
Wagner then would suffer a problem and drop from the race.

On the restart, Termansen would pull away from the second place car of Travis Loecker of Bloomfield and Joel Carlson of Winside, as they went door handle to door handle.

Loecker secured second and made another hard charge for the win, but would come up short at the finish. Loecker's second place was the second consecutive and third this season.

Rolling across the line third, Carlson picked up his fifth top 5 of the year. Chris Johnson of Bloomfield was fourth, while

Osborne's patience outlasts field, takes home first win of season

Riviera Raceway played host to the of Bancroft and Osborne maneuver "Bud 500" last Saturday night and with extra money in the purse, the racing became very competitive throughout the night.

But, it was not a quick night, as 17 cautions, lighting problems and another guard rail repair slowed down the night.

The temperature for the fans was tolerable, but the heat on the track came to a boil when several late lap incidents changed the outcome of the top running cars in the Grand National division.

Scott Phillips of Norfolk took the hardest lick when his machine clipped another car and shot up into the third turn guard rail. He was leading at the time and was not seriously injured.

The next 19 of 25 laps proved the most exciting as race fans watched Curt Zuhlke

through the 15-car field. While up front, leader Bob Milander of Norfolk kept youngster Travis Roth of Bancroft at bay, as they tried to race on the same piece of

The level of competition was stepped up a notch when Zuhlke and Osborne caught the leaders on lap 13. The first battle of the war came when Zuhlke caught the second place car of Roth. The two got to working on each other and nearly was passed by Osborne, who tried to sneak around on the high side.

Finally on lap 19, Zuhlke crept passed Roth and moved to second, but on the next lap Zuhlke and leader Milander drifted high in turn four. This time Osborne not only snuck up on them but darted through the middle and grabbed the lead.

Osborne said the middle opened up and with a good bit of four he managed to go from fourth to first in one turn.


The incident produced a caution on the next lap, which placed Osborne in the driver's seat, Roth second, Zuhlke third and the older Roth, Reggie, in fourth.

On the restart, R. Roth got a run on Zuhlke and made the pass for third. One lap later, he passed his son for second.

The last caution of the race flew for the second battle of the war, when Zuhlke and T. Roth tangled, ruining any chances for either driver to contend for the win.

T. Roth was sent to the rear of the field, while Zuhlke unexpectedly pulled off the track, ending his bid for his fifth consecutive "A" feature win.

T. Roth's best finish came back on May 30 when he finished third to winner Bill Wells of Norfolk and his father. He was looking to match or better the mark before the incident with Zuhlke occurred three laps from the end of the race.

Osborne went onto win his first feature this year and his eighth top five finish in nine racing nights.

Second went to R. Roth, his sixth top five, while third was handed to Steve Matthies of Norfolk, matching his best effort of the year. Matthies came from the "B" feature where he finished second. It was also his fourth "A" feature top 5 finish this season.

Keith Hansen of Norfolk made his returned to the track after his hard crash on the back stretch several weeks ago. Hansen sat out last week, but returned to finish fourth in the "A" feature,

Raymond Haase of Norfolk rounded out the top five, taking home his sixth top five finish this season.


Jeff Haase of Norfolk grabbed his second "B" feature passing Matthies on the final lap. Travis Dickes was third in the "B."


Milander held off R. Haase to pick up his first heat race win of the year.

Osborne clipped Phillips on the final lap to win the third heat. It was his third victory this season.


Osborne extends his lead in the points standings. Roth maintains second and Vic Lovejoy of Meadow Grove third.

Jim Kimmel of Norfolk had his best effort of the year finishing fifth.



Kimmel won the "B" feature with Pettitt finishing second.






