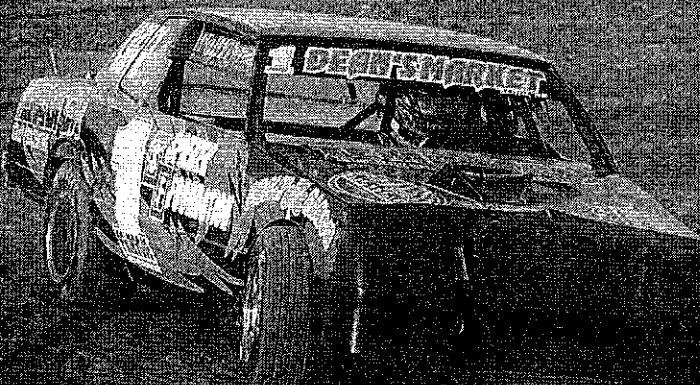

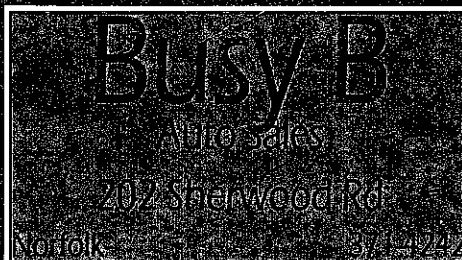

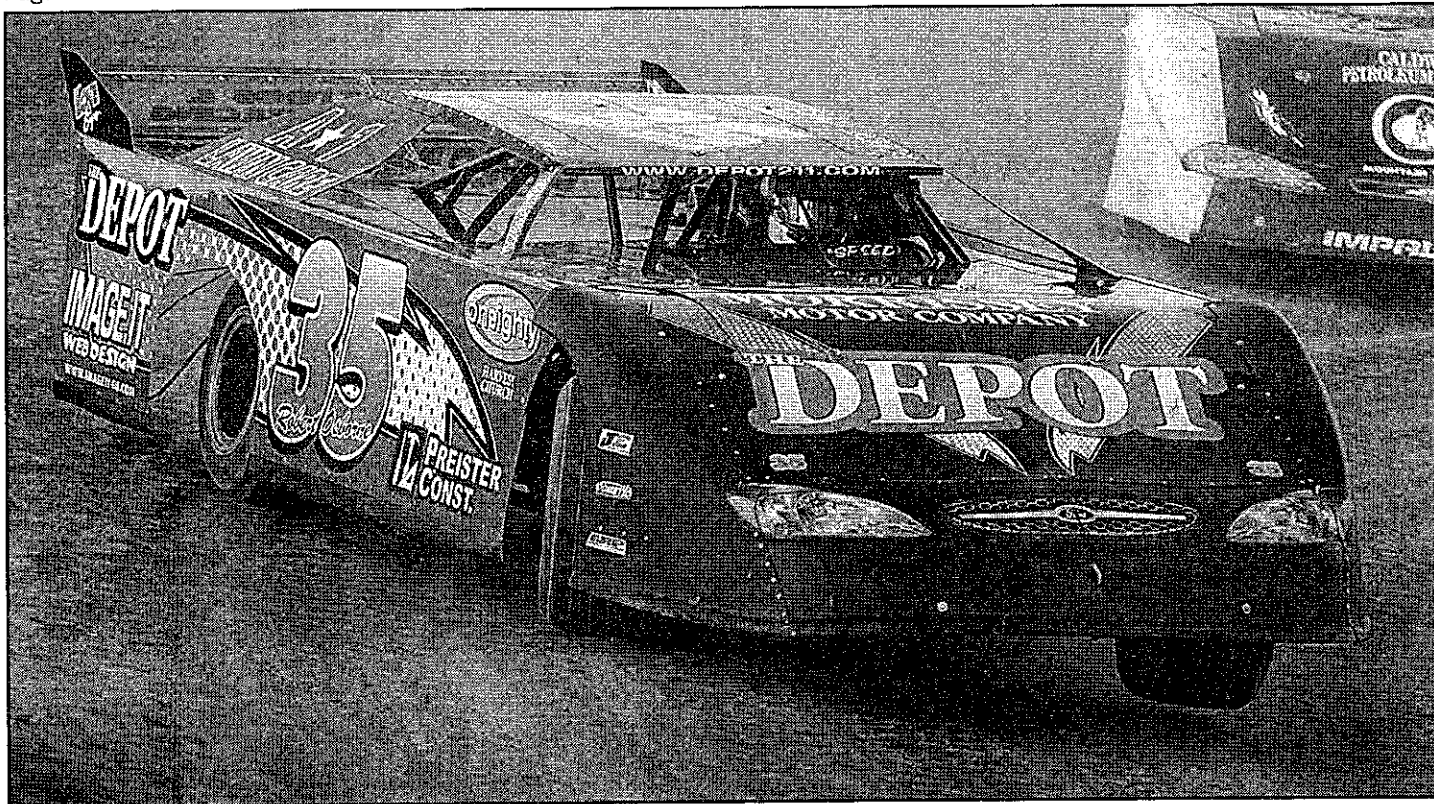

Robert Osborne of Norfolk claimed the win from his 10th place starting position. Osborne led the final 10 laps for the win.

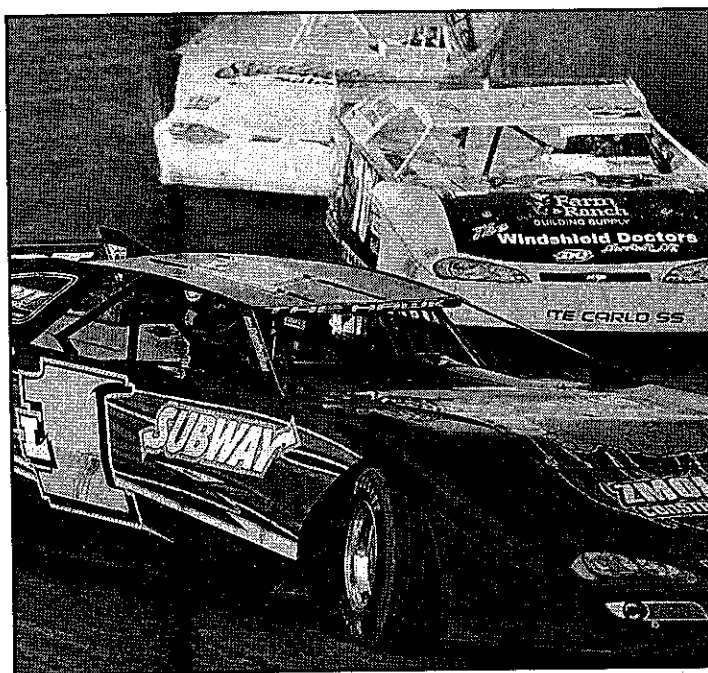
He first cracked the top 3 on lap 10 following the fourth caution.

Three laps later, the leader at the time ended his night in the wall. Doug Tomka of Stanton led the most laps in the race, but something

broke on his car while he was being challenged by Chad Jensen of Norfolk for the top spot. Jensen inherited the lead. However, he only led for three laps before Osborne moved out front to pick up his first win of the season.

Jensen ran second and as the previous winner Taylor Caldwell of Stanton finished third.

Chris Johnson of Bloomfield took home fourth and BJ Haase of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.

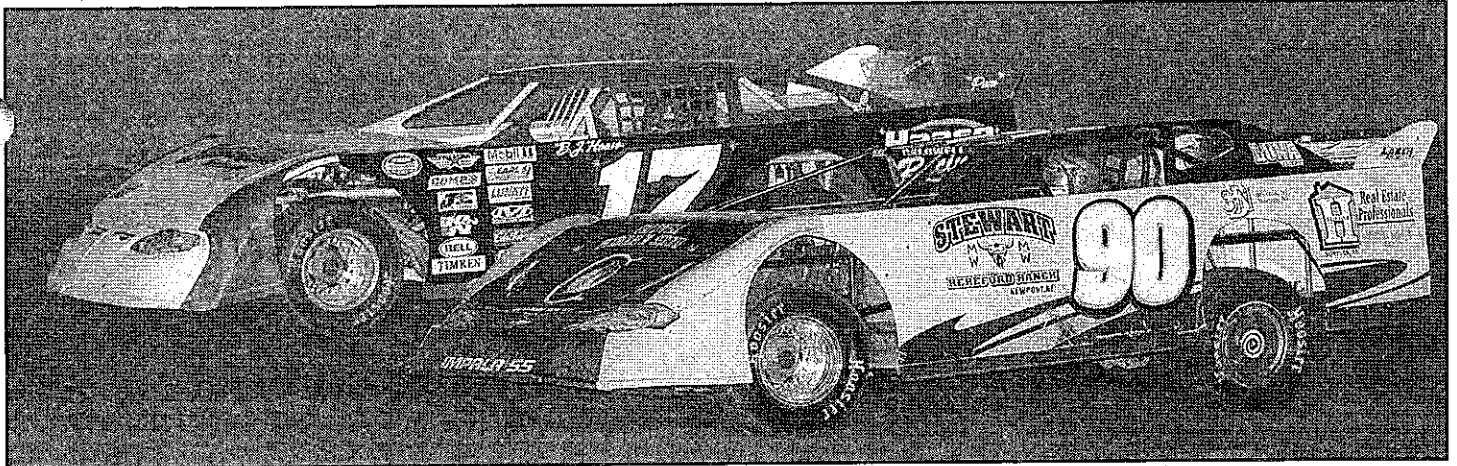


Doug Tomka was on pace to win both his heat race and "A" feature. He got the heat win, however, his night ended on the hook – again while he was leading the main event.

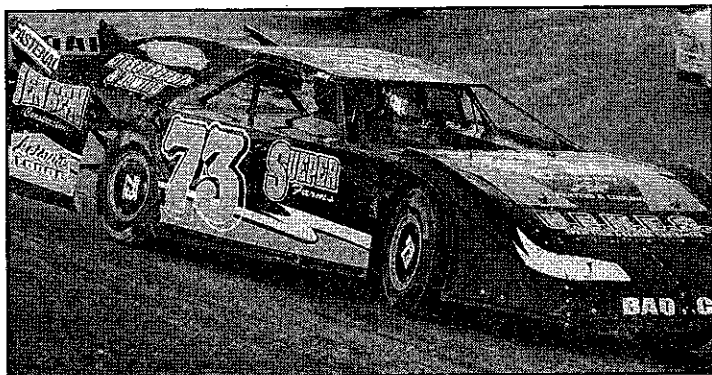

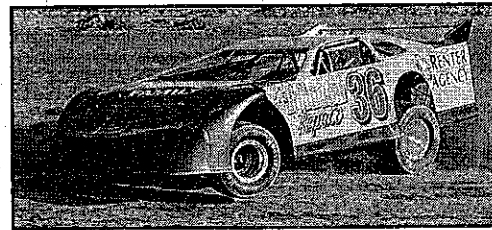

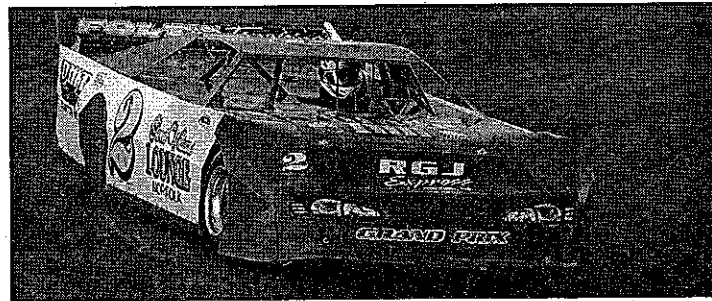
Chad Jensen (73) leads a pack in his heat race which he won. He placed second in the "A" feature, after leading five laps.



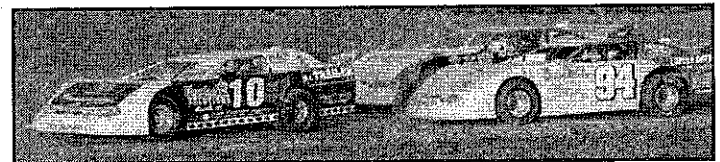

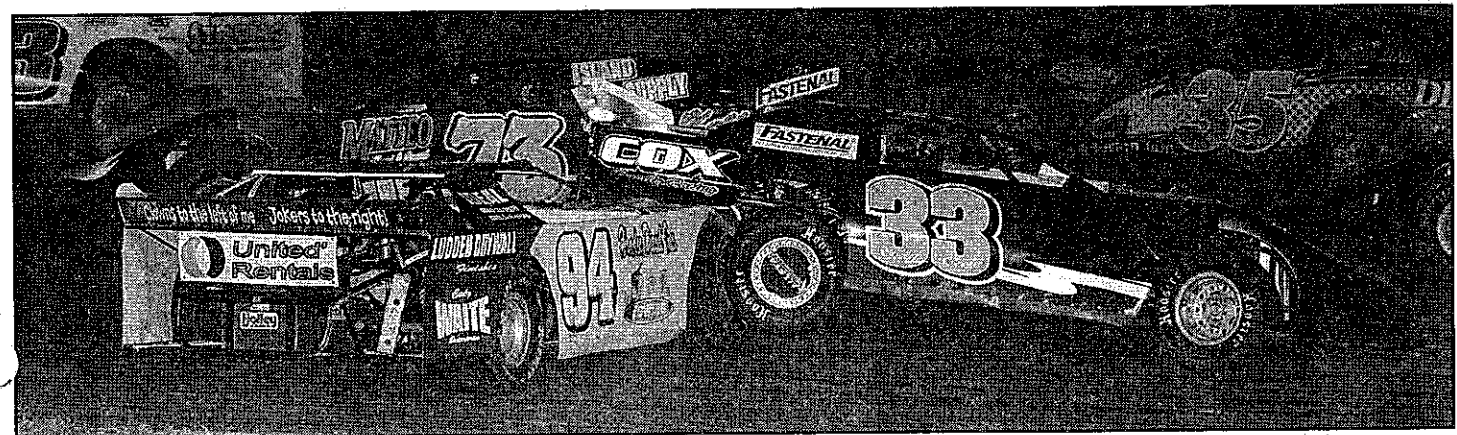

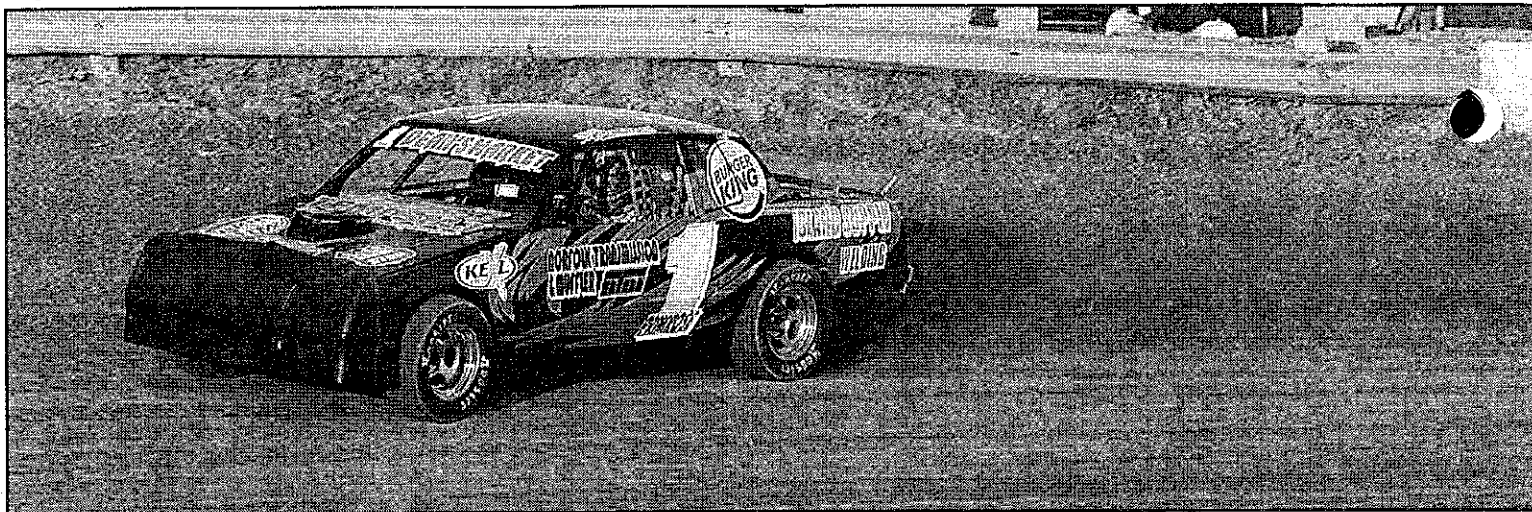
Jeff Foltz (2) exits turn four during his heat race. He finished ninth in the "A" feature.

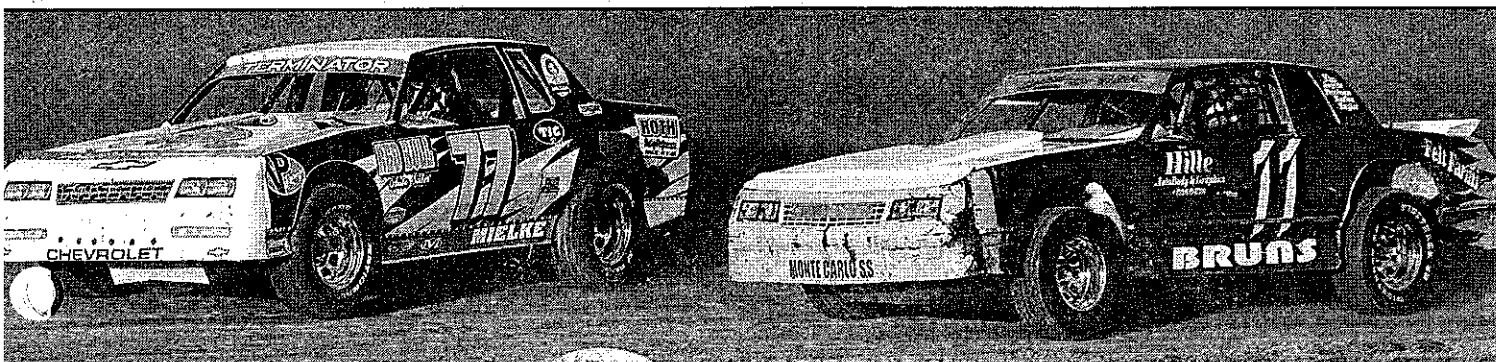
Travis Birkley (78) holds the edge on Tad Behmer (20) during their heat race. Birkley took the heat win.

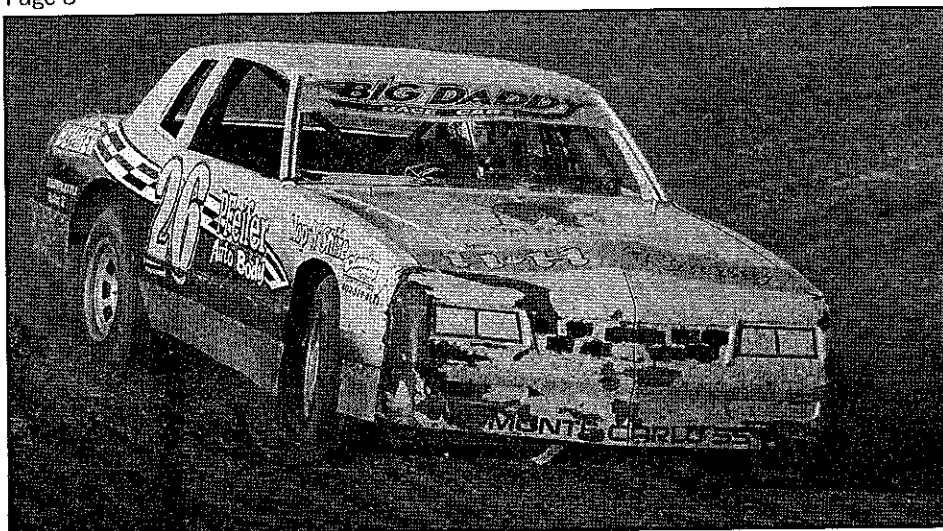

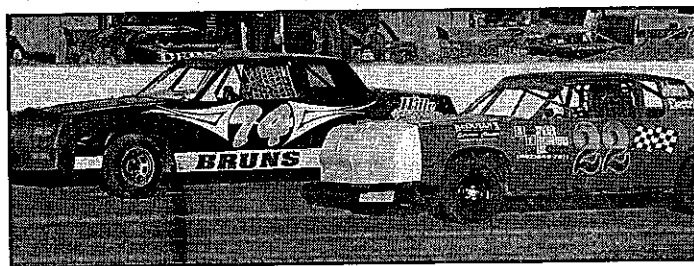

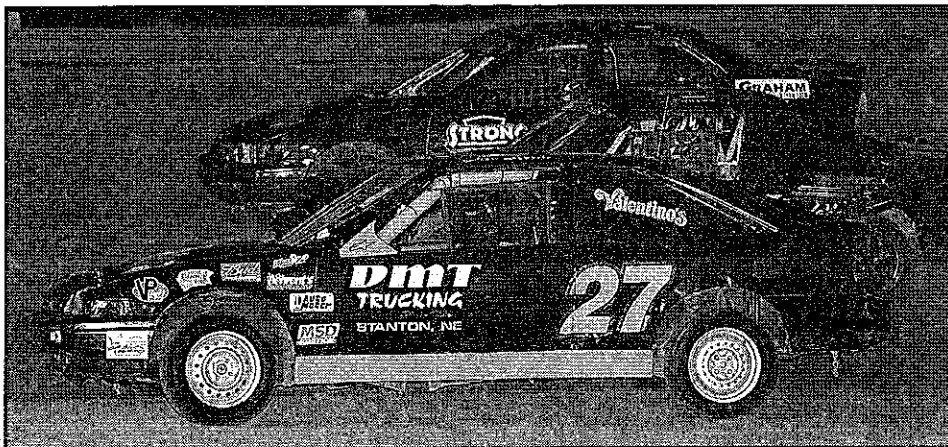
Sloan doubles on victories

Eric Sloan of Norfolk battled with defending Hornet champion Shannon Pospisil of Norfolk the first week to pick up the season-opener win.

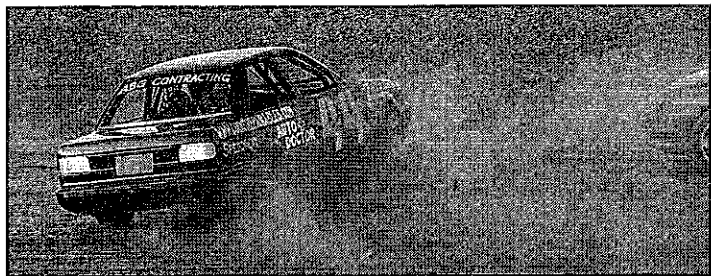
Last week Sloan came from the ninth place starting position was pacing the field by lap seven.
