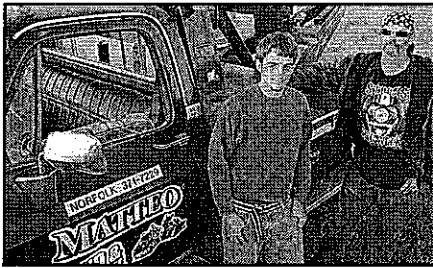

Bruns family goes 1-2 on opening night

Leading every lap from the pole position, Troy Bruns of Wayne ran a smooth consistent Street Stock "A" feature race and picked up his third Riviera career win.

Troy Bruns' brother, Chad Bruns also of Wayne, finished second and Brad Vogt of Pierce was third.

Troy Bruns made it look simple, but Jon Haase of Plainview did not make it easy. Haase made several attempts to get by Bruns, but was unable to complete the pass.

Chad Bruns started mixing it up with Haase on lap three, however, it was not until after the first of two cautions that Chad Bruns made the pass on lap 5.

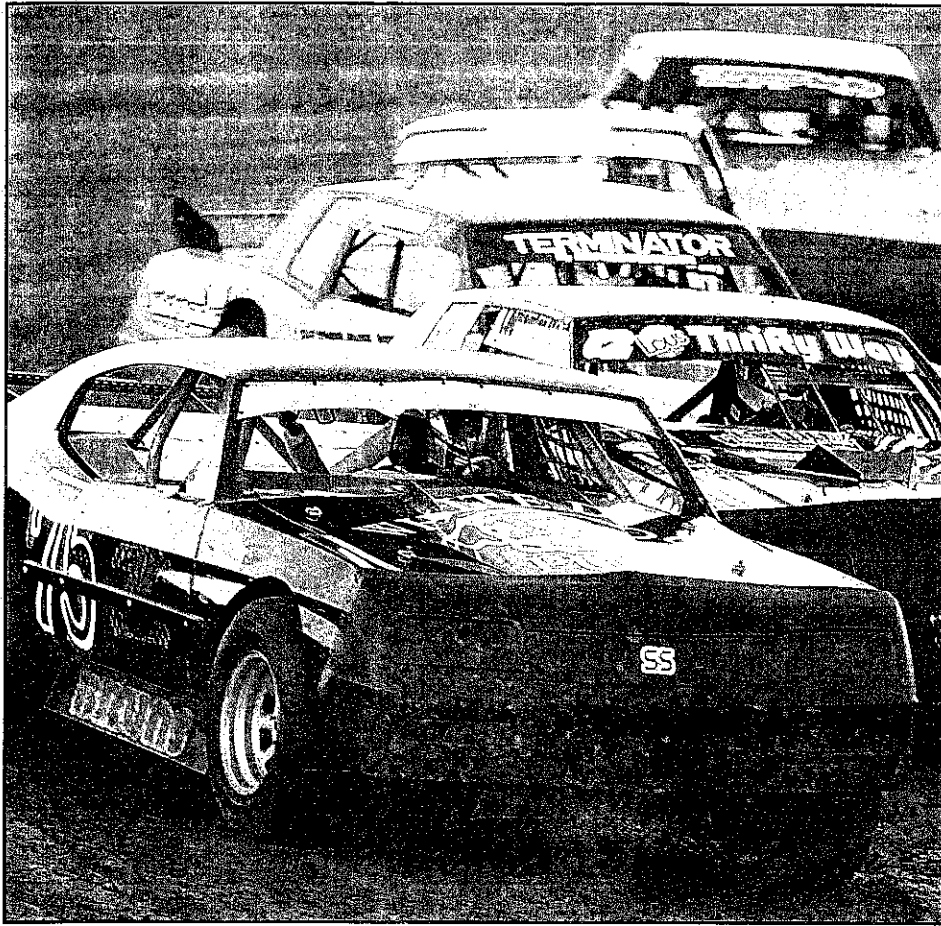
Haase fell back to fourth by lap eight and in a last attempt challenged Chad Bruns again by lap 10.

The final caution came out after the completion of lap 10. On the restart, Haase then had his hands full with Vogt, who came from the 12th place starting position.

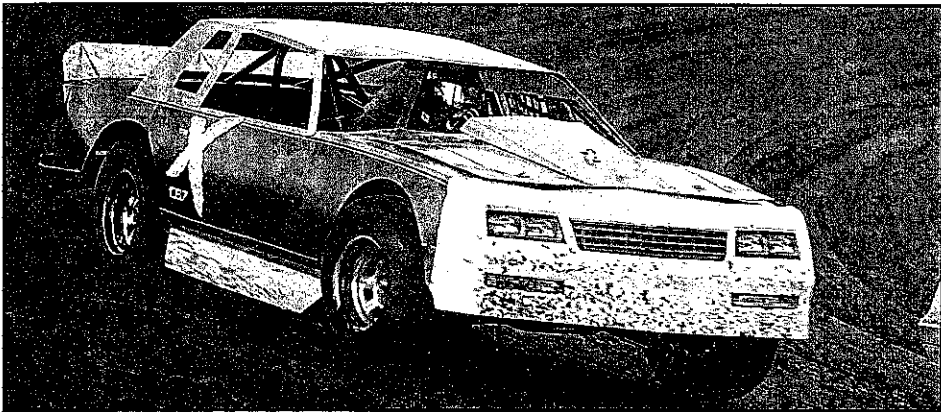
By lap 15 of the 18-lap feature, Vogt was side-by-side with Chad Bruns, but Bruns held off the charging Vogt.

The Bruns brothers were first and second, as Vogt was third. Haase came through fourth and Tad Behmer of Winside rounded out the top 5.

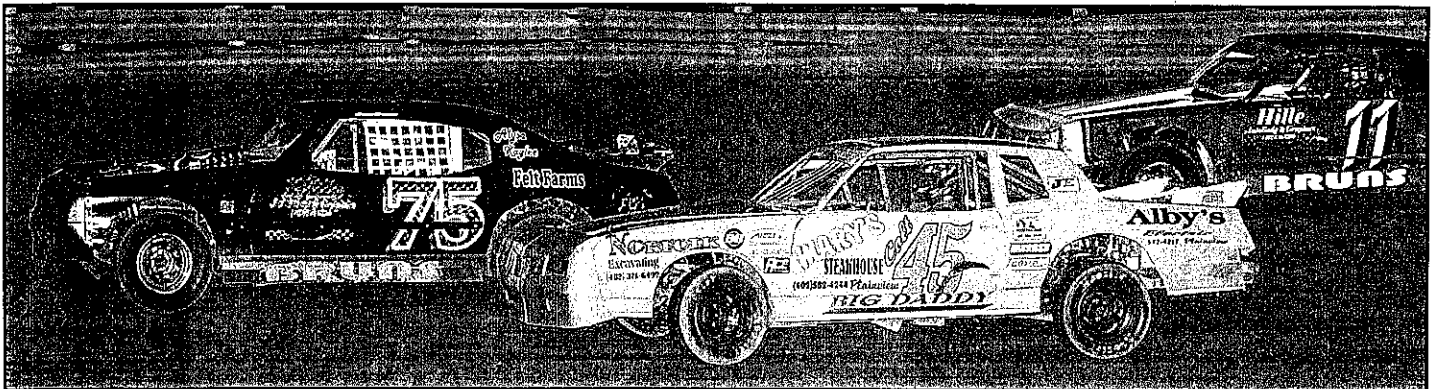

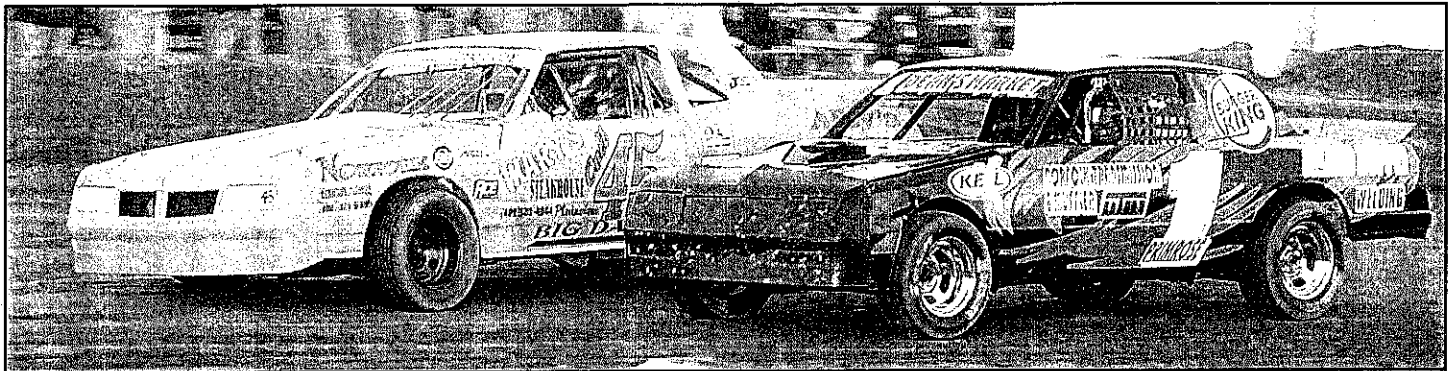
Troy Bruns leads his heat race which he won. He also win the "A" feature.

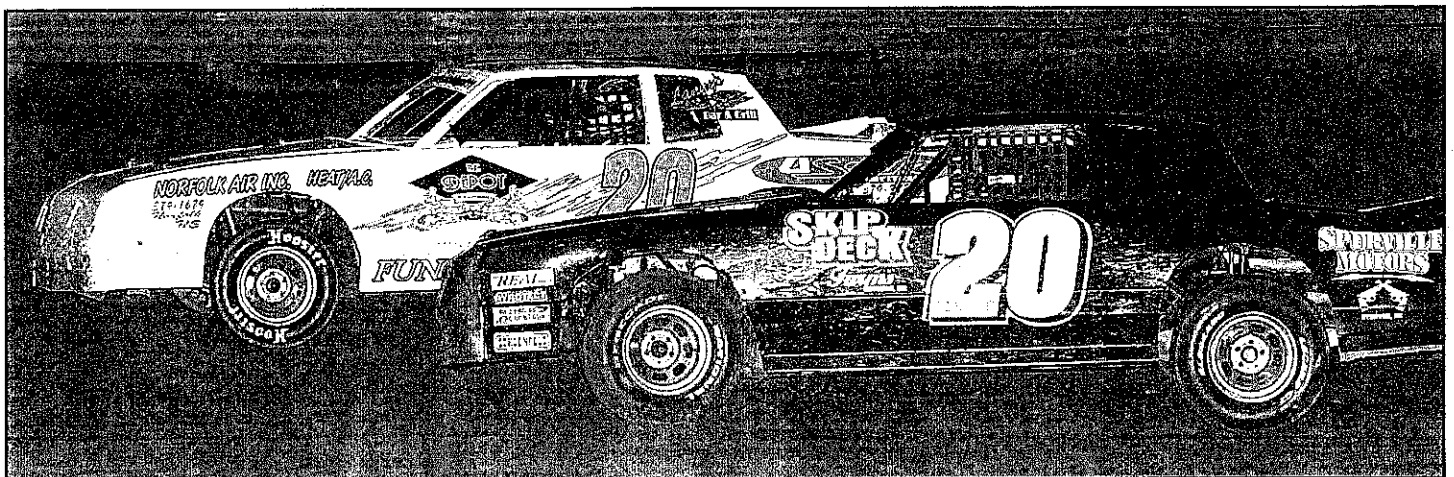

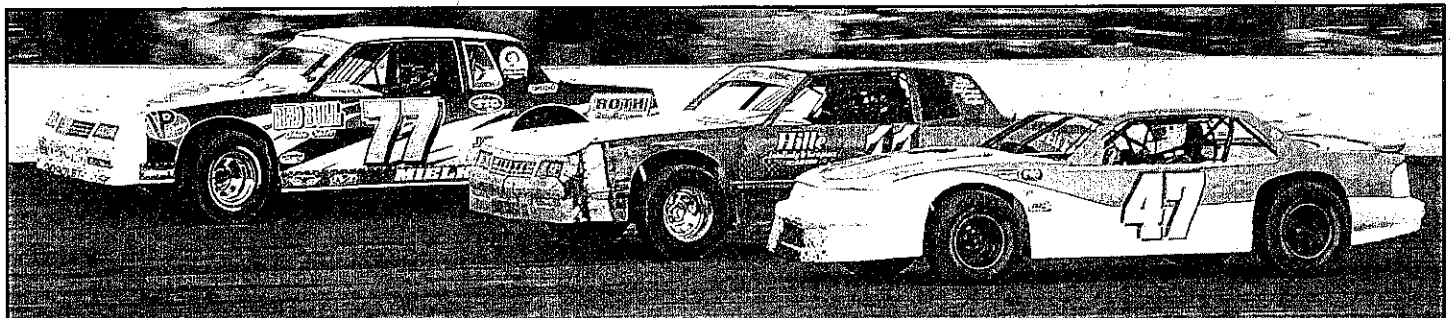

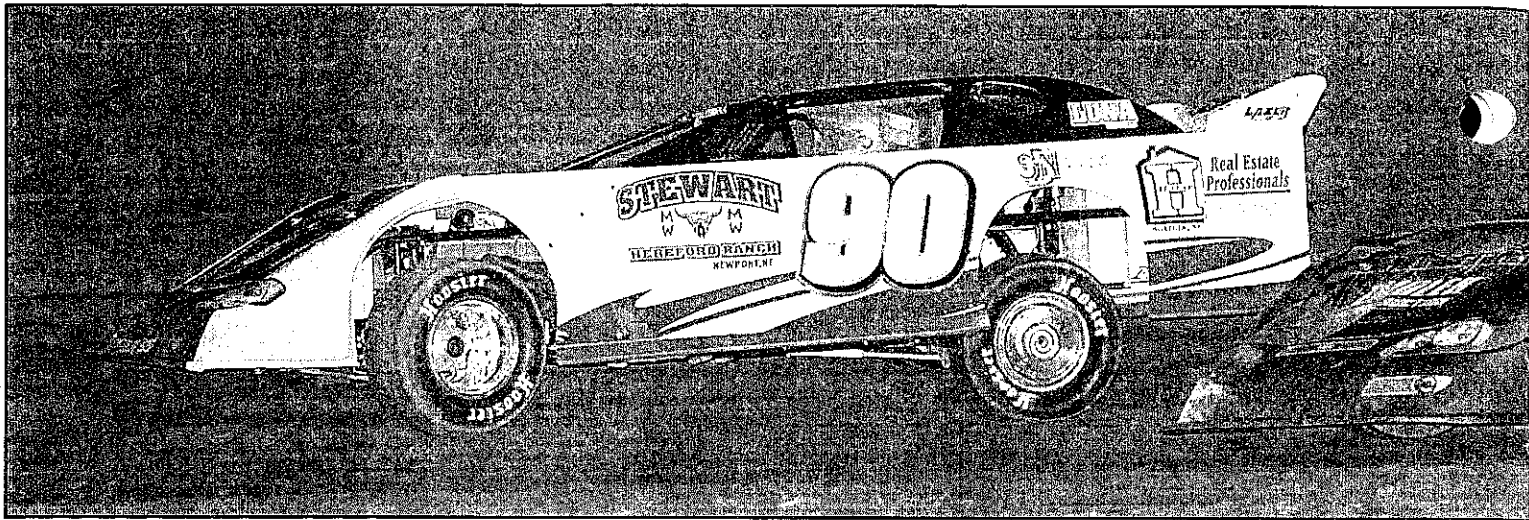

Caldwell claims first feature win of season

Taylor Caldwell of Stanton led 20 laps last week to pick up his second career win at Riviera Raceway. Chris Johnson of Bloomfield took second and brother Jim Johnson of Plainview finished third.

Caldwell started on the outside pole and led the first 15 laps. Doug Tomka, also of Stanton, was challenging Caldwell for most of those laps.

The two ran side-by-side pass the start-finish line three laps in a row, before Tomka made the pass on the fourth year driver.

Tomka settled into the top spot and paced

the 15-car field for five laps. However, when he caught lapped traffic, Caldwell closed in on Tomka.

With two lapped cars battling side-by-side for position, Tomka was held up. Caldwell had a hole open up for him and he raced back into the lead.

Tomka tried to slip passed to maintain the lead, but was caught up in an incident that crippled his car and ended his night.

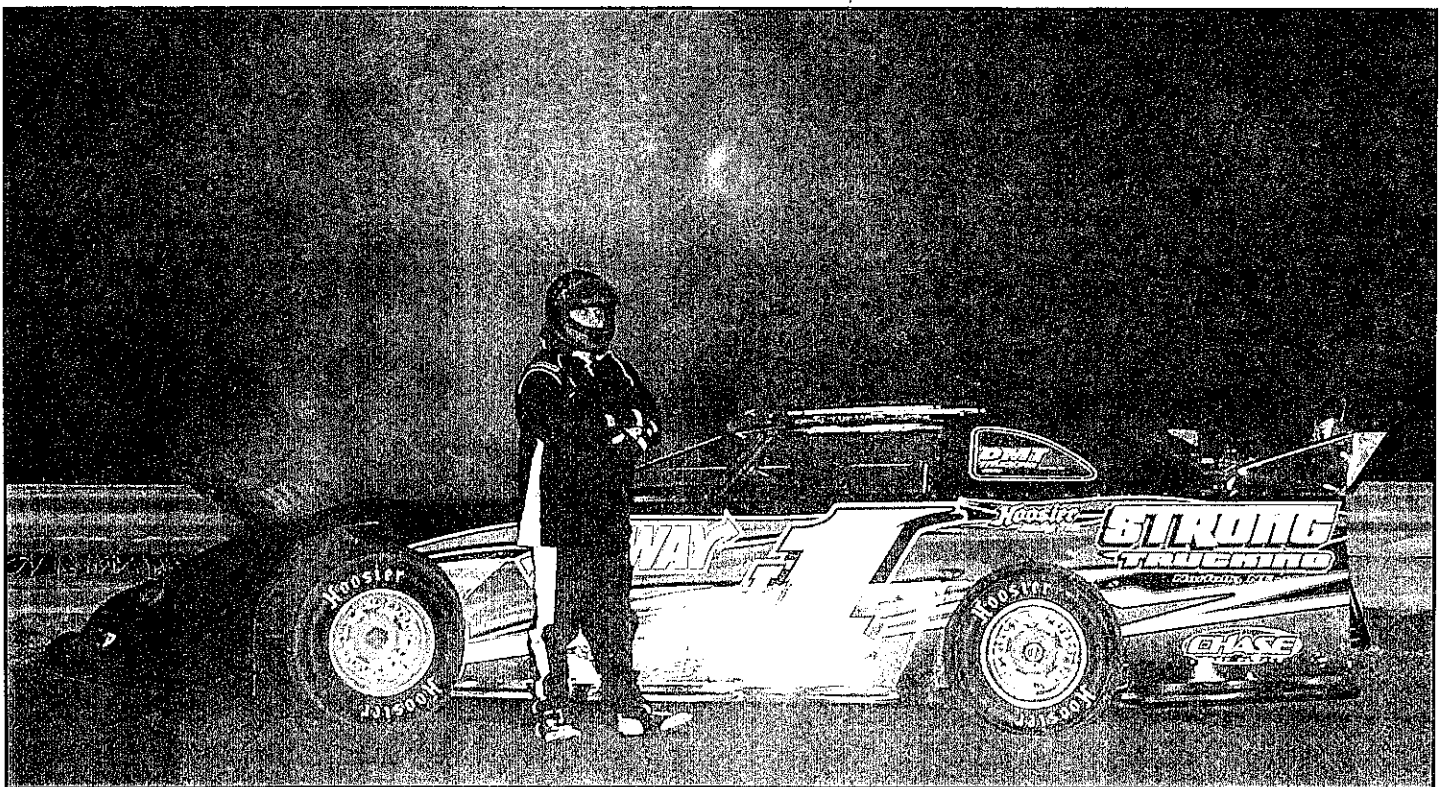
With Tomka out, Caldwell was leading, multi-defending champion Robert Osborne of Norfolk was second, Jim Johnson third and

Chris Johnson fourth.

On the restart, Caldwell went to lead the field. Osborne had trouble in turns one and two and had to avoid spinning out, which gave the green light to pass. In one corner, Caldwell fell to fourth.

Chris Johnson came out a hot contender. The final laps remained tight between Caldwell and Johnson.

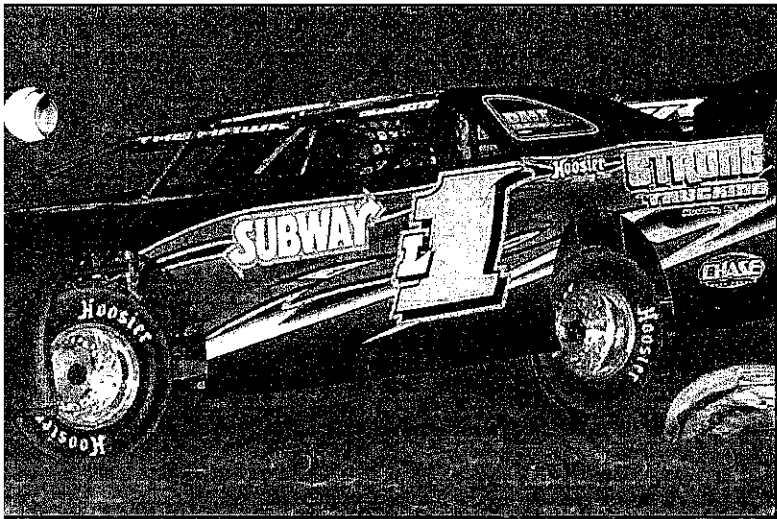

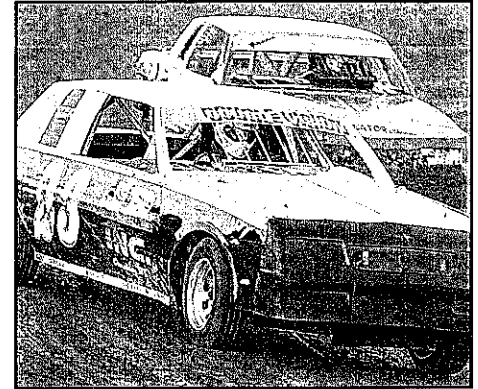

Johnny Kirby of Wisner led the first four laps before Wilkinson came from his seventh place starting position to take the lead.

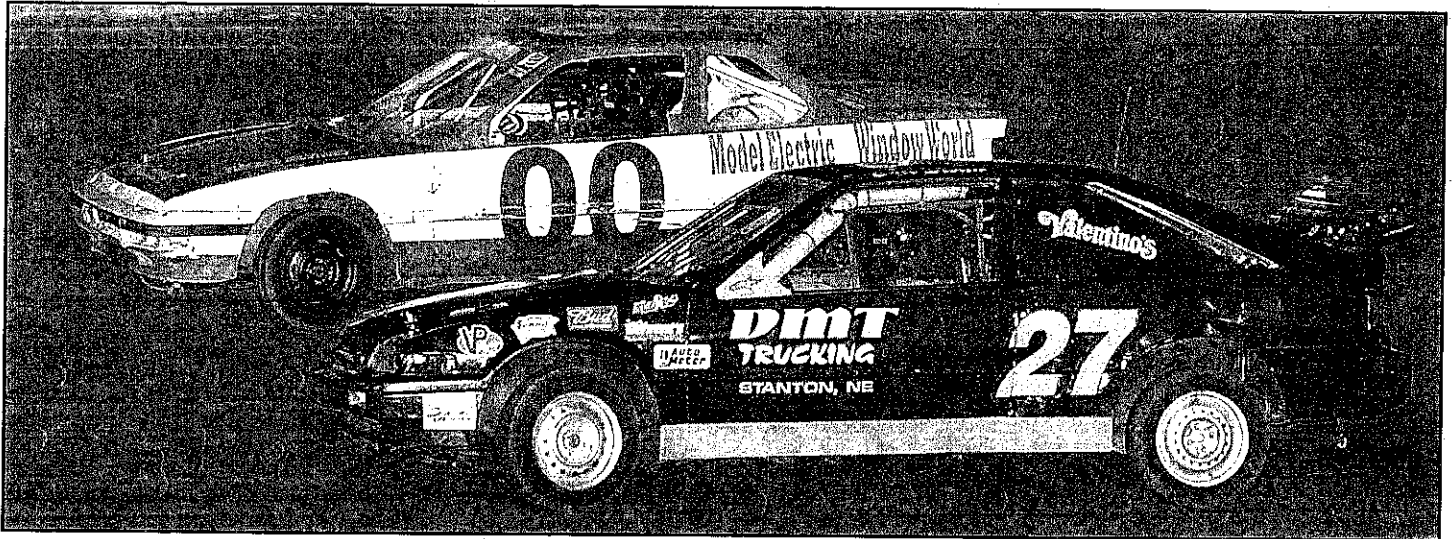
Dale Bittner of Norfolk finished fourth and Tim Kruse of Norfolk finished fifth.

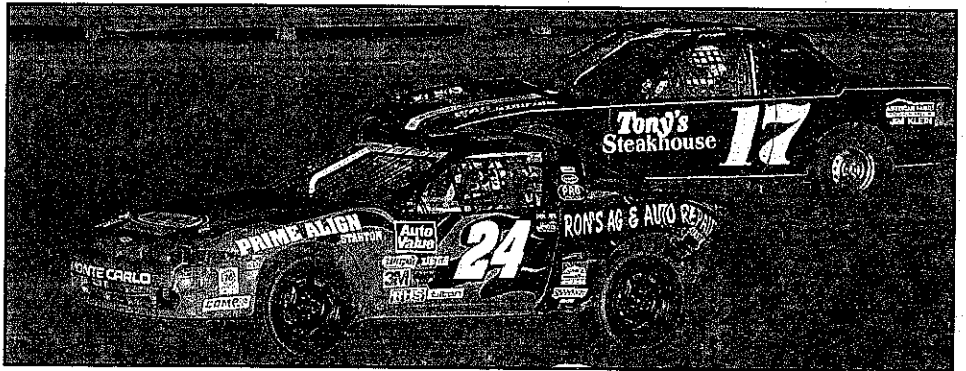

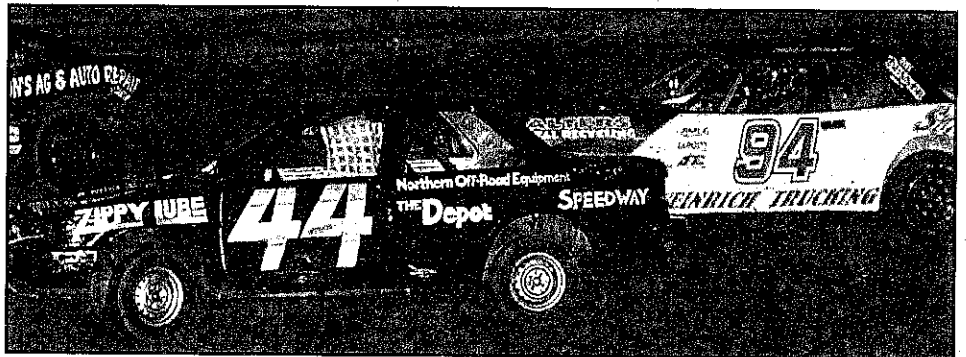
Eric Sloan won the final two Hornet "A" features at the end of last season and started this season with a win.

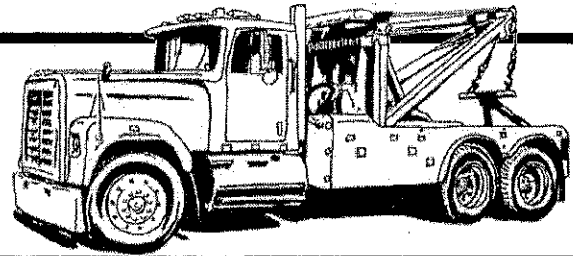

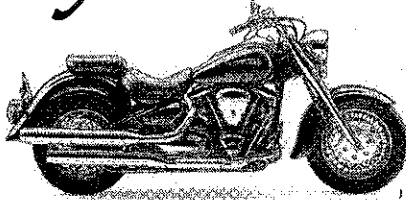

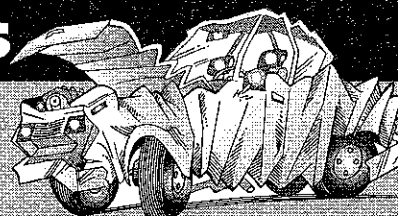
