Grand Nationals kickoff season

The sun was shining and the track was heavy feet of 1997 points champion Robert lead was then wiped away. Matthies condry last Saturday night at Riviera Raceway to kick off the 1998 racing season.

It was the first time in four weeks the weather cooperated and provided good racing weather, as 75 stock cars and drivers entertained a full crowd.

Reggie Roth of Bancroft, who won the most A-features last year with six, led the Grand National field of 15 cars for the final 23 circuits picking up the first win and the points lead for the brand new season.

Roth started the night on a sour note when his engine died during hot laps. His car was pushed to the pits where the problem was solved quickly and without problems. He later would hot lap the car, shaking the bugs from the system.

He rolled onto the track for his heat race where he raced Keith Hansen for four laps before assuming the top spot and eventually the win.

The win gave Roth the outside pole position for the "A" feature along side Steve Matthies of Norfolk, who had won the first heat race. Zuhlke arrived to the track just in time to hot lap with Roth after the driver's meeting. He won the third heat.

Matthies would hold Roth at the start of the "A" feature by blocking and using the lower line around the turns. After two laps, Roth made his move and got to the inside and took over on lap three.


After freeing himself from Matthies, Roth set sail and would pull away from the rest of the field, while Matthies held up the Osborne of Norfolk, Vic Lovejoy of Meadow Grove and Curt Zuhlke of Bancroft.

The first caution flew after eight circuits when Jr. Clausen spun in turn three. Roth's

tinued to hold onto second with Osborne, Lovejoy and Zuhlke on his heels.

The race would be restarted, but for



Pettitt would lead the first four laps and move away from the second and third place cars, who were in a battle for position.





This week 21 cars showed for the class, as 12 were remaining to run the feature.



Kruse and Vogt worked their way into the top three after five laps. They would battle with Smith and Worley.



Brian Koch (left) and Steve Reynolds stand in victory lane.


