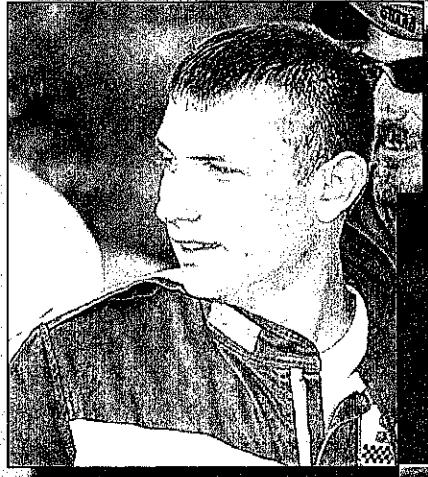

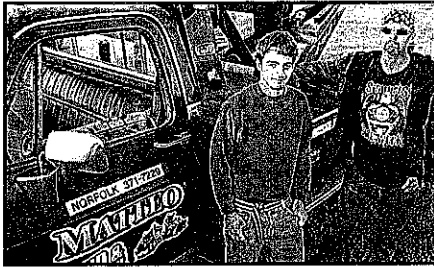

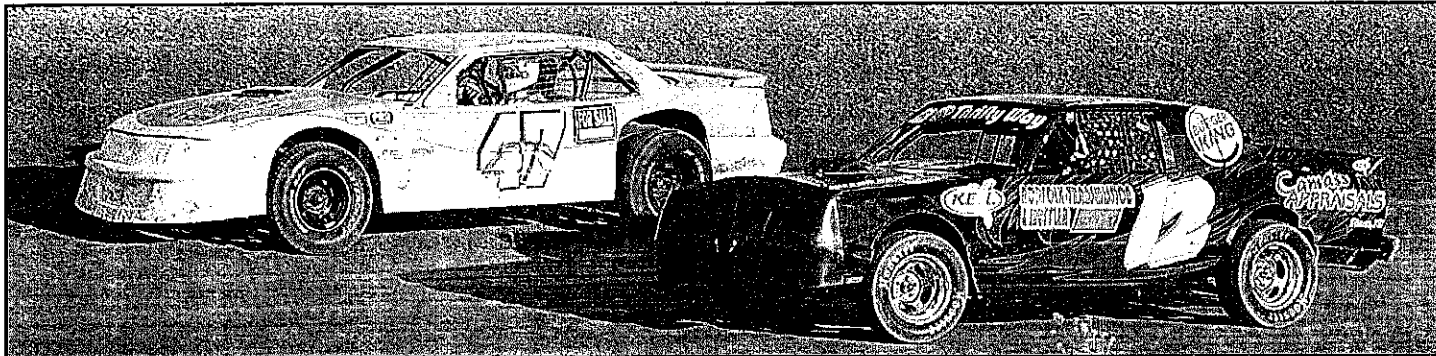
Weather Policy

Pettitt caught up with his teammate last week winning both "A" features, like Primrose did a couple weeks prior.

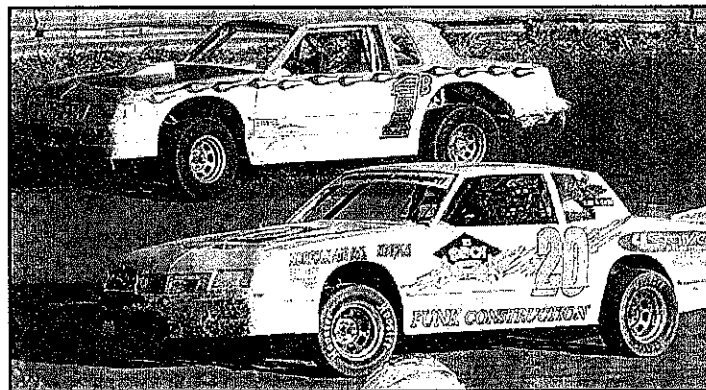
Outside of their wins, the

duo has only one other finish in the top 10.

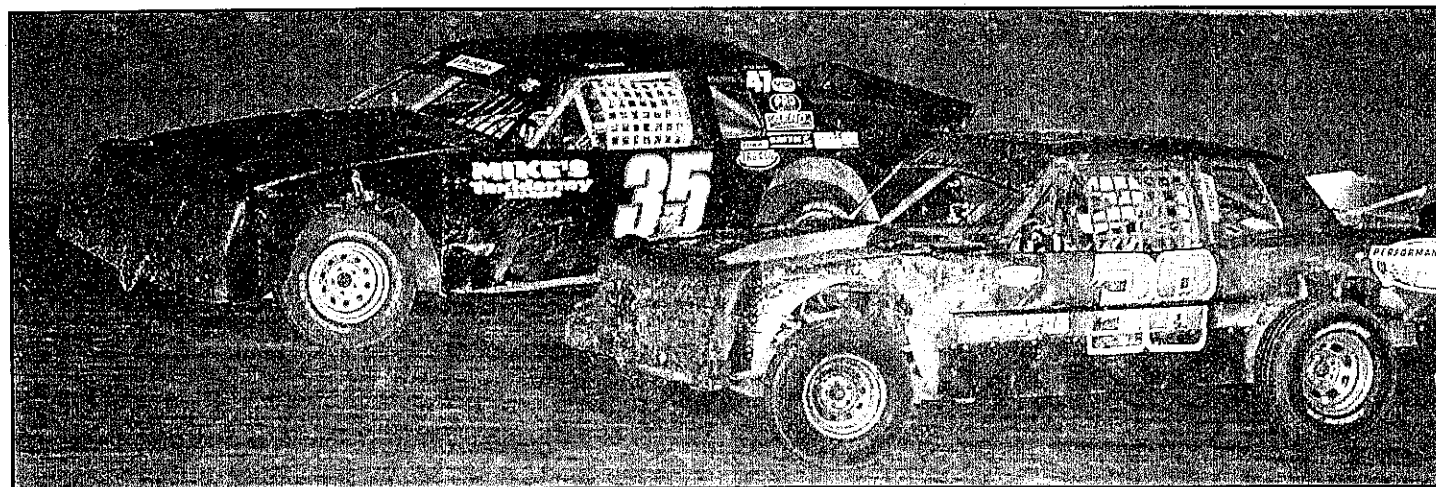
Pettitt did not have an easy time in the first feature. Brant Obanion of Norfolk led the first eight laps with Pettitt running along side of him for six of those laps.

Pettitt won with Eric Haase of Norfolk taking second. Jason Frisch of Hoskins took third.

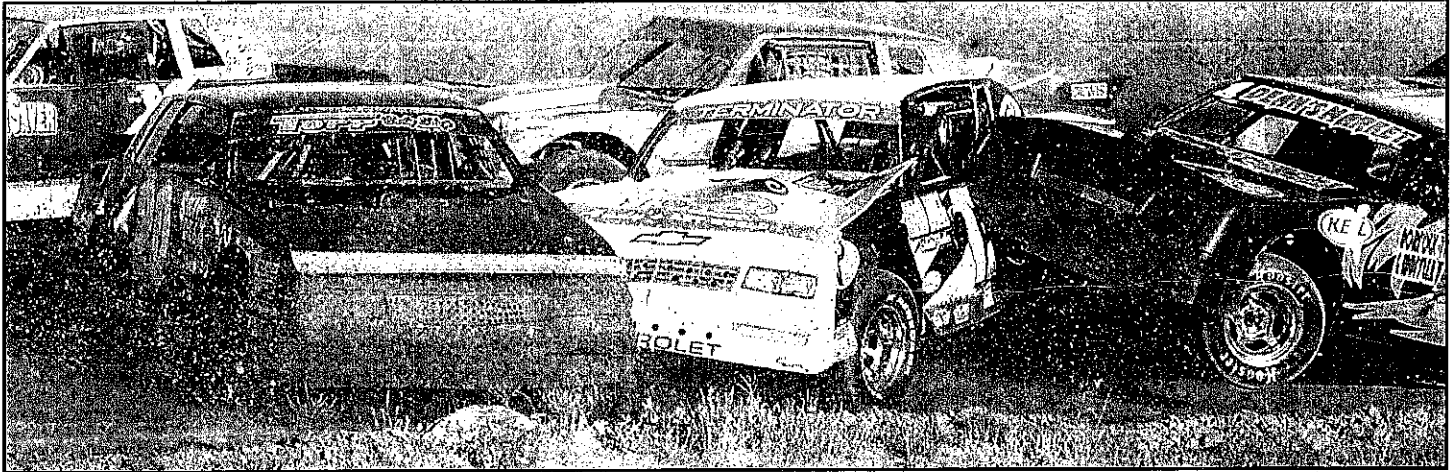

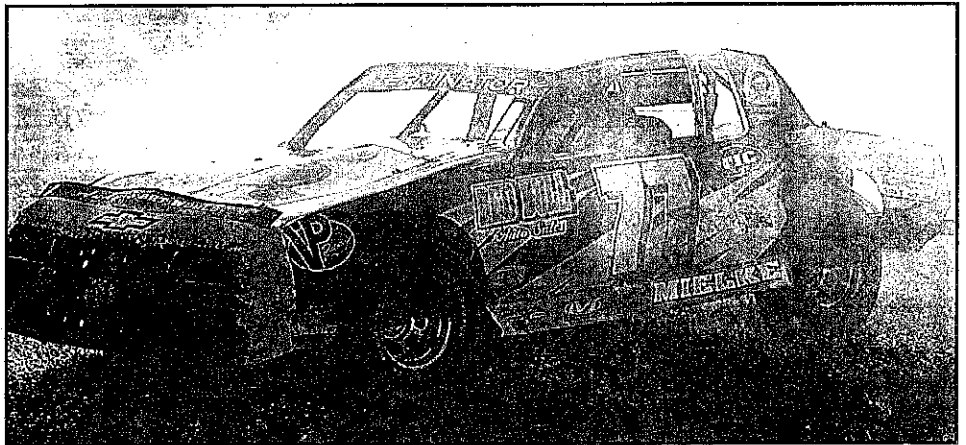

Pettitt broke into the top 3 on lap two. By the fourth circuit he was second. He raced with Hansen for seven laps before finally getting around.

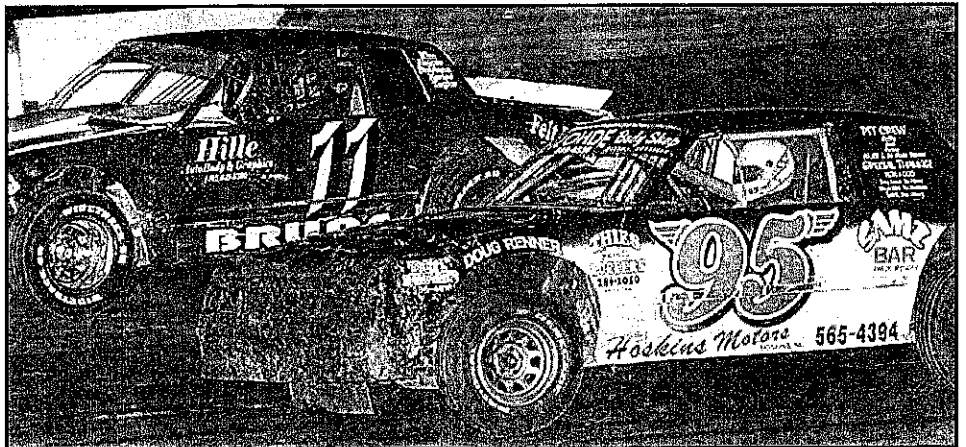
Pettitt collected his second win. Jeremy Gnat of Battle Creek was able to get by Hansen with three laps remaining in the race to take second. Hansen was third.



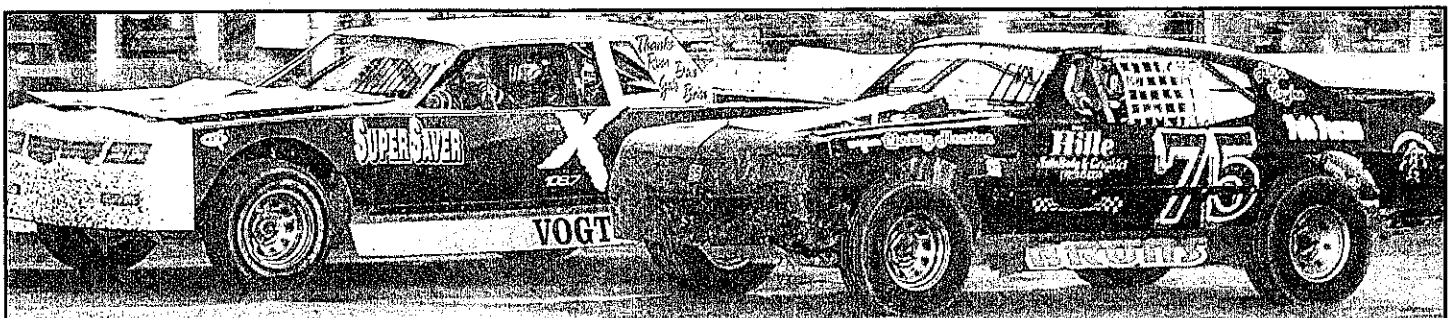
TeJay Mielke (77) sits on the infield in a cloud of smoke during the first of two "A" features, last week.



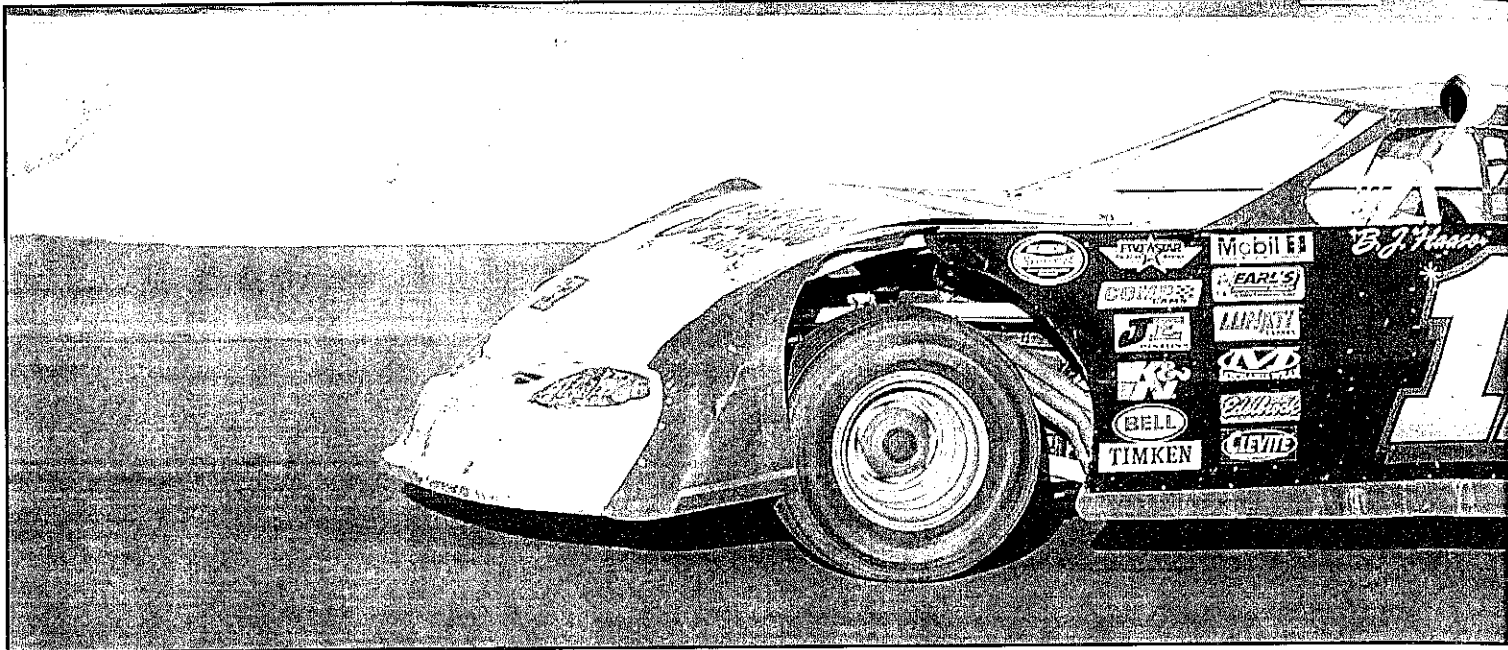

Haase hoards "A" feature victories

Norfolk's BJ Haase has had one win since 2004 and last week he returned to victory lane – twice.

With the feature races from June 21 rained out, last week double features were run. Haase claimed both wins leading 20 laps out of the 50 laps run.

Haase started on the outside of the second row on the first feature. Cody Cox of

Norfolk 17 laps, before Haase got around pacing the 17-car field. Chris Johnson of Bloomfield moved into second with seven laps remaining, but was unable to move up.

Haase won, Johnson second and Robert Osborne was third.

In the second feature, Haase started on the inside of the second row. Bob Milander of Pierce led the 15-car field for the first 13 laps,

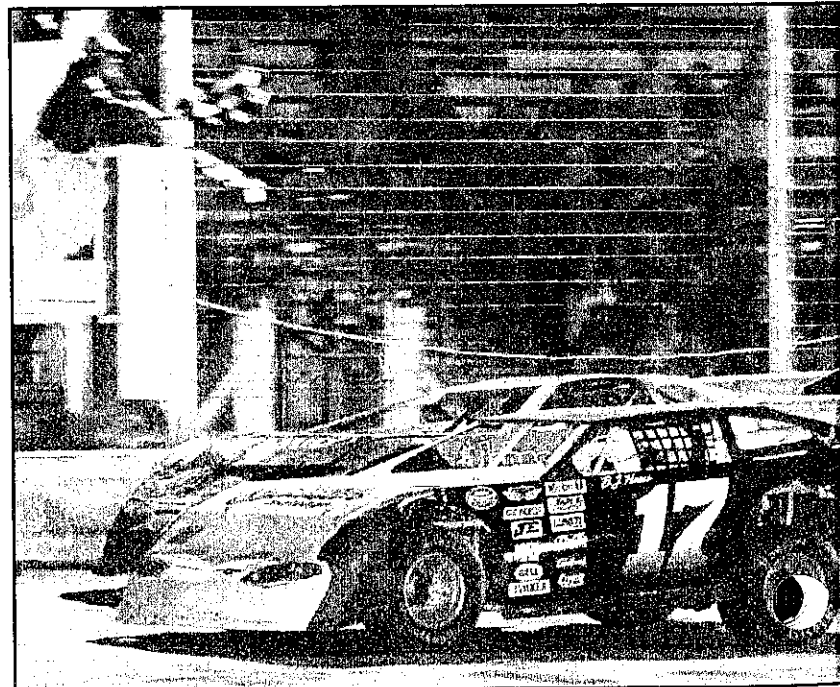
before Haase's car came to him and he took off.

Haase's car was not the only one to hook up to the track. Jim Johnson of Plainview made a late charge and made several attempts to get by.

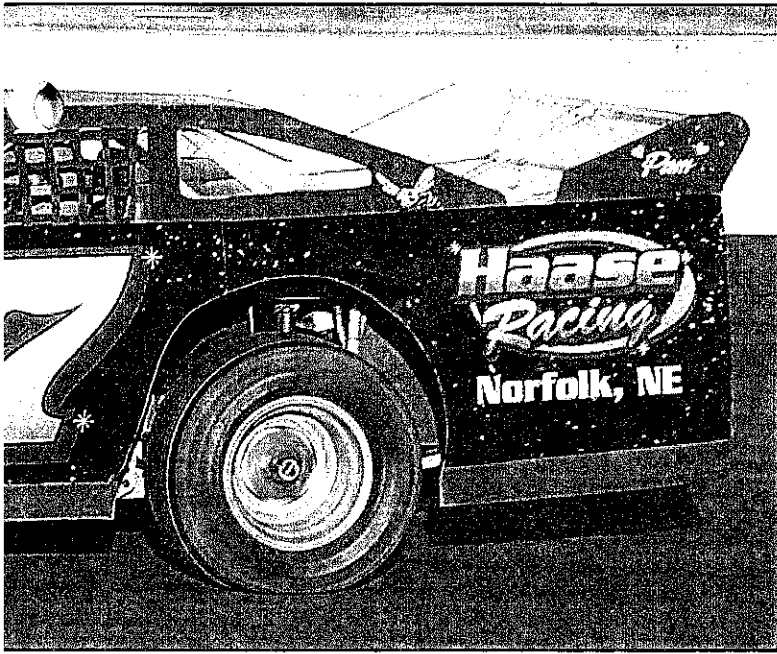

BJ Haase celebrates after his second win of the night last week.



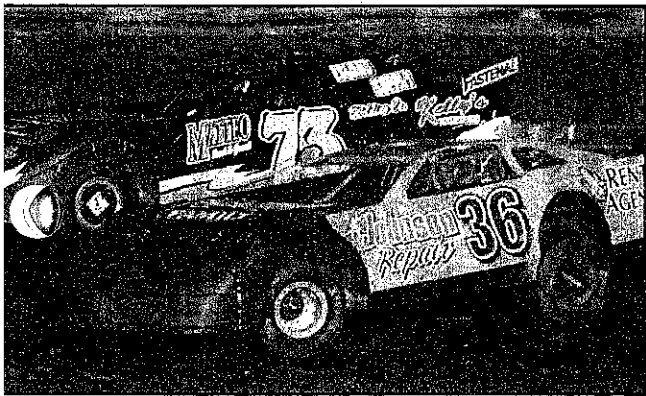
BJ Haase (17) edged out Jim Johnson (36) at the line to win the second of two "A" features.



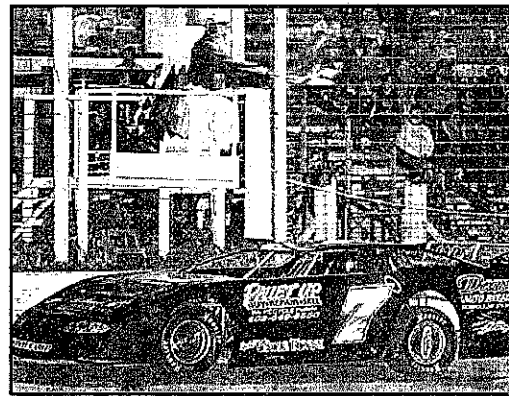

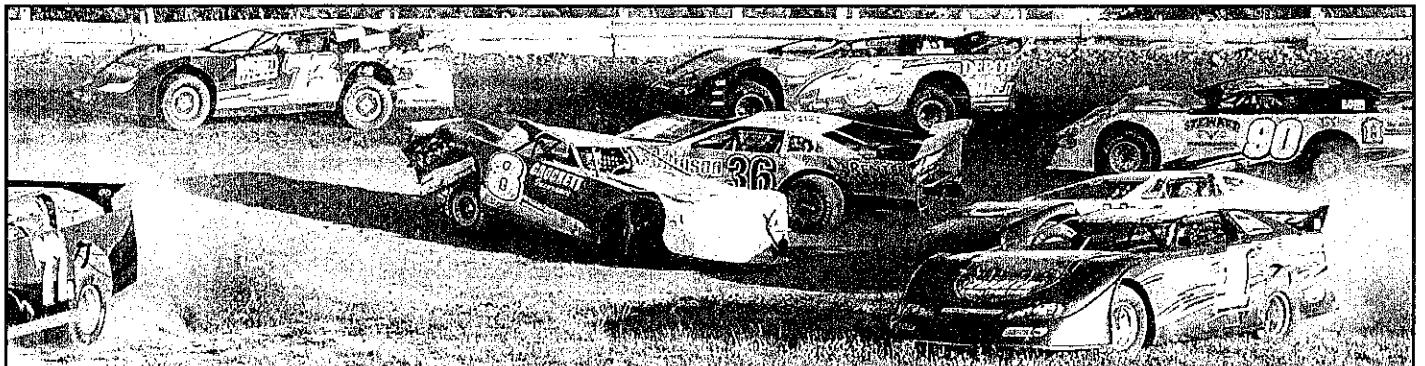
James Kelley (7x) takes the checkered flag to win his heat race last week.

Koch does it again in a Hornet

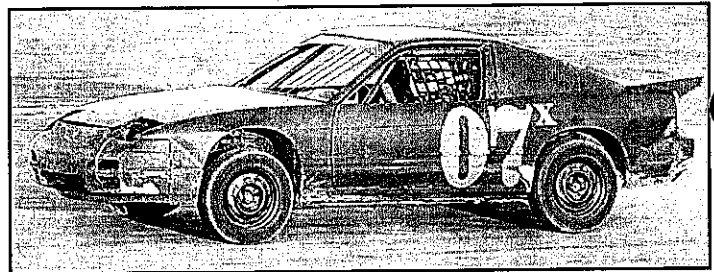

The Norfolk driver claimed his second win in as many starts last week. Koch blasted away from the field as he went from his 10th place starting po-

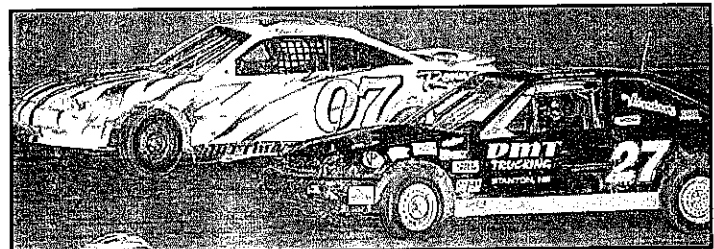
sition to first in just over a half of a lap.

A caution, which never came, was the only thing that was going to allow the field to catch him. He even backed out of throttle for the final laps to avoid over lapping other cars.

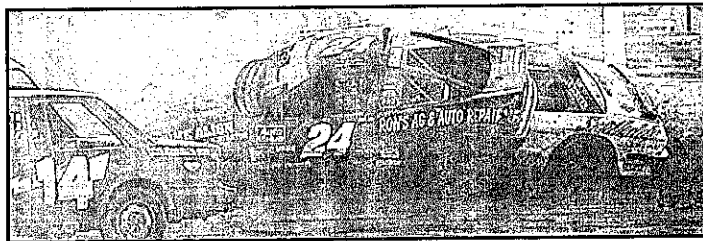
Points leader Eric Sloan overcame a flat tire in his heat race to take second. Third went to Stacie Huttman of Stanton.



Brian Koch (07x) screams around the track to win both his heat and "A" feature.



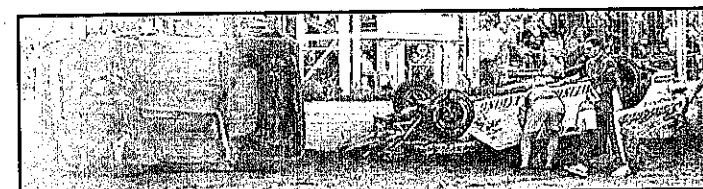
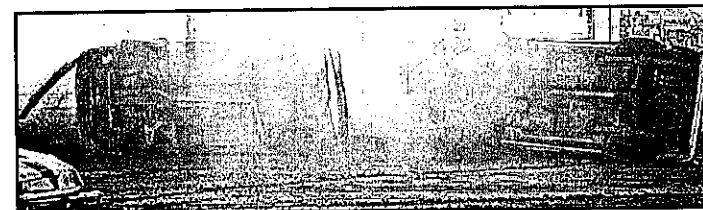
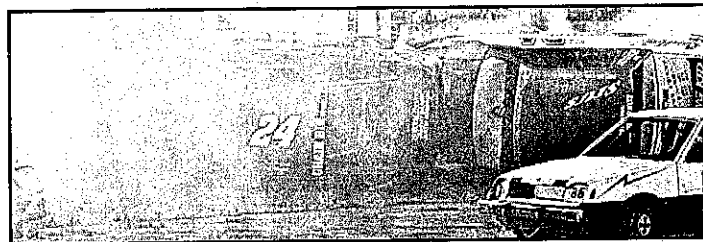
