With only one caution at the start of the feature, the 15-car field gets spread out and overlapping starts occurring.

Johnson became a victim as he led from the drop of the green. Johnson first caught the back of the pack on lap 14 and had little trouble getting pass the first set of slower traffic.

However, six laps later the

back markers ran Johnson hard and allowed Milander and Robert Osborne of Norfolk to close the gap.

A few laps later another car blocked his way and the duo was given a chance to pounce on Johnson.

While exiting turn three, Johnson nearly came to a stop for what looked to be a problem.

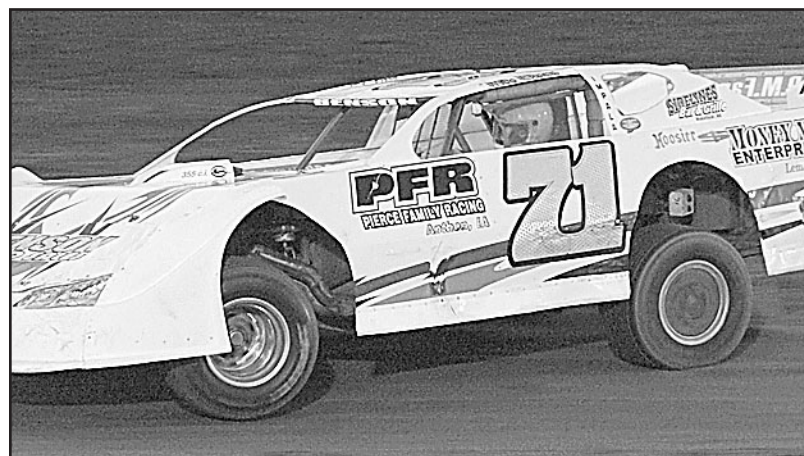
Johnson was unable to hold back Milander. Milander picked up his second win. Johnson held onto second and Osborne finished third.

lost traction and plowed into the side of Kleve.

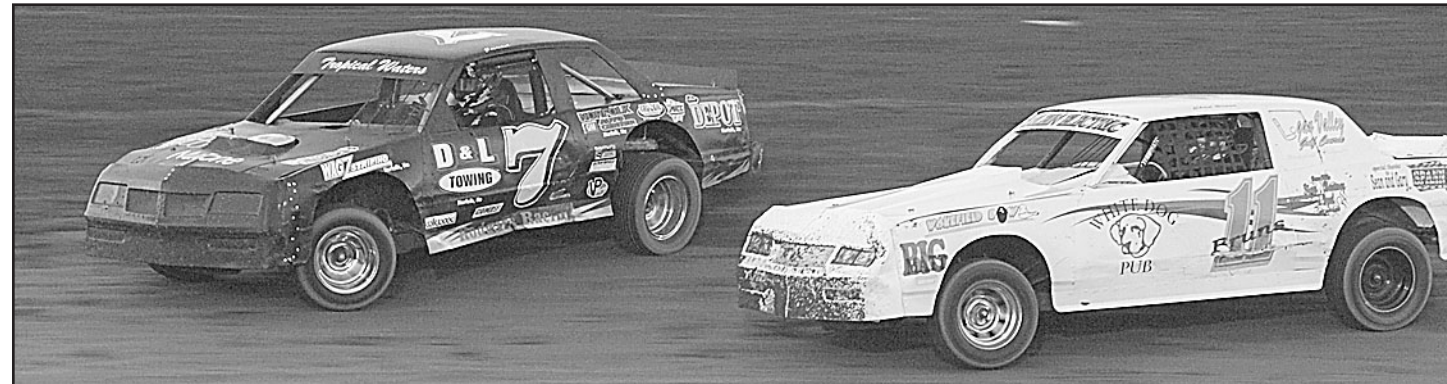
Kleve then was pushed into the wall, causing the final caution of the 14-lap feature.

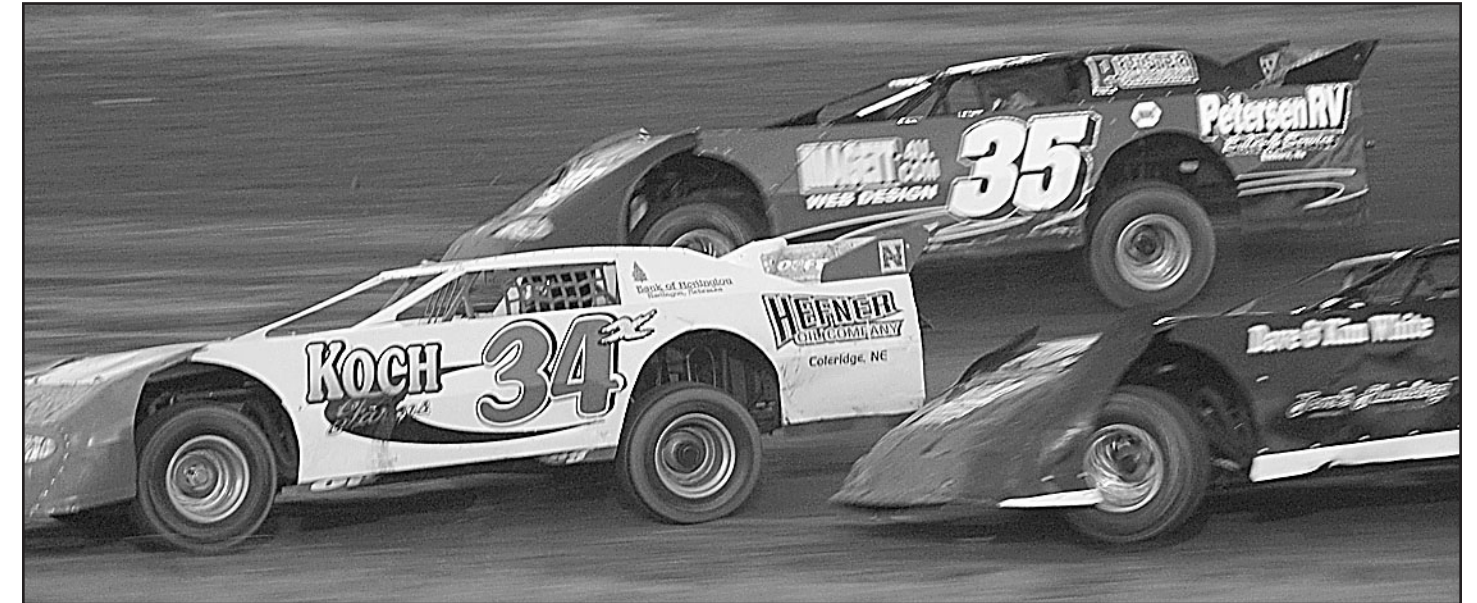
Chad Bruns won out and finished second. Mielke came back and took third. Troy Bruns grabbed fourth and Jared Rodgers rounded out the top 5.



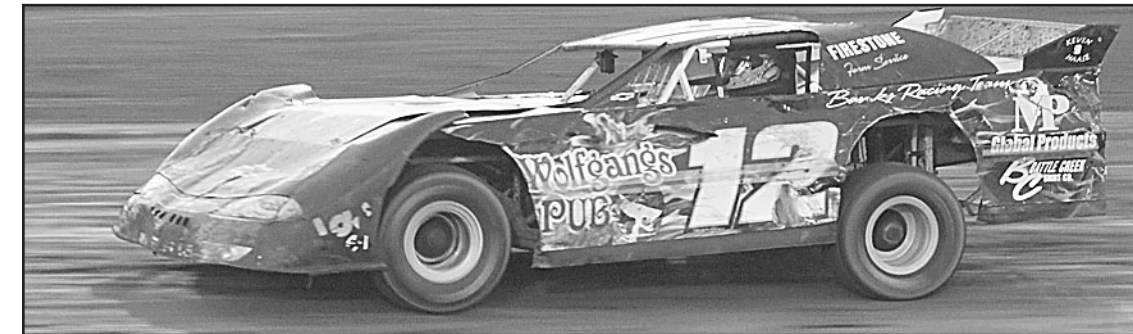

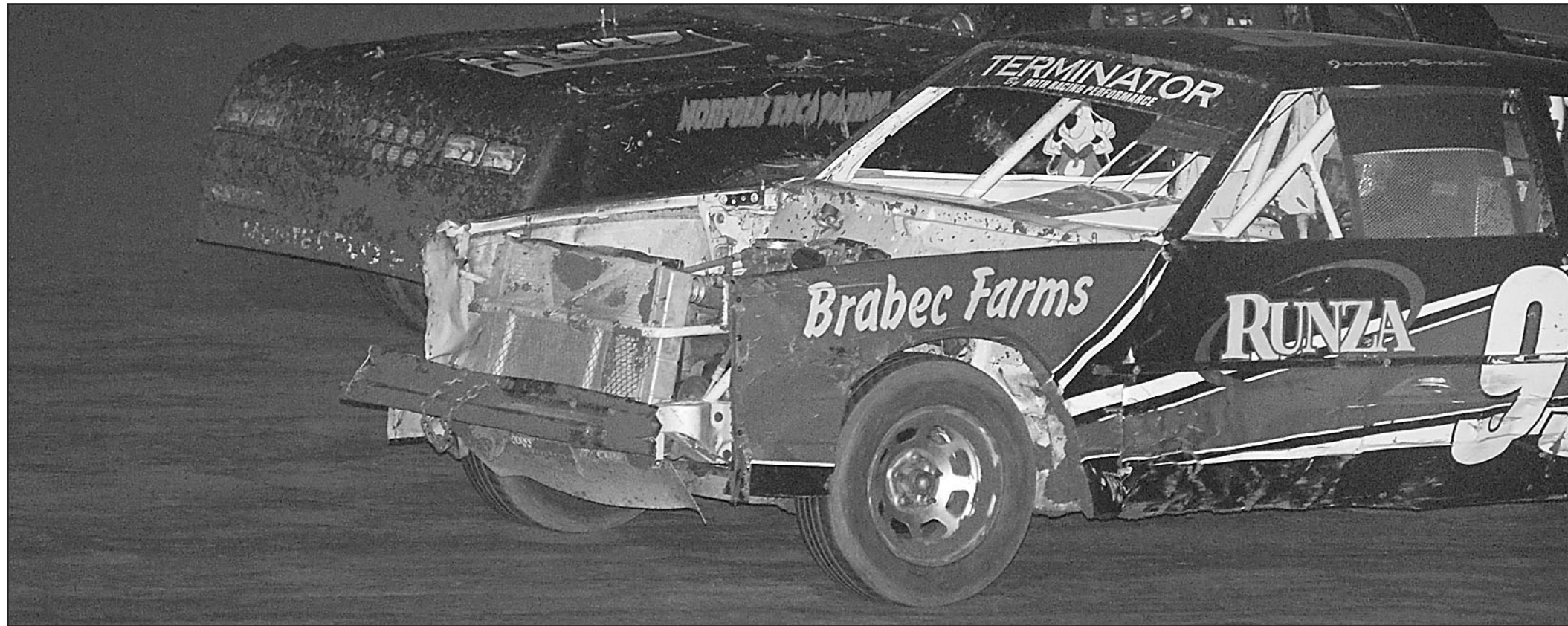
Alex Banks (12) took a 12th place finish in the feature.

Terry Ronk of Norfolk led the first eight laps. Ronk endured four of the five cautions. By the restart from the fourth caution, Brabec had worked his way from 14th to eighth.

Kevin Haase led one lap before the final caution flew. Brabec had moved to fourth.

Hoskins moved out front. Three laps later, Brabec moved into the third spot. Lap later he was second and at the white flag, Brabec edged Weinrich at the line.

Brabec went onto win, Weinrich second, Neil Bruns of Norfolk finished third. Haase placed fourth and Mark Arduser of Battle Creek captured fifth.

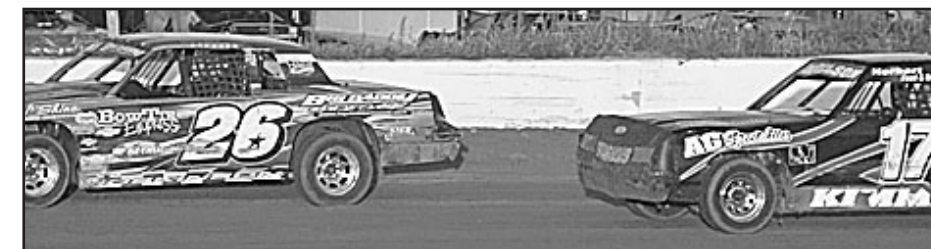
Mark Arduser (4) took a fifth place finish in the feature.



Kevin Haase (9) gets turned around and then got stuck in the mud during the feature race. Haase regained his position and finished fourth.

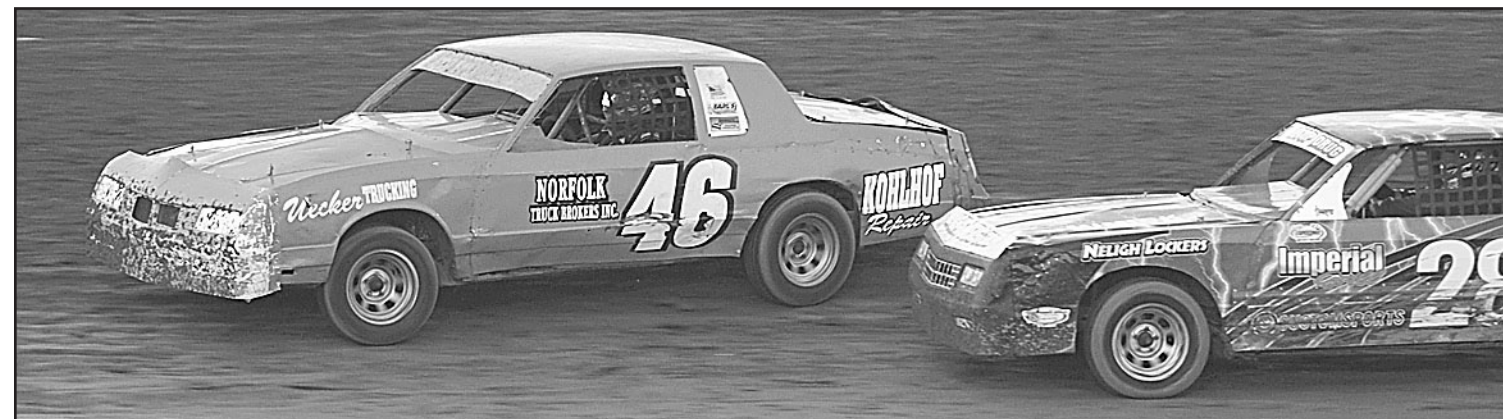


Hans Housek (59) is spun out in turn two. He later suffered a flat tire and ended up finishing 10th.
