





Champion scores win

He began pacing the field on lap seven. He led


the final 19 laps for the win.

Doug Tomka of Stanton took second place for the second time this season.


He started on the inside of the fifth row. He broke into the top 3 on lap 10 behind Johnson and Eric Vanosdall of Winside.

He inherited the runner-up position when Eric Vanosdall of Winside slipped up on the dry-slick surface.


Chad Jensen of Norfolk got by Haase on lap 18. Robert Osborne of Norfolk finished fourth and Haase rounded out the top 5.



Tad Behmer (20) slid too far in his heat race and spun out in front of Heath Harrison (53). Behmer got airborne




Doug Tomka (1) tied his best finish of the season with a second place.




Chris Johnson celebrates after winning the "A" feature.




Eric Vanosdall (9) runs second to Chris Johnson (7) in the "A" feature.

Bruns only led one lap, but it was the important lap. Bruns was sent to the rear of the field during the first lap of the feature and had to come through the 10-car field.



On the next laps, Mielke and Chad Bruns were still side-by-side until Mielke lost it on his own.






Chad Bruns (11) celebrates after winning the "A" feature.




Troy Bruns (75) took a fourth place finish in the "A" feature.



Travis Birkley (78) has a slight advantage over Chad Bruns (11) when they took the white flag. However, Bruns had the edge over Birkley at the checkered flags.





Spann back to winning




