





The Street Stock driver said he knew he had his work cut out for him when Jim Johnson of Bloomfield got him early in the race. Termansen was forced to brake hard to avoid an incident allowing Johnson to get by.

He then knew it was going to be tough to get back by him. But that is when lady luck came into the picture.


Johnson was in the middle of a duel with Joel Carlson of Winside, when entering turn three Carlson had a tire go flat. Unable to control the car, he drifted high into four taking Johnson with him.

With the bottom of the track wide open, Termansen and Chris Johnson of Bloomfield zipped passed to take over third and fourth.

Termansen and C. Johnson, who came through the field together, grabbed the next spot getting by Mike Timm of Pierce a lap

For the next three laps they battled with Russ White of Norfolk, who had led a majority of the laps so far.

Taking the white flag, Termansen and C. Johnson battle side-by-side on the final lap, but Termansen would hold off C. Johnson to take his second straight feature win and his fourth in the last five nights. Johnson

nabbed his ninth top five, as White finished Nick Opfer of Hartington. All three third, his best run of the year.

"Bizarre" was the word Bancroft Grand National driver Curt Zuhlke described last Saturday night's Grand National "A" feature while Street Stock driver Kim Termansen of Yankton described his race as one big

Zuhlke also pointed to the full moon which came out during the Street Stock "C" feature. That is when the night got bizarre. Up to that point the caution flag only flew twice, during the Street Stock and Grand National heat races.

During the Street Stock "C" feature, Terry Walker of Norfolk took a wild ride through the guard rail in turn three, just after the moon became visible in the east.


Walker's accelerator stuck going down the back stretch and when he entered turn three he could not stop. Going straight up the banking, Walker punched his way through the guard rail and then flipped to his roof going down the hill on the outside of the track.

Track safety crews helped Walker from his car. Walker was able to walk

It was Bancroft Grand National driver Curt Zuhlke's fifth win of the season, as he battled long and hard with Reggie Roth, also of Bancroft, throughout most of the 25-lap race.

In fact, Zuhlke was so involved in racing Roth and Jay Smith of Norfolk that he did not even know he had won the race.

He said he thought he took the white flag, but thought Bob Milander of Norfolk was leading. Milander, who

was nearly a lap down, was spun out in turn two, and was a straight away ahead of the leaders, making it look like he may be the leader.



To start the night, Zuhlke said his engine developed a miss. Tearing the engine apart twice before the "A" feature. Zuhlke was not sure of what the problem was, but when the "A" feature began the car was perfect.

As Zuhlke got closer to Roth he noticed his competitor had a flat tire. oth continued to run hard, but had afficulty keep his nose in front of him the corners.


Zuhlke said he saw Roth had a flat, but knew the veteran would not back off. Finally on lap 22, he got by Phillips and Roth to take over the top spot.

Zuhlke would led last week's winner Smith across the line to take home win number five, as Smith grabbed his second runner-up finish and his sixth top five of the season.


Phillips would hold onto third, his first top five finish of the year in nine "A" feature appearances.

T. Roth had the best finish between the trio. He finished sixth.


Heat races went to Hansen, Robert Osborne of Norfolk and Vic Lovejoy of Meadow Grove.


In the points battle, Osborne regains


Heat races went to Chris Gulovsen of Norfolk, Carlson, Loecker and C. Johnson.

would leave fourth. A flat tire would send him to the pits, giving him a 14th place finish.


Darrell Doerr, who also never got to his best form, dropped to fifth, 51 points off the leader.






