





Timm led the caution-free 15-lap "A" feature from the drop of the green flag to lap 13, only to have Doerr lead the final


Before the night start, Timm commented a fast track is a disadvantage for him, as his power plant is no match for the bigger outfitted teams.


The two then slowly gained on Timm, who by then had nearly a full straightaway lead. It was on lap 13 when the duo caught Timm going into turn three.

T. Roth took over the top spot with lap eight from Jeff Carlson of Wayne. He moved away from the field until the final caution flew with eight laps remaining.


On the restart, T. Roth was first, Carlson

Osborne continues to lead the Grand National points. He has finished in the top five 10 times in 11 nights. Which is the ost by any driver has done this year.


Osborne has one win, three seconds, two thirds, three fourths and one fifth. His other finish was seventh, which was the makeup race for the June 6 rain out.

Both Zuhlke and R. Roth each have six top five finishes. Zuhlke has four wins, while R. Roth won the first night out and has finished second four times.



Raymond Haase (2X), Jay Smith (77) and Curt Zuhlke get together in the first and second turns 17 laps into the "A" feature.





Timm, who said he became too cautious toward the end, held onto third, his first top five finish of the year.


Rounding out the top five was two-time winner Kim Termansen and Travis Loecker, breaking his four week string of runner up finishes.









