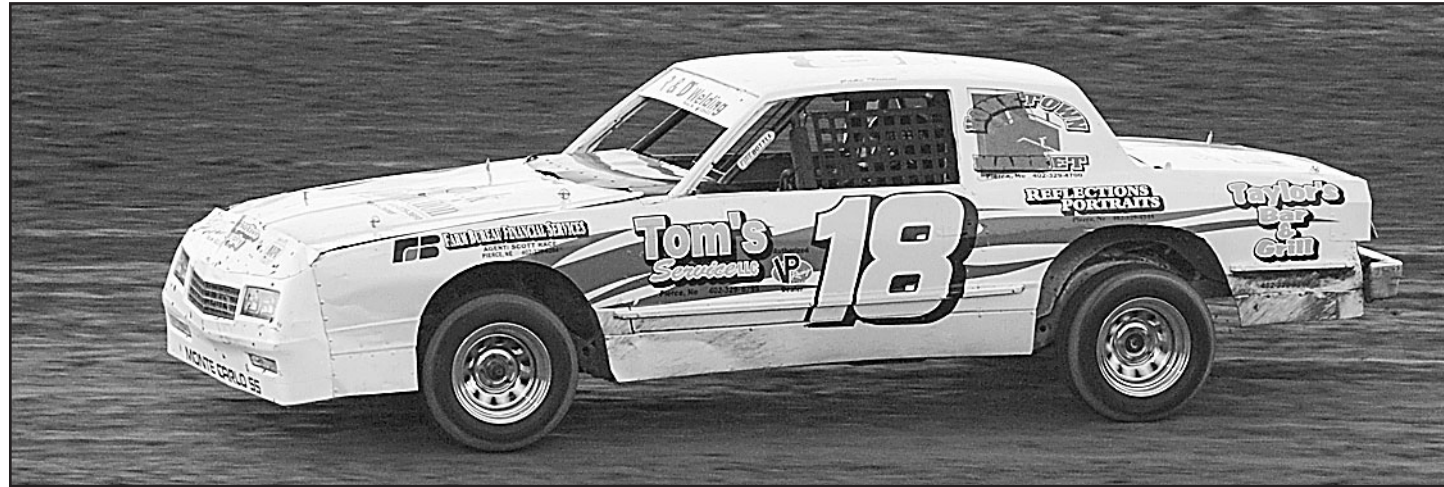


Timm, Relitz first-time winners

Hobby Stock driver Jake Timm of Pierce has watched his dad, Mike Timm, win; his uncles, Jeff Haase and BJ Haase, win; and even his cousin, Matt Haase win.

It was Jake Timm's turn Friday night.

Timm started on the outside the second row behind Terry Ronk of Norfolk.

At the drop of the green flag, Ronk grabbed the lead with Timm in tow.

Timm settled in behind Ronk for the first few laps, before Timm started challenging for the lead.

Ronk led the first nine laps,

before Timm successfully made the pass for the lead.

Timm led the final six laps to gain his first-career win at the track.

Ronk then got into a battle with Tracy Buck of Neligh and Matt Haase of Norfolk.

The three were side-by-side at the start finish on lap 10. Ronk came out back in the second position, where he stayed for the final five laps.

Haase collected the third place check for his third top 5. Fourth went to defending points champion Jeremy Brabec of Stanton and Buck took fifth.

Rounding out the top 5 was Jeremy Barg of Norfolk.



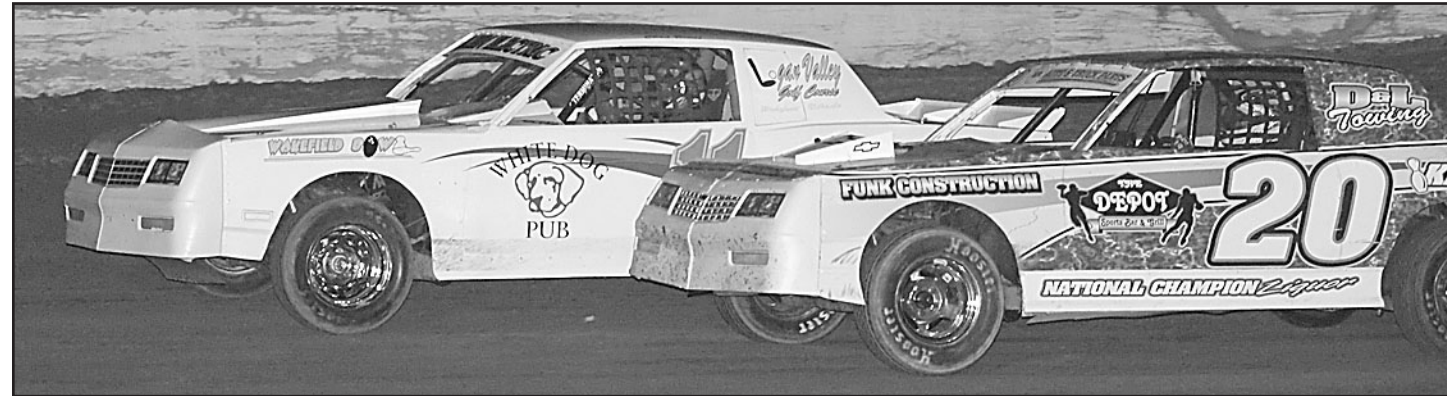

Haase spun and was going to get his spot back, but a flat tire sent him to the rear.

Two laps later after the restart, Haase was back into

the third position and battling for second against Jason Hames of Crofton.

On the final lap, Haase got a run out of the final corner and edged out Hames at the line.

Hames took home third, Troy Bruns of Wayne finished fourth and Jeremy Gnat rounded out the top 5.

TeJay Mielke of Norfolk and Chad Bruns won their heat races.

Chad Bruns win moved him to second in the points standings 16 points behind his brother Troy Bruns.

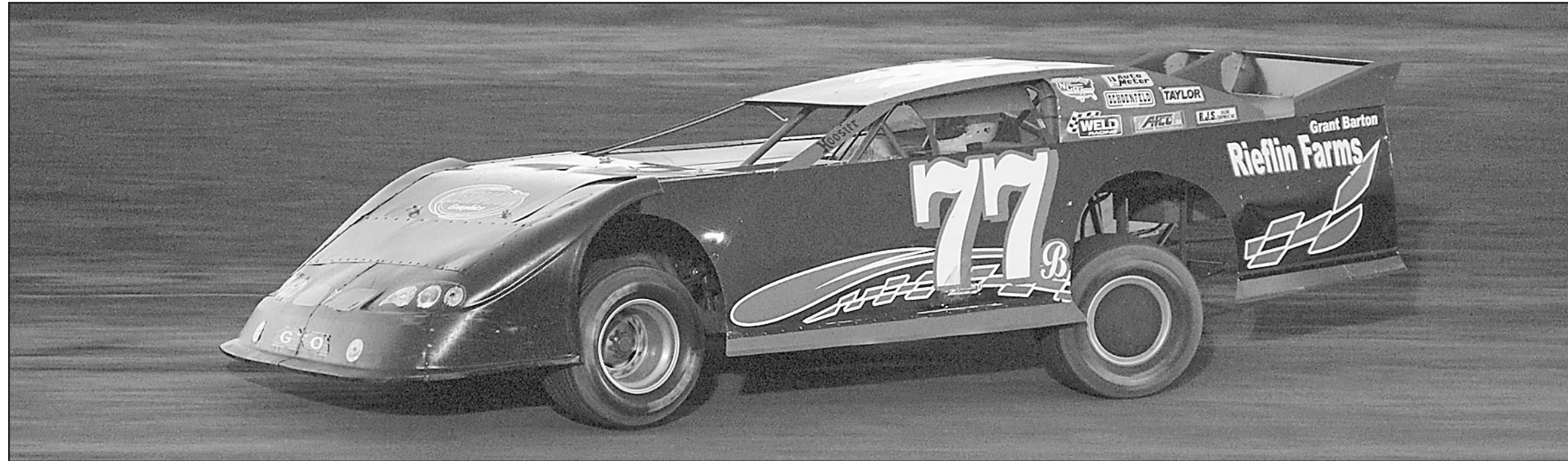

Milander finds success

What a difference a week makes. Riviera Raceway track manager Russ Haase worked on the track surface to eliminate the ruts and holes that plagued the week before.

Friday night, the track was smooth and ready to go. The night had two first-time winners and two repeat winners. Grand National driver Bob Milander of Pierce last full season at the track was back in 1999 and has run a limited schedule since. He picked up his another win Friday night.

Milander took advantage of a battle for second at the start of the 25-lap feature and by the time second was sorted out; his lead was more

than a half a lap. A caution on lap eight erased the advantage and on the restart, Milander nearly gave it away when he drifted up the track in the first turn.

He gathered it back straight and went to work. By lap 17, he was lapping traffic. No one ever got close, as he picked up his first win at the track since 2001. Ben Sukup of Norfolk was the driver who came out of the battle for second. He held the position until Chris Johnson of Bloomfield challenged him on lap 12. Johnson got by on lap 13. Milander's lead was large and lap traffic hindered his progression.

Sukup took home third, Doug Tomka of Stanton finished fourth and Jim Johnson of Plainview rounded out the top 5. Alex Banks, Chad Jensen and BJ Haase, each of Norfolk, won their heat race. Haase had the best finish in the "A" feature at sixth.

Ben Sukup (07) had his chance to take the lead after Bob Milander (77) slid up the track on a restart. Milander recovered and went on to win. Sukup was third.
