In his third year of running the Grand National division, Norfolk's Steve Matthies brought home his first "A" feature win of the year last Saturday night and his fourth career divisional win.

Matthies drove in the Street Stock division for 10 years before he made the move to the Grand National ranks. And in those three years as a Grand National driver, he it was not R. Roth as he was about to overhas claimed at least one win a season.

Unlike any of his previous victories, Matthies had the extra bonus of racing side-by-side with his rookie cousin Travis Roth of Bancroft for the final 23 laps of 25lap event.


> The track had became a one groove track and that was as low as you could get, said Matthies. If a car got out of the groove, it was too slick and the car would drift to the wall.

Racing at the Hartington race track the 25. And now Termansen grabbed back-tolast four years, Yankton's Kim Termansen has started racing at Riviera Raceway this year and has become a driver to watch, as he won his second consecutive Street Stock "A" feature this season.

With the closing of the Hartington race track, several drivers have decided to pull their cars into Norfolk and race at Riviera. Out of the top 10 in points at Riviera, at least six drivers ran a full season at Hartington in the previous years.

Termansen became the fifth back-toback Street Stock "A" feature winner in the last two years. Pat Jensen of Stanton was the first one last year, winning on May 10 and 17 of 1997.

Ron Pettitt of Pierce was next, winning on June 28 and July 3 of 1997. Darrell Doerr of Plainview was next when he finished out his four-win season, claiming two in a row on Aug. 2 and 9 of 1997.

This year, Chris Johnson of Bloomfield was the first one, winning on May 16 and

Termansen made quick work out of the field as he went from seventh to second in the first lap and passed Brian Wagner of Winnetoon on lap two following a restart to take over the lead.

Termansen would lead the rest of the 13 of 15 laps. Travis Loecker, who tried to catch Termansen in the final 12 laps settled for second again.

It was Loecker's third straight second place finish and his fourth second place finish in the last five weeks. In fact, all of Loecker's top five finishes have been in the top two spots — one first place and four runner-up places.

Rounding out the top five from Saturday night was Pettitt, Doerr and. Johnson.

Johnson leads with the most top fives at seven. Doerr and Jim Johnson of Bloomfield have six. Doerr and Pettitt are the only two Street Stock drivers to qualify for the "A" feature all 10 weeks.


Doerr has come from the "B" feature once, while Pettitt has run the "C" feature once and the "B" feature twice to make the main event.

Pettitt, however, has the most heat race wins with seven. Termansen is next with four.


Winning the "B" feature last Saturday was Joel Carlson of Winside. Throener was second and Nick Opfer of Hartington third.


