Two feature wins for Weinrich

It was a close battle in the Hobby Stock division last week with Tate Weinrich of Hoskins coming out on top.

Weinrich led the final five laps. The finish was decided by only a half-a-car length.

Terry Ronk of Norfolk led the first 10 laps from his pole position with Weinrich slipping in to the second spot

from the drop of the green.

It was on lap nine of the 15-lap feature Weinrich made his move for first.

Weinrich and Ronk were side-by-side for laps nine and 10, before Weinrich led the 11th lap.

It then became a show for first-time Hans Housek of Emerson. The new driver to the track didn't break into

the top 3 until the 12th lap.

He was third on lap 13; he was second taking the white flag; and was alongside Weinrich at the checkered flags to capture second place.

Neil Bruns of Norfolk finished third and Ronk took home fourth. Matt Haase of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.

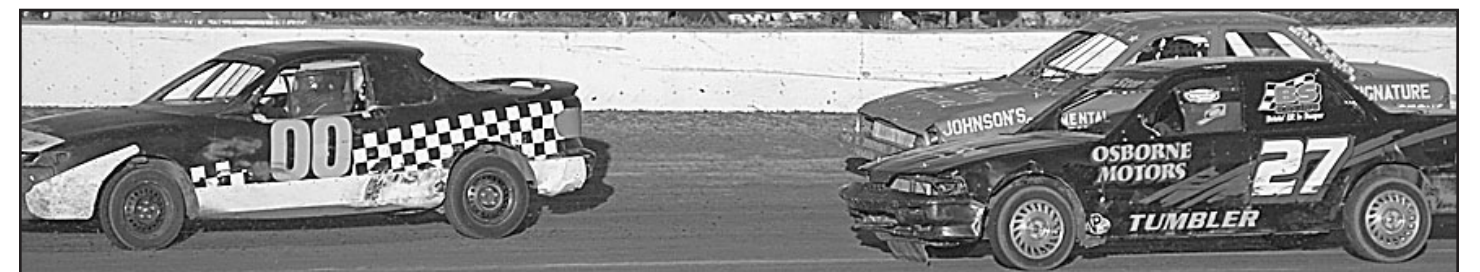
Shannon Pospisil of Norfolk was next to run the spot and it is where he finished. It was Pospisil's sixth top 5 finish.

Bruns ties brother in feature victories

With the track staying tacky all night it came down to who had smoothest laps in the Street Stock division.

If a driver over shot the corner and pushed up the track, it opened the bottom side for the car behind them

TeJay Mielke of Norfolk jumped out the early lead from the outside pole position.

He slowly moved away from the field, but a caution tightened up the field. Mielke was leading Troy Bruns of Wayne second and Eric Haase of Norfolk third.

All three cars were fast until two laps after the restart, Haase car went dead down the backstretch ending his night. It also gave Mielke the lead back. Bruns had made the pass, but the lap was not completed giving Mielke the lead again.

Mielke led the next three laps, before he bobbled allowing Bruns to get alongside.

For three-laps, Mielke and Bruns were side-by-side throughout most of the laps.

On the white flag lap, Bruns claimed the top spot alone. His brother Chad Bruns of Wayne made a last lap effort, but came up short.

Troy Bruns picked up his third win of the season, matching his brother's three wins. Chad Bruns was second. Jared Rodgers of Norfolk picked up his second top 5, when he passed Mielke in the closing laps.

Mielke finished fourth and Jeremy Gnat of Battle Creek rounded out the top 5.

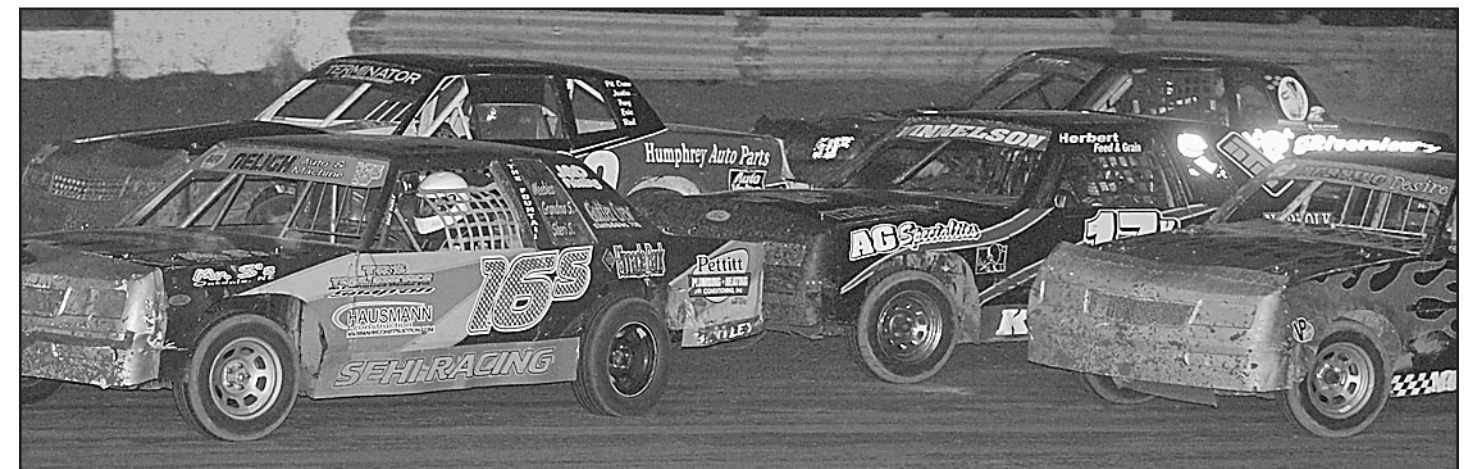


Kevin Haase (9) leads a group through turn four during his heat race. Haase finished second in his heat race.

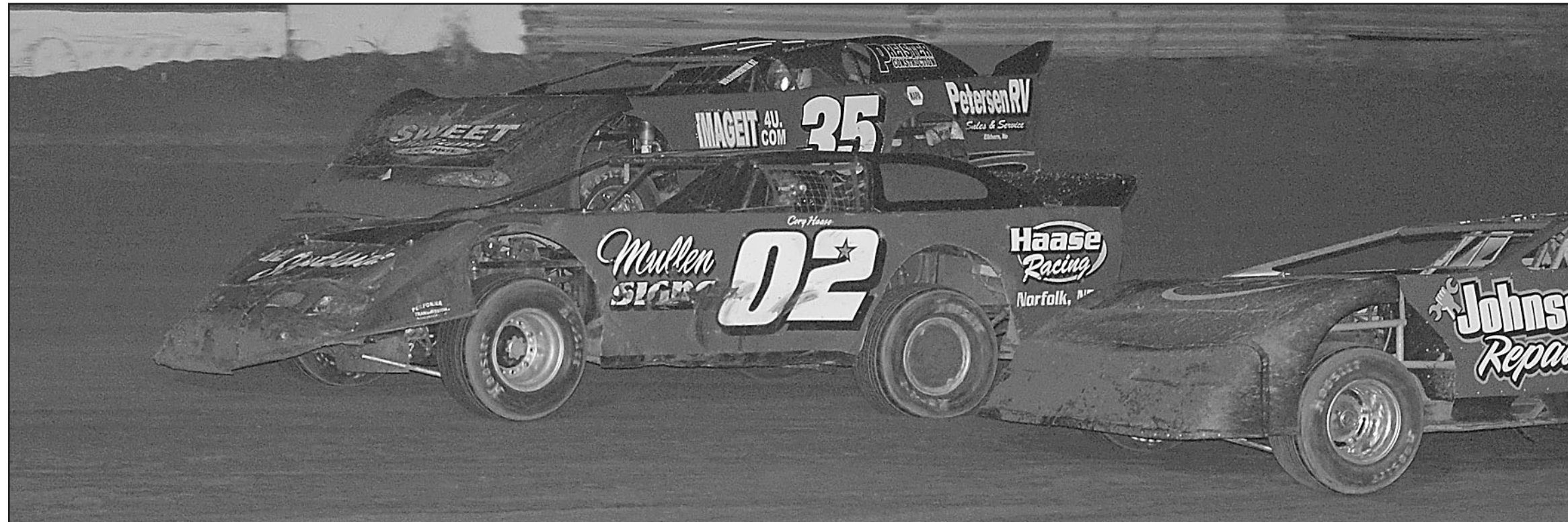
Matt Haase (81) took third in his heat race and was fifth in the feature. It was his sixth top 5.

Osborne leads one lap for win

Robert Osborne of Norfolk led only the final lap, last week, passing Cory Haase of Norfolk on the last lap.

The race only had one caution after the completion of the second lap. Ben Sukup of Norfolk led the first three laps from the pole position.

After the restart, Haase challenged for the top spot. It took two laps for Haase to complete the pass to lead from the fourth lap on.

Osborne started 10th in the 15-

car field and slowly picked his way through the field.

Osborne broke into the top 3 on lap 20, when he pulled alongside Chad Jensen of Norfolk.

Two laps later, Osborne was racing Doug Tomka of Stanton for second. For two laps Tomka and Osborne were side-by-side at the line.

Osborne managed to make the pass. As the white flag flew, Osborne and Haase were side-by-side. The two cars were door handle-to-door handle on

the final lap with Chris Johnson of Bloomfield sticking his car alongside, as well. However, it was Osborne who had the advantage at the checkered flags.

It was Osborne second win of the season and his fourth top 5. Haase picked up his third top 5 and his best finish so far this year.

Johnson's third place was his sixth top 5. Fourth went to Tomka and rounding out the top 5 was Jensen.

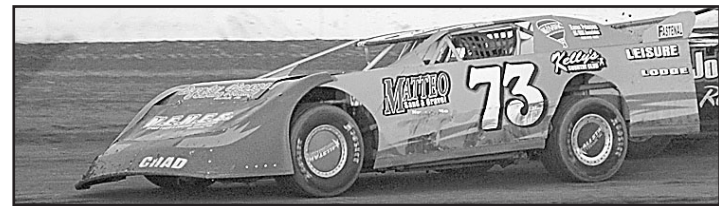


Robert Osborne (35) edges out Cory Haase (02) at the finish of the feature, last week.

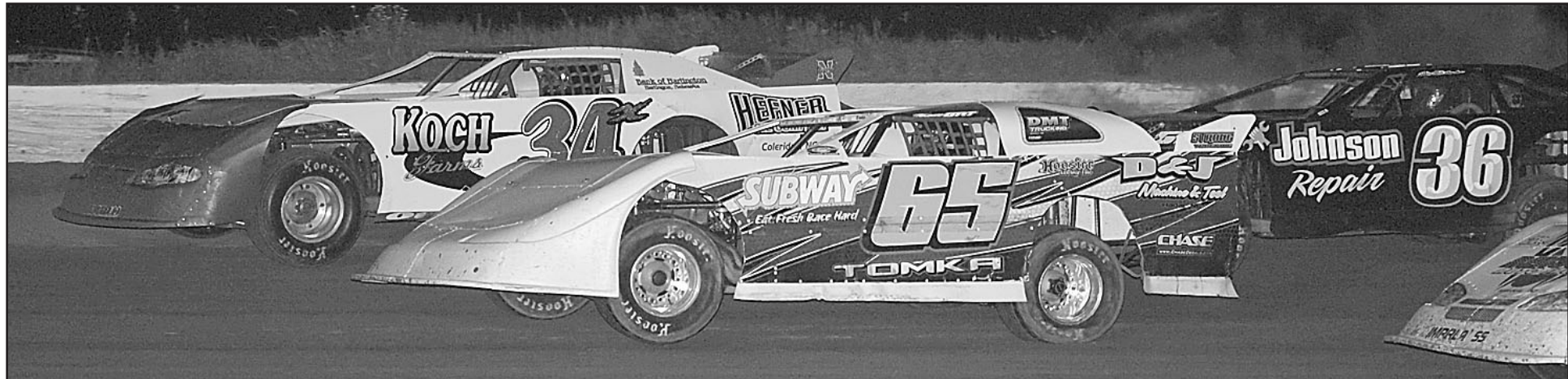
