



Sehi flies sky high with win


Derek and Marcus Sehi of Neligh started racing back in 2007 and have switched off driving the No. 16 since then.

However, a slower vehicle spun out in front of them and Haase tagged the spun vehicle just hard enough to take out his radiator.


Sehi took his first career win at the track, Behmer was second and Jim Kimmel of Norfolk was third.

Jereme Knoell of Petersburg finished fourth and rounding out the top 5 was Jake Timm of Pierce.




Jake Timm (29) won his third heat race. He later took fifth in the main


Kent Behmer (94) and Tate Weinrich (46) slid into the infield during their heat. Behmer finished second later in the "A" feature.





It was Haase's first win since 2006. Birkley took second and TeJay Mielke of Norfolk finished third.


Shawn Primrose took fourth. Rounding out the top 5 was Ryan Rohde of Carroll.





Johnson victorious again


Chris Johnson of Bloomfield outlasted the six cautions that plagued the 25-lap race.

Johnson started on the inside of the third row. He broke into the top three on lap five. He was second by lap 16. It was his 16th Grand National win at the track.


Robert Osborne of Norfolk took his eighth top 5, placing second. Third went to Tomka.







Rodgers does it again

The one thing Jared Rodgers of Norfolk learned the previous week that patience helps win races. Saturday night, Rodgers was sitting third and could have aggressively gone for the win.

But he sat back and the lead came to him.

He had just got position on the second place car of Nelson Vollbrecht of Stanton when leader Katie Wagner of Norfolk got a flat tire and pulled into the infield.

That put Rodgers out front and leading again. He led the final five laps. It was his second straight win.

Ryne Hoffart of Norfolk slipped past Vollbrecht two laps from the end to take second. Vollbrecht took third. Fourth went to newcomer Jeff Goodier of South Sioux City. Rounding out the top five was Stacie Huttmann of Stanton.




