



Meyer takes first victory


Cameron Meyer raced nine times last season and bagged one top 5 with six "A" feature appearances. This season, Meyer is sitting third in the points with a win already in the books.

John Dunklau of Norfolk led the first six laps, but after a caution, Meyer moved out front and led the final six laps for his first track win.


Meyer started on the outside of the third row and was running third on the completion of the first lap. Three laps later he was second.








