

Huttmann started on the pole and never looked back. He captured the win with plenty of room to spare. Stacie Huttmann had finished second in three different occasions.


Tony Coover of Norfolk,

subbing for Adam Wagner, took home second after passing Shannon Pospisil of Norfolk for the position on lap two.


Kandie Haase of Norfolk was next to pass Pospisil for the third spot, but she only held the position for only eight laps.

Fourth went to Garet Hurlbert and rounding out the top was Pospisil.









Saturday night he picked up his first career "A" feature win; a win where he left


everybody in his wake.

Weinrich started on the outside pole and led the entire 15-lap race which went uninterrupted.


Tracy Buck of Neligh held the second position for six laps before Matt Haase of

Kent Behmer of Norfolk then got on lap 11 to take third. Fourth we Kimmel and fifth to Jon Langenberg Norfolk.








Kent Behmer (94) passes Kevin Haase (9) in turn two. Behmer finished third in the feature.






Johnson opened up a two second

He caught slower cars on lap 14 and more on lap 22. Johnson picked up his fourth win of the season. Osborne finished


second for the fourth time and Jim Johnson took third, which was his third time this season.

Chad Jensen of Norfolk was fourth and BJ Haase was fifth.




Chad Jensen (73) races to a fourth place finish in the "A" feature. Eric Vanosdall (9) took seventh.




Birkley led four laps, before Shawn Primrose blasted out front to lead the final eight laps.

TeJay Mielke of Norfolk also mixed it up with the leaders, but never led a lap.


When it was over Primrose won his fifth feature of the season, Mielke was second and Birkley finished third.

Fourth went to Pettitt and Eric Haase of Norfolk was fifth.


