





## Winside native outlasts brother battle

Street Stock driver Joel Carlson of Winside may not have had the fastest car on the track last Saturday night, but he was able to hold off the hard charging brother duo of Chris and Jim Johnson, both of Bloomfield, to win his second "A" feature of the year.

Chris Gulovsen of Norfolk led the first seven laps, to start off the "A" feature. Carlson started on the inside of row three and moved into second on the second lap.

While Carlson worked on Gulovsen, Jim Johnson was the first to catch the leaders. It became a three car battle for the lead.

Several cautions would slow the field and on the first two restart Carlson or Jim Johnson could not get by Gulovsen.

It took until the third restart for Carlson to take advantage of a slip up by Gulovsen to grab the lead.

Jim Johnson followed suit and set up the final eight lap shootout. Jim Johnson tried everything he could to get by Carlson, but the track was becoming too slick to pass.


Johnson looked at one point to have Carlson on the inside off turn four, but Carlson was able to block the move.

During the attempt, Chris Johnson became a contender, as he snuck his way

up to the back bumper of his younger brother.

With the slower car of Carlson holding up Jim Johnson, Chris Johnson used his momentum to get along side of Jim Johnson, but could not make the pass.

In a rookie season getting one "A" feature is an accomplishment, but to win a second is a even better.

Bancroft Grand National driver Travis Roth took advantage of a one groove race track Saturday night at Riviera Raceway to win his second feature of his career.

Roth, who began his career in the Grand National ranks this year, started his charge from the outside of row three and worked his way to the front in five laps, passing Doug Tomka of Norfolk for the lead.

As Roth was making his way to the front, the track got dry slick making the high side and the middle of the track nearly impossible to use.

With Roth out in the lead, the next five spots became filled with the top drivers in the division, as Jay Smith of Norfolk, Curt Zuhlke of Bancroft, Reggie Roth of Bancroft, Vic Lovejoy of Meadow Grove and Robert Osborne of Norfolk got into line behind Travis Roth.

But with the only line around the track on the very bottom, nobody dared to try and make a move on the outside.

Smith was able to get on the inside of Travis Roth coming off the corners, but could not muscle his way passed down the straightaways.

Osborne said he tried the outside line once, but quickly moved back down.

Reggie Roth made an attempt to advance to third place, taking it from Zuhlke.

Zuhlke wanted nothing to do with that and he then made a charge on the second

place car of Smith.

Each lap Zuhlke was only able to get a nose under Smith coming out of the turns and sometimes sticking his nose in front but was unable make the pass.


As Smith and Zuhlke raced, Travis Roth remained smooth and pulled away from field to easily take the win.

In the final laps Zuhlke was able pull along side Smith and made the pass to finish second with Smith taking third.


Reggie Roth was fourth and Lovejoy finished out the top five.

Travis Roth has raced in all the "A" feature this season and has recorded four top five finishes.

Only two other drivers have run all 14 "A" features - Reggie Roth and Robert

The "B" feature was won by points leader Osborne. He was forced to run the qualifying race when he went three wide with Keith Hansen and Jeff Haase in his heat. Osborne's right front climbed over Hansen's left front sending both drivers to rear of the field.

Osborne got the car back together and ran down Scott Phillips of Norfolk in the "B" feature. Phillips took second and Hansen was third.

Winning their heat races were: Smith, Reggie Roth and Lovejoy. Lovejoy collected his fourth of the year, as Smith nabbed his fifth.


Despite ending his string of heat race wins the previous week, Reggie Roth got back in the saddle and won his 13th of the year.

However, he nearly gave it away when he almost looped in turn four. He had built up enough of a lead and had plenty of horsepower to stay out front.

It is down to five weeks left in the season counting tonight, and after running 14 weeks, the points battle is at one point.

Osborne holds an edge over Reggie Roth 1010-1009. Osborne has 11 top-five finishes to Reggie Roth's nine.


Zuhlke sits third in the points 71 points back from the leader. Lovejoy and Travis Roth are forth and fifth, respectively. Lovejoy holds the edge by four points.

The brother duo would run the final laps side-by-side and out of turn four on the final lap, Chris Johnson edged out Jim Johnson and nearly was able to get along side Carlson.

Carlson took home his second win of the season, his sixth top five in 12 "A" feature appearances.

Chris Johnson finished second for the second week in a row. He leads the field in top five finishes with 10. Jim Johnson finished third for his ninth top five.

Rounding out the top five finishers

were: Travis Loecker of Bloomfield fourth and Chris Gulovsen fifth. For Gulovsen, it was his best finish of the season and his third "A" feature appearance.

Jason Throener of Pilger found himself winning the "B" feature. It was his second consecutive win. Bernie Berck of Norfolk was second and Josh Derickson of Hartington finished third.

Derickson also had to make it through the "C" feature, where he was second to Jim Kimmel of Norfolk.

Kimmel had one of the those nights to forget. In his heat race he was knocked out of the race, when John Dunklau of Norfolk went to hot into turn three, nailing Kimmel in the left front.

In the "B" Kimmel was meat of the sandwich when Jason Jensen got sideways causing a chain reaction. Kimmel again was struck hard. He did manage to finish fifth.

Winning the heat races were: Ron Pettitt of Pierce, Chris Johnson, Loecker and Kim Termansen of Yankton.

In the points battle, the top spot changed hands again. Despite Loecker's seventh straight top five finish, he still finds himself trailing by one point. He went in to the night down to Termansen and now trails to Chris Johnson.

Termansen dropped to third, as Jim Johnson moves to fourth from sixth. Sitting fifth is Pettitt, down one position.
