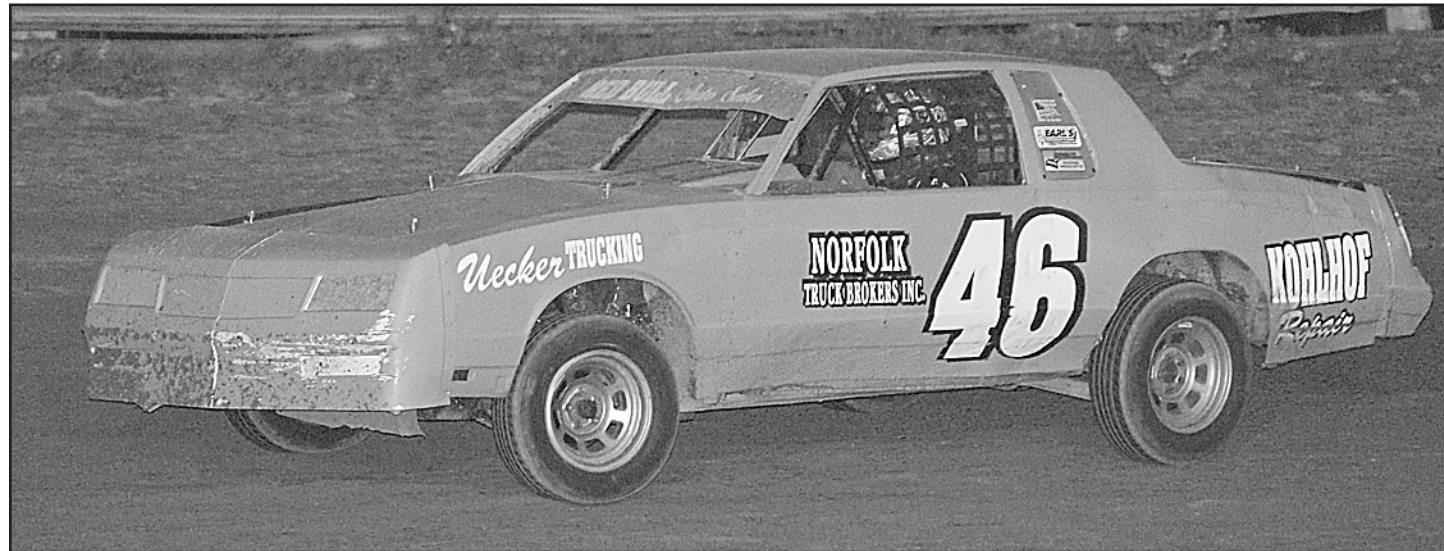

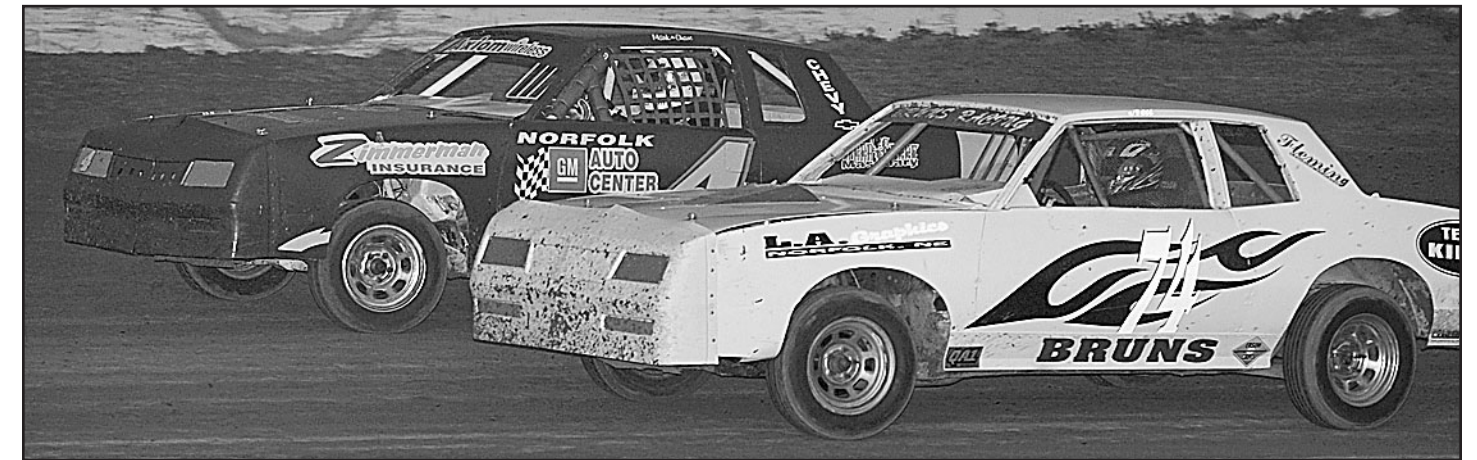

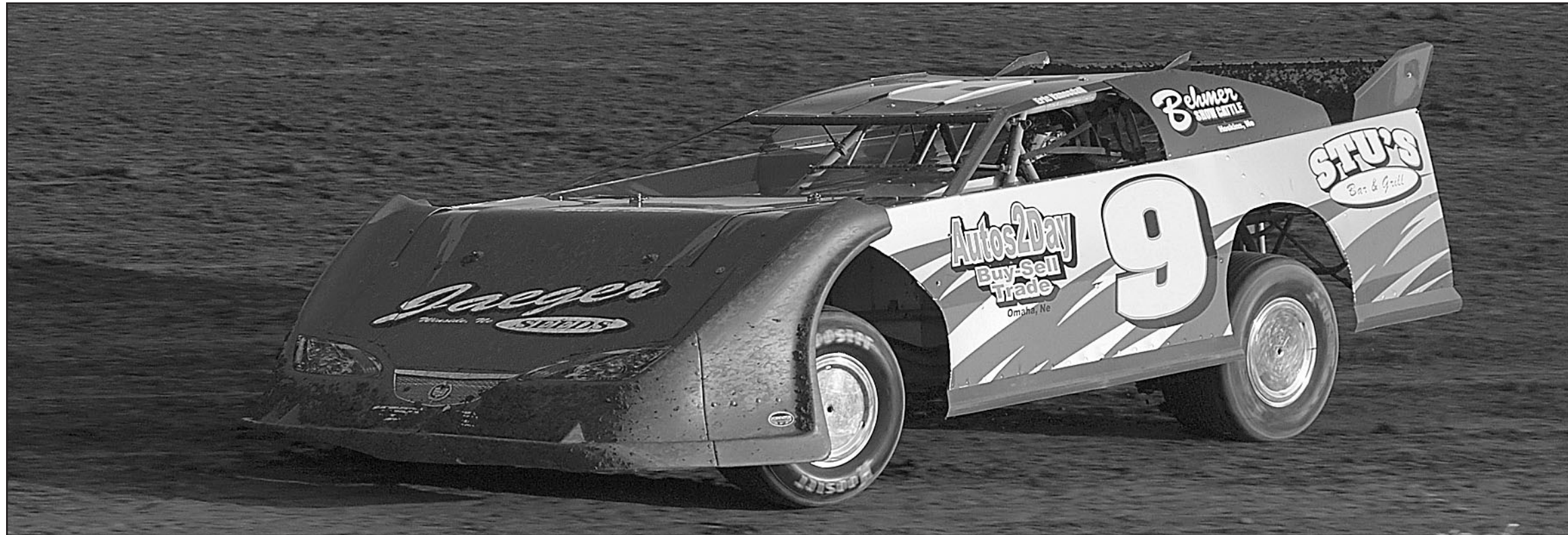

Eric Vanosdall of Winside broke during his heat race and was forced to run the "B"

feature. Hours later, he was winning his first "A" feature of the season.

Vanosdall finished third in the "B" feature and started 15th in the 15-car field in the "A" feature.

Ten laps into the 25-lap feature, Vanosdall was running fifth, but moved to third, when leader Junior Coover of Norfolk dropped from the race during

the caution laps and another car spun out on the restart.

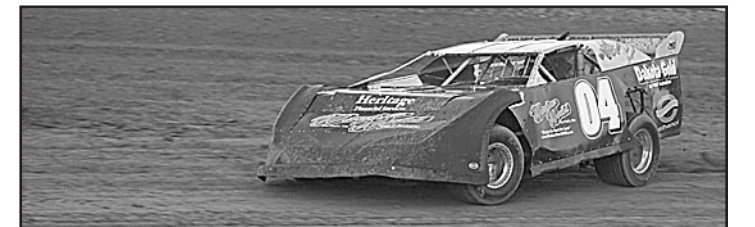
Four laps after the restart, Vanosdall passed Travis Birkley of Wakefield for second. It was another six laps when he took the top spot from Chad Jensen of Norfolk, who led for eight laps.

Jensen finished second and Jim Johnson of Plainview finished third.
