Hurlbert takes first victory

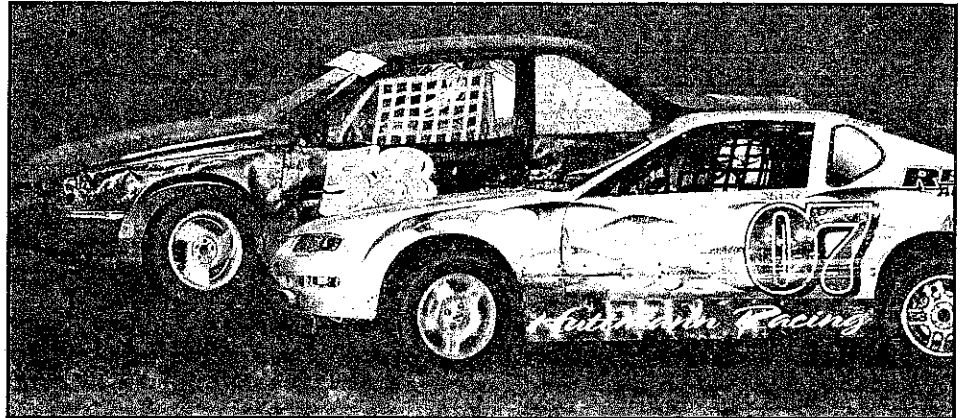
Grant Hurlbert of Winside can easily remember his first Hobby Stock victory and last week, he got to share his brother's first victory.

Garet Hurlbert of Winside piloted his 4-cylinder from his seventh start position to the front in four laps.

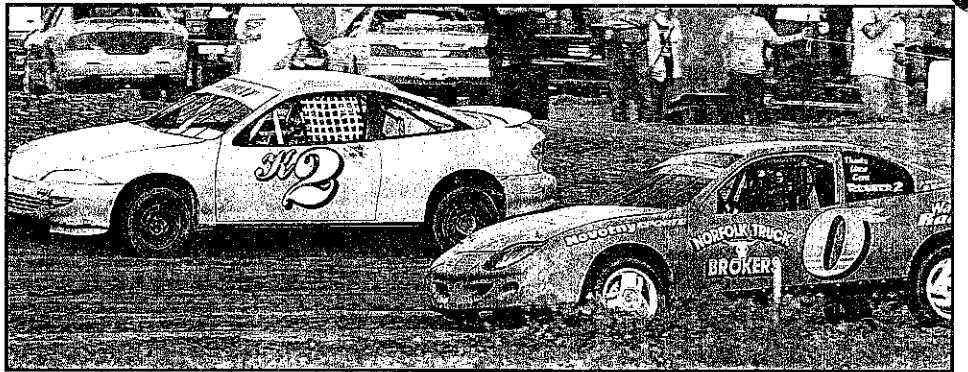
Hurlbert started on the inside of the fourth row and was contending for the third spot by the end of the first lap. He was second on the second lap and leading by the third lap.

The race went uninterrupted once it got started. Stacie Huttmann of Stanton came up one position short of extending the female win streak – which was at three.

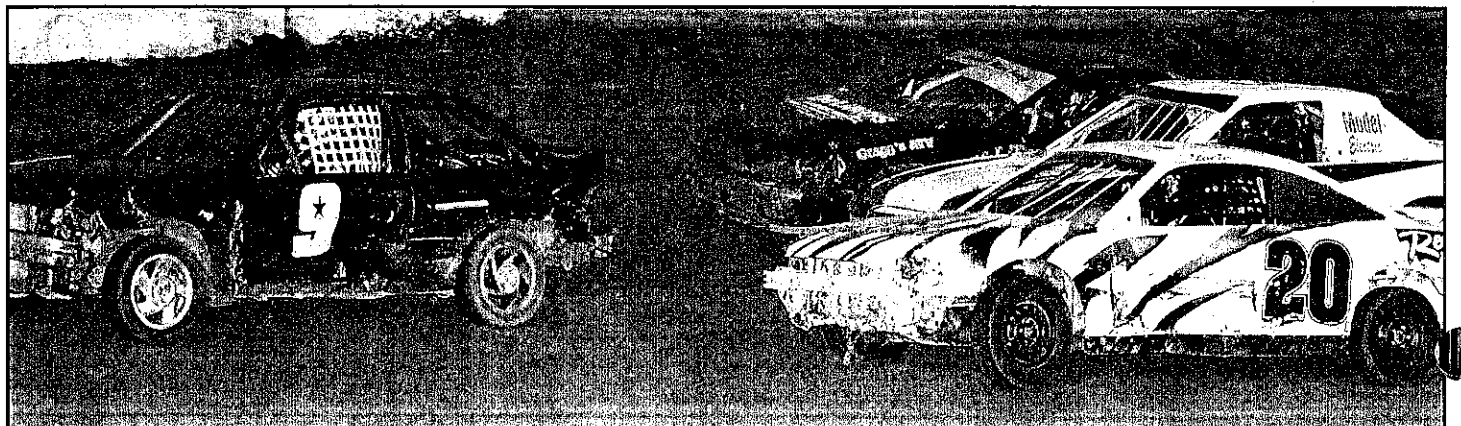
Huttmann finished second and Jordan Uehling of Neligh was third.



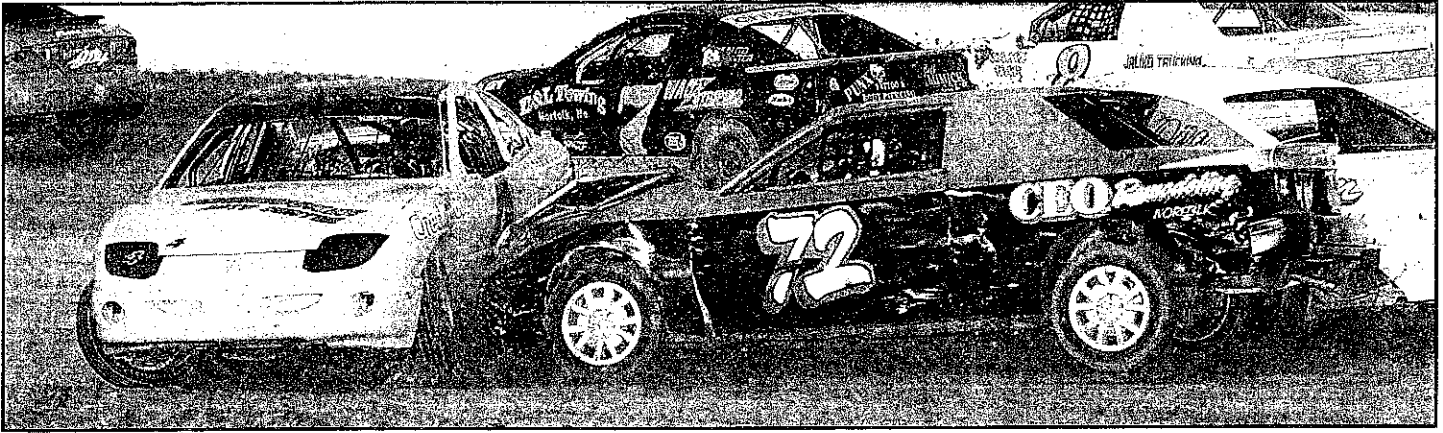

Bruns' car takes win with Behmer driving

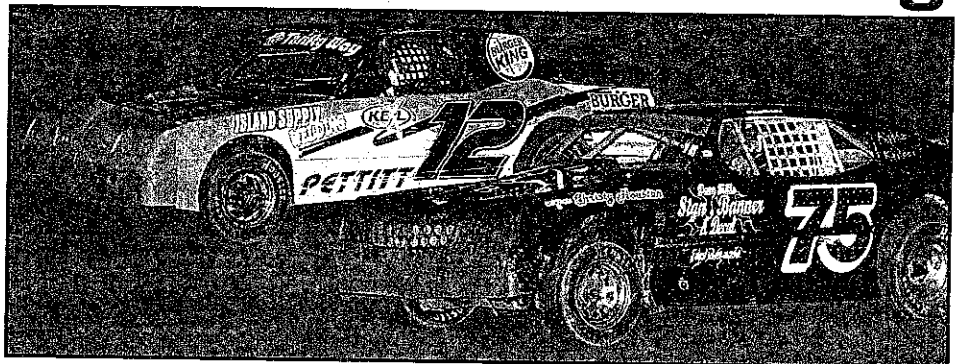
It was the second straight feature win for the Street Stock that pulled into victory lane last week; however, it was the second driver to pilot the car to the win.

of the race with a flat tire.

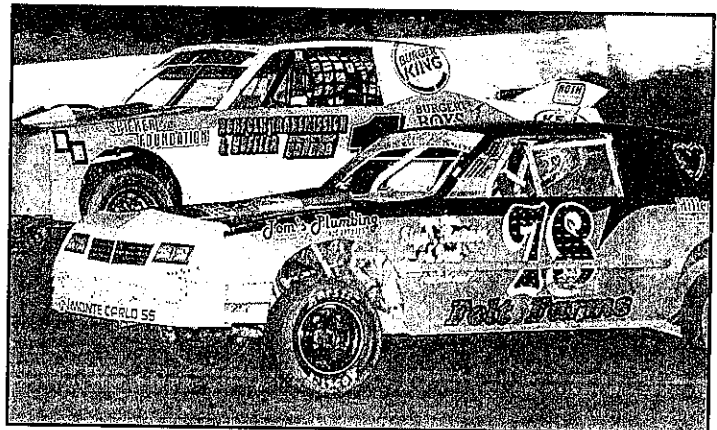
Troy Bruns, Chad's brother, ran second to Behmer for the last half of the race to take second. TeJay Mielke

of Norfolk crossed the line third, but he lost several weights to make his car too light. He was penalized giving Ron Pettitt of Norfolk the third spot.

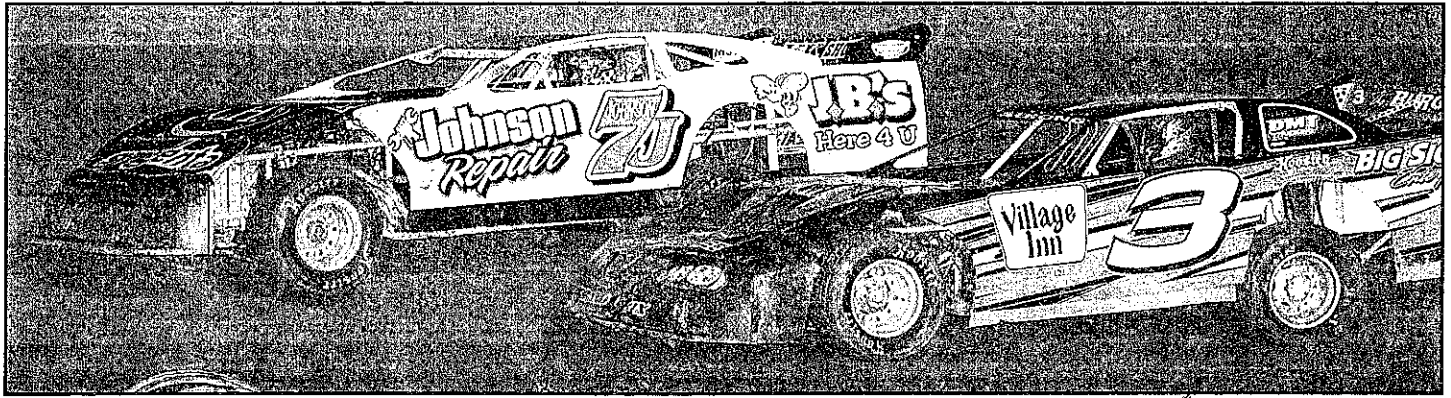

JR Strong of Norfolk started on the pole and led the first four laps before Johnson went from his outside third row starting position to the front.

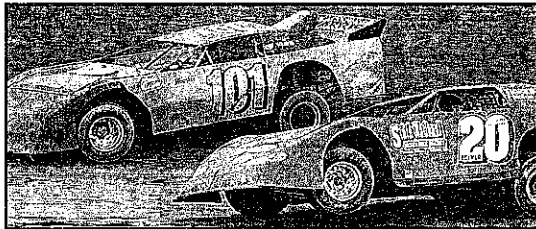
Strong held onto the second spot until lap 19 of the 25 laps run. Chad Jensen of Norfolk was the first to get by and

Robert Osborne of Norfolk was next.

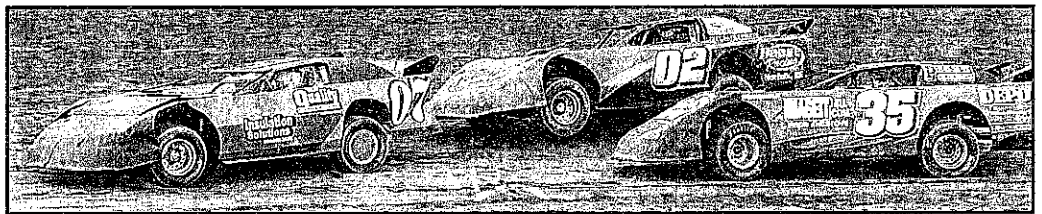
Osborne jumped passed Jensen for second a lap later and set out to catch Johnson. He would come up a car length short of taking the win.

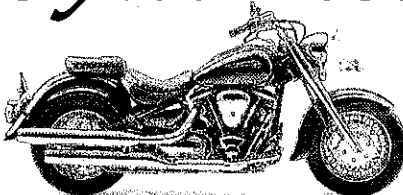

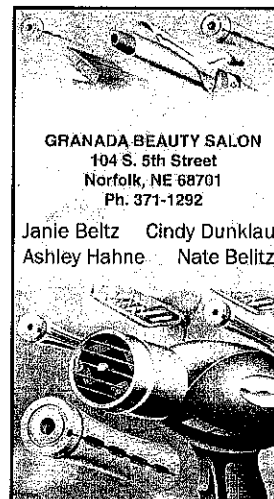

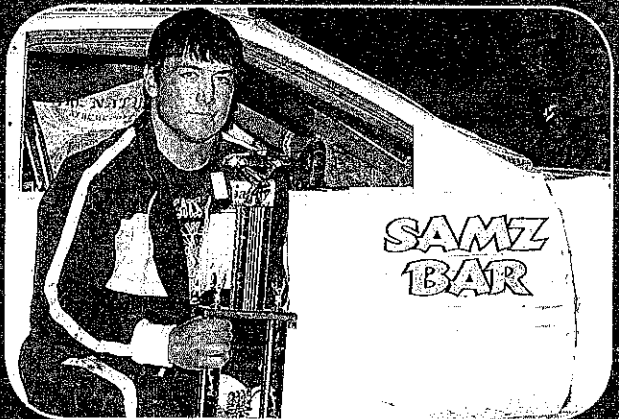
