



Smith claims second feature win

Three cars battle to finish line

It was a month ago when Grand National driver Jay Smith of Norfolk got rned around on the back stretch and was ruck head on by Keith Hansen of Norfolk leaving both drivers with badly damaged stock cars.

Smith would sit out a second week to make the necessary repairs.

Even after returning, Smith said the car took time to get back into shape and get the set up on the car the way he had it before the incident.

Last week he finished into the top five and with the car dialed in, he picked up his second win of the season when raced Curt Zuhlke and Reggie Roth, both of Bancroft, for the win last Saturday night.

Starting from the inside of row four, Smith worked his way to the front steadily. On his way to the front, Smith said Chad Jensen of Norfolk was the toughest all night, as both Bob Milander of Norfolk and Smith tried to get by Jensen early in the

During the time he tried to get around, Jensen, Smith also had to protect his position, as several times Zuhlke would get to the inside of him.

Milander finally got by Jensen on lap 10 p take over the top spot. Smith said Jensen then drifted high, allowing him to zip past. A lap later he was passing Milander for the lead.

Smith would lead for three laps before the first and only caution flag flew for the cars of Travis Roth of Bancroft, who won the race the previous week and Jeff Carlson of Wayne. Both were sitting in turn four.

That bunched the field with Smith first, Hansen would return a week later, but Milander second, Zuhlke third, Jeff Haase of Norfolk fourth and R. Roth fifth.

On the restart, Zuhlke downed Milander for second. One lap later, R. Roth made the pass around Milander for third. That set up a three-car battle for the win in the final 11

With the track getting slick, Smith said it became a one groove race track and that was at the very bottom of the track against the large tires lining in the inside of the track.


Both Zuhlke and R. Roth made their attempt to pass, but the groove was not large enough. The only thing left to do was wait for a mistake by another driver.

Smith would make the only mistake and it nearly cost him the race. Smith said he entered turn three the final time and clipped one of the large tires. The incident upset his car and the car slid high opening the bottom groove.


Zuhlke filled the hole, but Smith managed to gather the car back and as the two exited the fourth turn they bumped door handle-to-door handle. It then became a drag race to the finish.

Smith would win, Zuhlke second and R.

and had checked out on the field. Pettitt was able to close the gap, but settled for second.

Travis Loecker of Bloomfield battled with Bernie Berck and Chris Johnson for third. Loecker was able to take third with Johnson finishing fourth and Bernie Berck fifth.

It was Loecker's seventh top five finished this season.

Johnson took his eighth top five finish to lead the Street Stock division. For Berck, it was his best effort in the five "A" features he has run this season.

Pettitt and his crew were given a scare

in his heat race, when he was running third when the car developed a serious problem. The car was silent and coasting down the back stretch looking like his night was done.

However, Pettitt discovered a wire on the ignition box was causing the problem.. Crew members made the necessary repairs and Pettitt was able to refire the No. 12 machine. He finished the last three laps and salvaged a four place finish forcing him to fun the "B" feature.

Pettitt started on the outside of the front row and won the 10-lap "B" feature. It was Pettitt's fourth top three finish in the "B."

Doerr was second, with Jason Throener of Pilger taking third. Doerr passed Throener with three laps left.

Heat races went to S. Matthies,

Carlson, Termansen and Johnson.

It was Termansen's third, Johnson's fourth, Carlson's third and Matthies first in the Street Stock division.

Roth, who attempted to go around both, finished third on the inside of Zuhlke.

It was Smith's second win of the season and his fifth top five in 10 "A" feature appearances. Zuhlke, who has won four "A" features this season, took his first second place finish. He has eight top five finishes.


R. Roth posted his eighth top five in his 12th "A" feature appearance.


his No. 2 machine during his heat race and was asked to step in for the vacationing Phillips.
