



Arduser takes the checkered flags first

Mark Arduser of Battle Creek started on the outside of the fourth row during the main feature last week, five laps later he was leading the show.

Arduser slipped by Dave Hille of Pierce, who led the first four laps.

Arduser had little trouble with the win. Tate Weinrich of Norfolk came from the fifth row to finish second. He broke into the top 3 on lap 10 of 15. He was second two laps later, getting by Kevin Haase of Norfolk

Third went to Jeremy Brabec of Stanton. Brabec locked horns with defending points champion Sean Spann of Wayne.

Spann had a slight lead on Brabec taking the white flag, but Brabec was able to edge out Spann to take the

checkers third.


Spann was fourth, with Haase rounding out the top 5.

Matt Haase of Norfolk won the "B" feature with Tracy Buck of Neligh and Dale Bittner of Norfolk taking the other two transfer spots. Matt Haase had the highest finish of the three in the "A"







Mielke brings it home

He got by on lap 10 for the win. The battle came


behind them with Bruns, Travis Birkley of Wakefield and Primrose.

Bruns moved around Sievers on lap 12. Primrose got by Sievers with three laps remaining for third.


Chad Bruns of Wayne finished fourth and Ron Pettitt of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.

With the win, Mielke moves out front in the points, two points ahead of Primrose. He gained three positions. Primrose remains second.






the first lap before Vanosdall jumped out front to pace the field. By lap six, Roth moved into the second spot.


Roth then settled in behind Vanosdall, who was running the high side, and patiently waited for an opening. However, the first yellow flag was displayed first slowing the field.


On the restart, Roth nearly lost his second spot when Robert Osborne of Norfolk went to the bottom and got by, but the second caution came out and erased the pass.
