
Weather Policy

Primrose tops the field twice in one night

Street Stock driver Shawn Primrose of Norfolk came through and picked up wins two and three of the season last week, as weather shortened the night on June 7 forcing a double feature night last week.

The second feature also turn into a marathon as the corners proved slick for some drivers. Six cautions were thrown in the 18-lap feature.

Primrose's first win came when he led the final five laps, and in the second race he came through the field quickly to lead the final 14 laps.

In both cases, he passed Jason Frisch of Hoskins for lead. Frisch did hang on for a second place finish in the second feature. Eric Vanosdall of Winside was second in the first feature.

Travis Birkley of Wakefield finished third to Vanosdall as Chad Bruns of Wayne finished out fourth. Rounding out the top 5 was Brad Brabec of Norfolk.

Following runner-up finisher Frisch in the second feature was Ryan Rohde of Carroll. Brad Vogt of Pierce was fourth and Jon Haase of Plainview rounded out the top 5.




Tad Behmer (20) and Brad Vogt (X) run in the first feature. Vogt finished fourth in the second feature.















Jim Spencer of Norfolk won his first career Hobby Stock feature last week during the first of two "A" features.


Spencer paced the field for the final 14 of 15 laps. Tracy Buck led the first lap.

Arduser wrapped the second position for his first top 5. Tom Marksmeier of Norfolk placed third for his second top 5.




