Sloan grabs a second win

Hornet driver Eric Sloan gambled at the start of the "A" feature and drove through the center of the field and went from the inside of the third row to lead the first lap of the race.

At the drop of the green flag, Sloan quickly moved between Cody Relitz and Katie Wagner, who both started in the second row.

He followed Kyle Mizner and Adam Wagner out of turn two and drove passed the two through turns three and four.

Once out front he drove away from the field until the first of three cautions were thrown after the completion

of the eighth lap. The caution erased a half-lap lead.

The next two cautions came out without completing another lap. So on the third restart, Sloan maintained the lead for the final four laps to take home his second win of the season.

Relitz of Norfolk backed his first win up with a second place. Third went to Grant Hurlbert of Winside, who had to out race Kandie Haase of Norfolk.

Haase took fourth and Shannon Pospisil of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.

The most trouble from the slick track came in the Street Stock division. Four yellow flags were thrown before the first lap was ever completed.

However, once the race got started, it went uninterrupted. Jason Hames of Crofton took the early lead. Chad Bruns and Troy Bruns fell into the second and third position.

The two exchanged the position a couple times before Troy Bruns took the

second spot on lap eight of the 18-lap feature.

The next lap Troy Bruns was running a long side of Hames and on lap 10 he was out front.

Troy Bruns led the final nine laps for the win. Second became a battle between Hames, Chad Bruns and Ron Pettitt of

Norfolk.

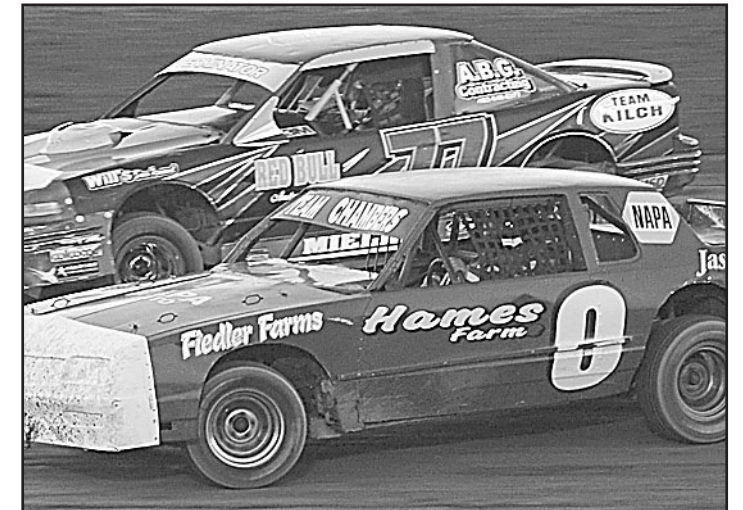
All three were side-by-side on lap 12. On lap 15, Chad Bruns captured the second spot and Hames took third.

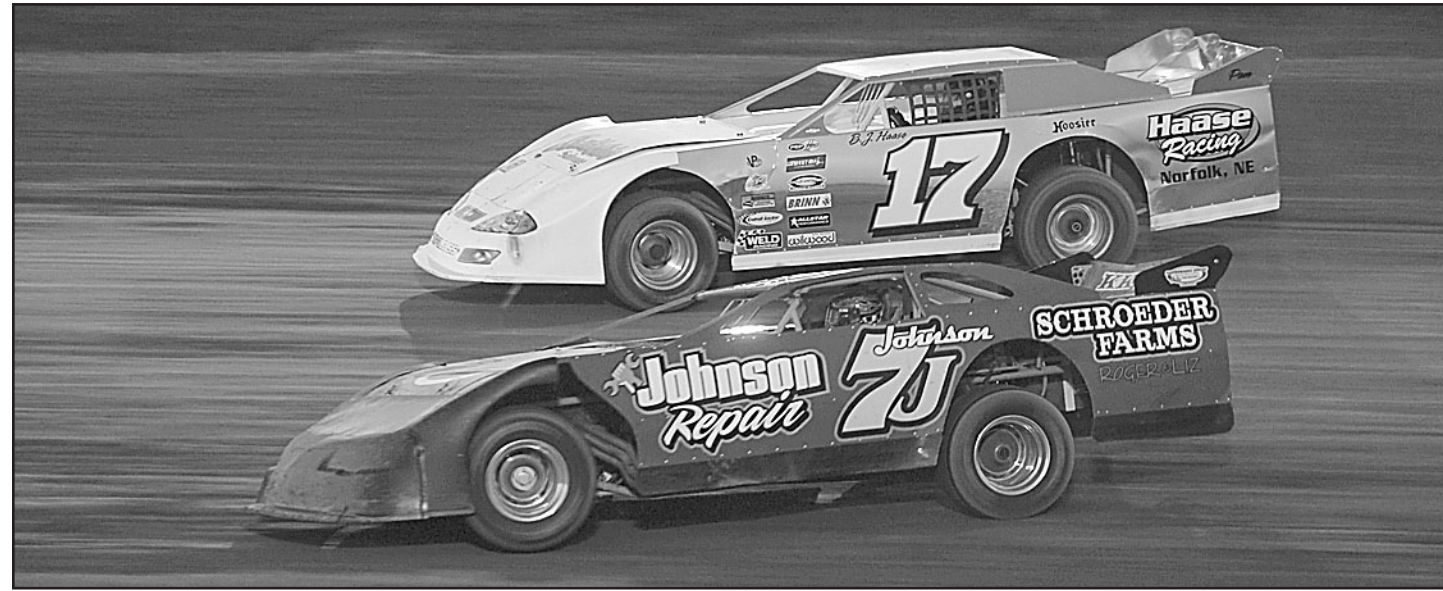

Johnson takes victory away from Clausen

There was a learning curve last week, as the track surface became dry-slick for the first time this season.

By the time the Grand Nationals took the track for their "A" feature, there was a nice shine on the track.

Heath Clausen of Norfolk led the first 21 laps, before Chris Johnson of Bloomfield made his move and led the final four laps.

Johnson said the car was not working all that well until the fifth of six cautions. On the restart, Johnson was running third to leader Clausen and Bob Milander of Pierce.

And as if a switch was turned on, Johnson got by Milander on lap 20 and a lap later muscled his way under Clausen for the lead.

Johnson pulled away for his first win of the season. Clausen took second and Milander was third.

Alex Banks of Norfolk cruised in fourth and Chad Jensen of Norfolk was fifth.

Sehi returns to winner's circle

Hobby Stock driver Derek Sehi of Neligh dominated his heat last week and was looking to score his second career victory in the "A" feature, when he sped off at the start of the main event.

He had the outside pole position for the 15-lap feature. Following a caution on the completion of the first, Sehi set sail to pace the field.

Jake Timm of Pierce slipped into second passing Kevin Haase of Plainview for the position.

Timm then hunted down Sehi and was able to dive underneath going into the corners, but Sehi had the momentum coming out of the corners to maintain the lead.

Lap by lap Timm edged closer to taking the position, but a caution was thrown three laps from checkered flags.

On the restart, Timm dove

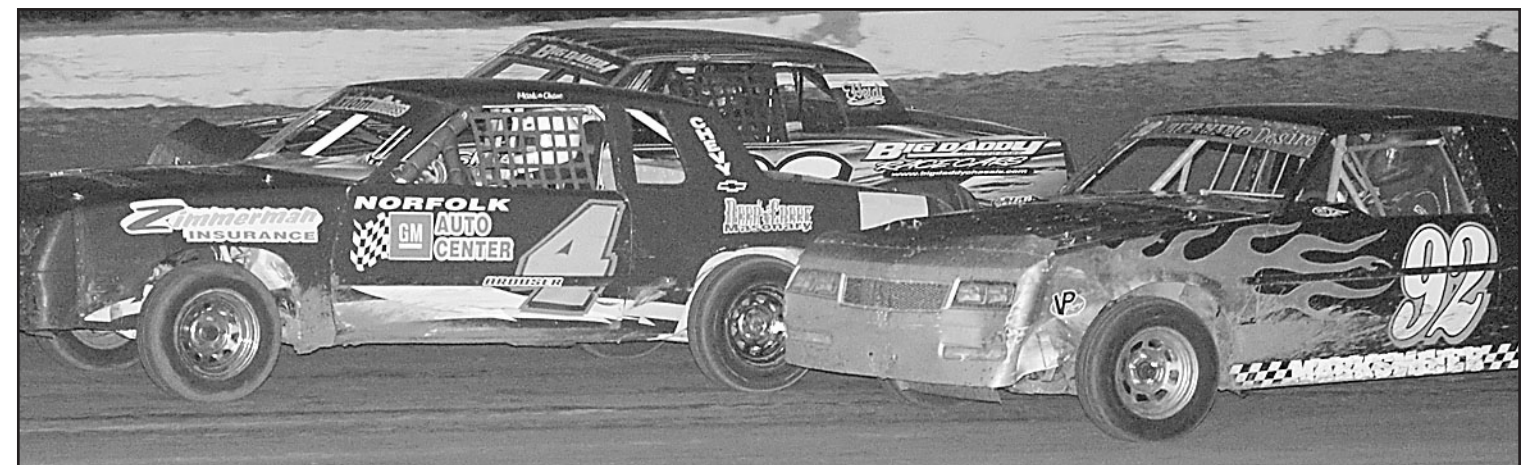
low into turn one, but discovered he had a brake problem and chose to spin out to avoid taking anyone out.

Timm continued, but having brought out the caution, he started last on the restart.

Sehi took the win, as a battle for second place helped slow up the field. Sehi won his first of the season and his second career win at the track.

Jeremy Hoskinson of Norfolk slipped past Mark Arduser on the final lap to claim the runner-spot on his first appearance of the season.
