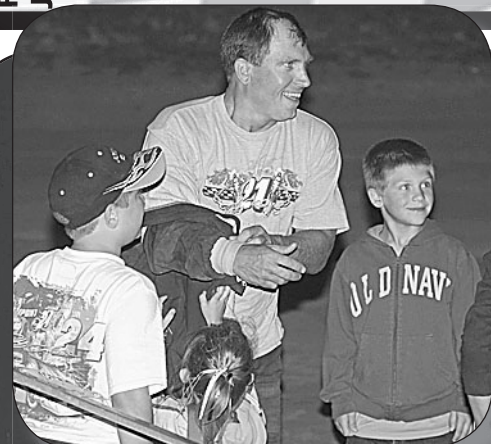

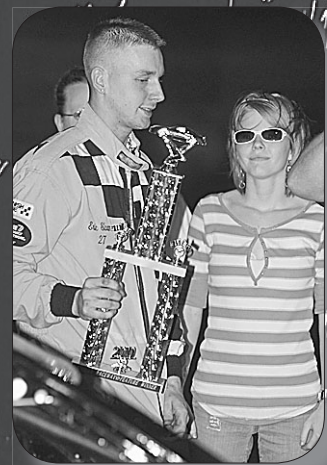

It was on the restart when Haase slipped past Weinrich for the top spot. Haase went onto win his second feature of

the season.

Jeremy Brabec of Stanton finished third and Jim Kimmel of Norfolk was fourth. Rounding out the top 5 was Weinrich.

his fourth of the season and his fifth top 5.

Shannon Pospisil of Norfolk moved into the second spot on lap seven to finish in the runner-up position.

Wieneke wrapped up the third spot. Grant Hurlbert of Winside finished fourth and Ryne Hoffart of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.

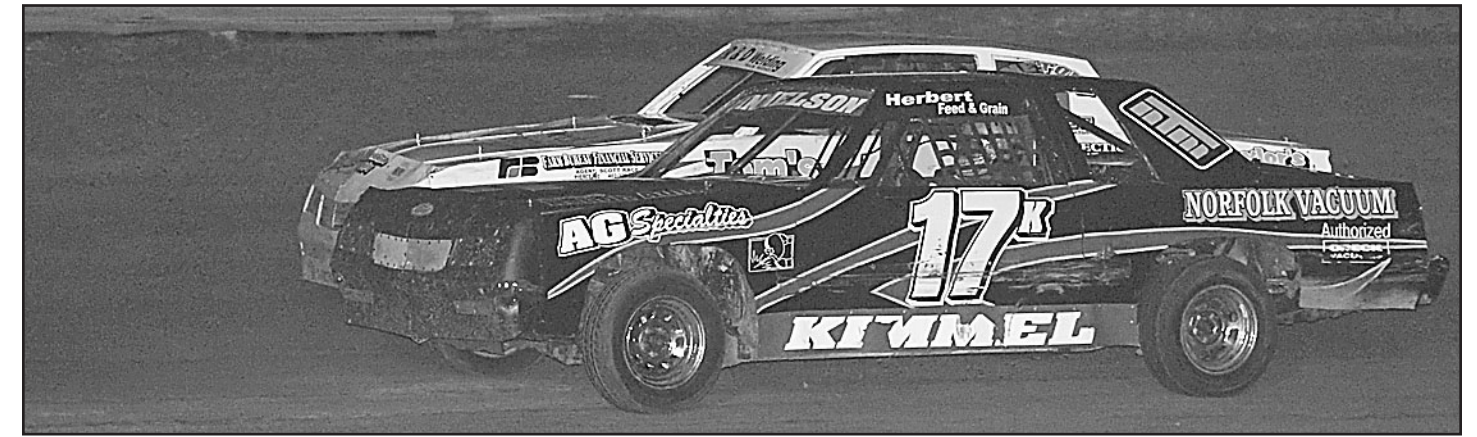
Bob Milander's (77) night ended early when he got caught up in an incident.

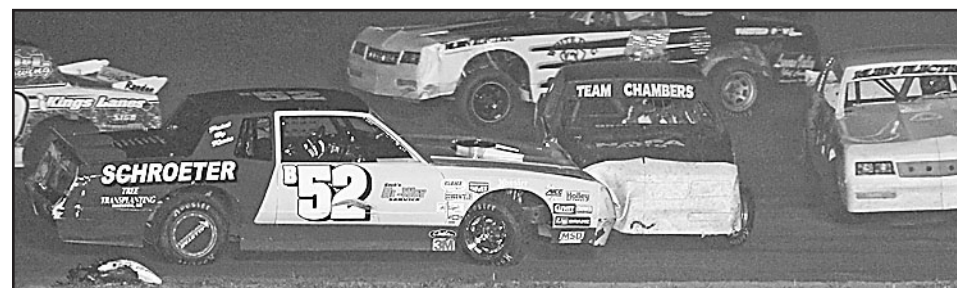

### Brun survives problems

When the races started last week, Chad Brun of Wayne looked as if he would have never started the night.

It started in hot laps when an oil leak caused massive plume of smoke trailing his stock car. His crew worked to fix the problem, but again he fogged the track with smoke.

When it came to his heat race, the crew finally fixed the leak and he went onto win the qualifying race.

During the main event, two cautions were thrown. Brun found himself in the middle of both incidents.

The first one he made it through, however, the

second one he slammed into the side of another car after the completion of the third lap.

The hit was hard enough to badly damage his right front rim, but the tire held air.

On the restart Brun was running third behind Eric Haase of Norfolk and Jason Hames of Crofton.

Four laps later, he was pacing the field. He led the final eight laps to pick up his third win of the season.

Haase captured the second position and Hames was third. Troy Brun of Wayne finished fourth and Jared Rodgers of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.
