





It was the only feature to run straight through to the end without a caution.


Starting on the inside of the third row, Sloan jumped in to the second spot on the second lap.



The high line pulled Haase back out front of the field, as Tomka circled the track on the low side. Tomka could get into the corner, but found no grip exiting the turn.


Haase had the momentum on the high side

Third went to Robert Osborne of Norfolk. He moved into the spot on lap 17. He took a shot could not get the bit off the




Chad Jensen (35) and Robert Osborne (35) compete in his heat race. place finish for his 11th top 5 of the season.







Primrose takes fourth victory


Shawn Primrose of Norfolk blew a motor before last week at Boone County Raceway and had to drop a new motor into the #1 machine.

But the track was not kind to horsepower, as feathering the throttle off the corners was more important.






Ron Pettitt (12) runs with Dale Primrose, Jr. (4) in their heat race. Pettitt took a fourth place finish in the "A" feature.




