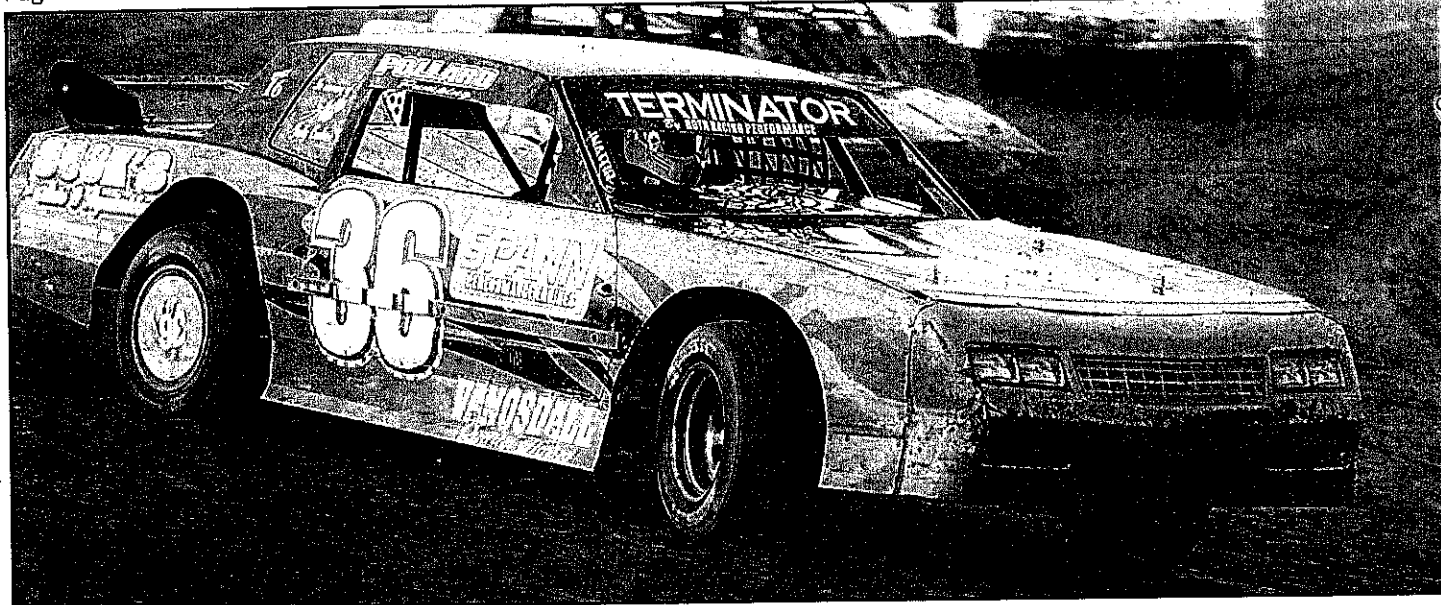
Weather Policy

Vanosdall claims first of season

Eric Vanosdall of Winside picked up his fourth career win at the track Monday night.

The track surface provided to be slick, as Vanosdall endured seven cautions before taking the win.

He started on the inside of the third row and was pacing the field after two laps.

It became a three-way battle for second, third and fourth between Tad Behmer of Winside, Jason Hames of Crofton and Jeremy Gnat of Battle Creek.

Behmer held the second spot while Hames and Gnat ran side-by-side for third.

Hames then made a move on Behmer on lap five, but he was

unable to make the pass. That opened the door for Gnat who pulled alongside Hames for laps six and seven.

Hames got back in front of Gnat on lap eight before the fifth caution flew. On the restart, Hames made the pass before the six caution came out.

Again on the restart, Behmer lost another spot this time to Gnat.

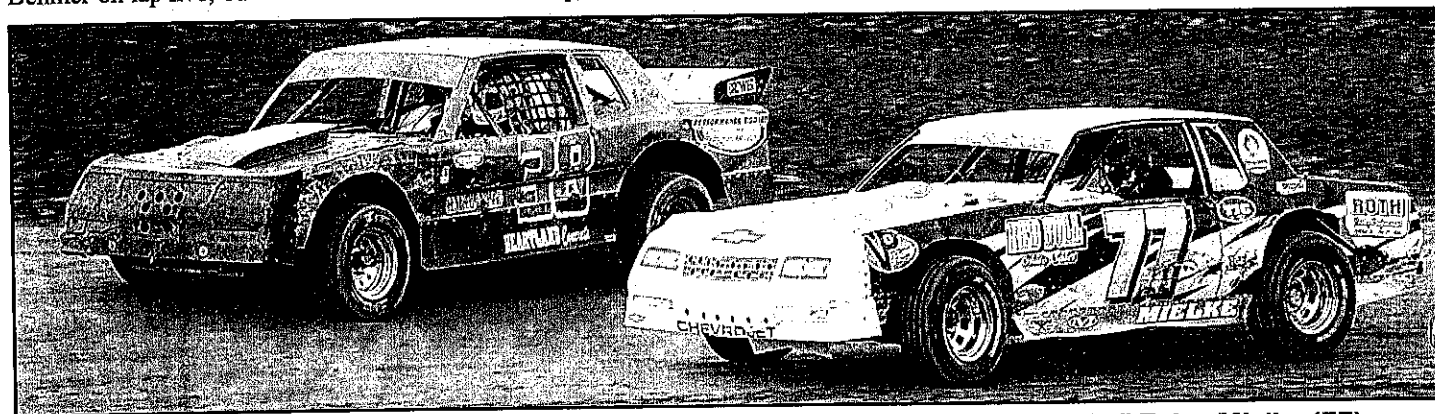
The top three went to the line, Vanosdall, Hames and Gnat.

Behmer continued to fall back and Jon Haase of Plainview finished fourth and point leader Brad Vogt of Pierce rounded out the top five.

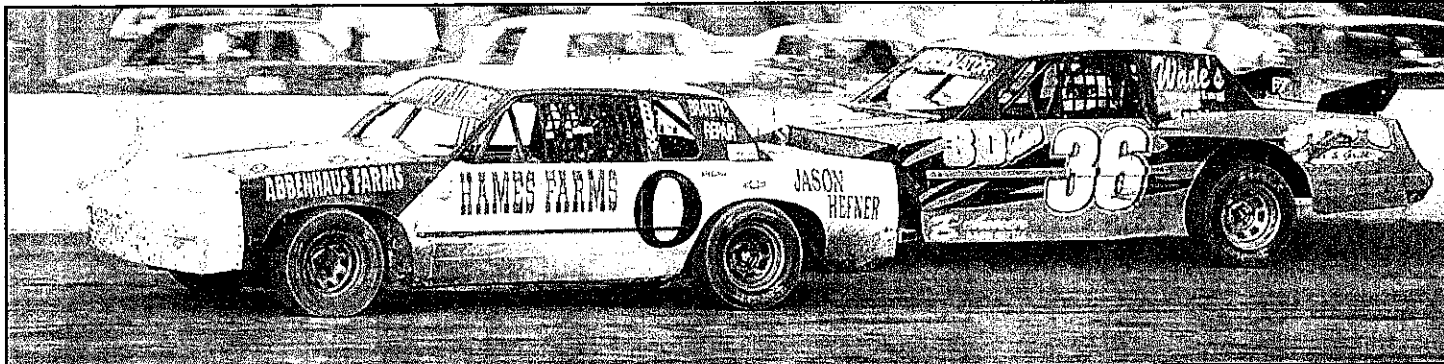

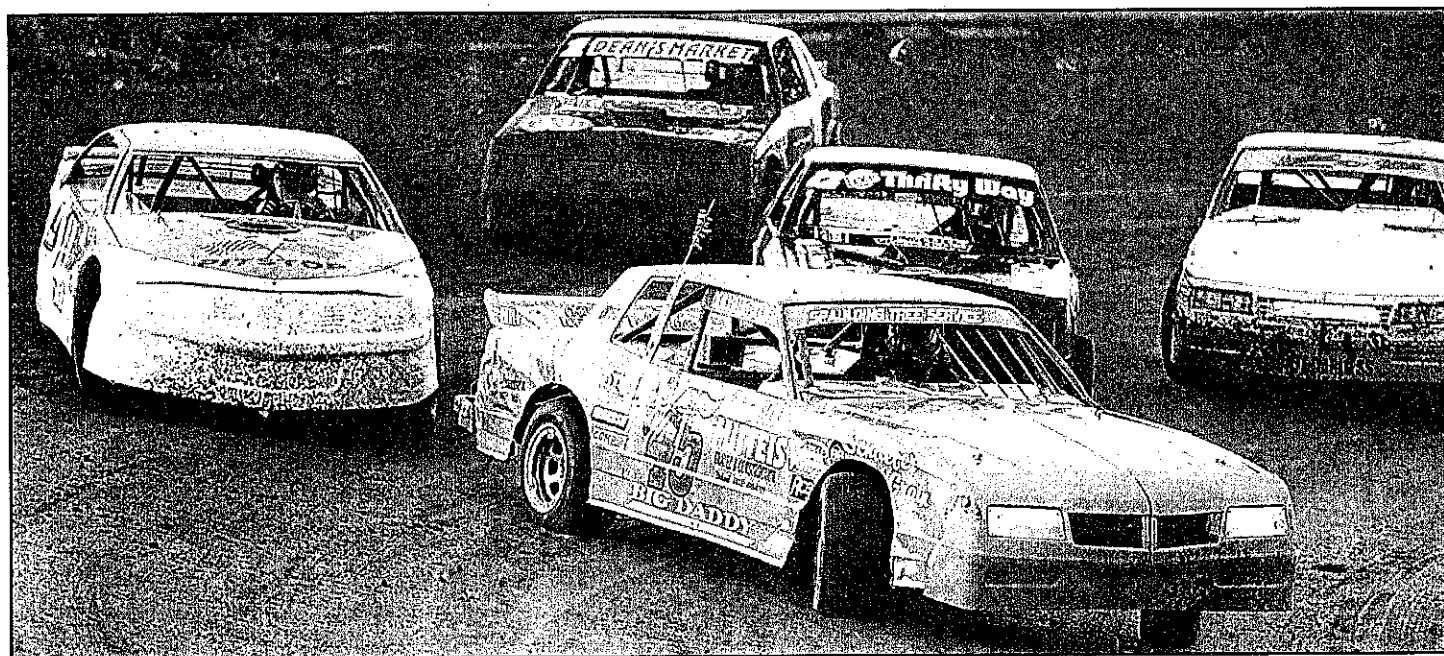

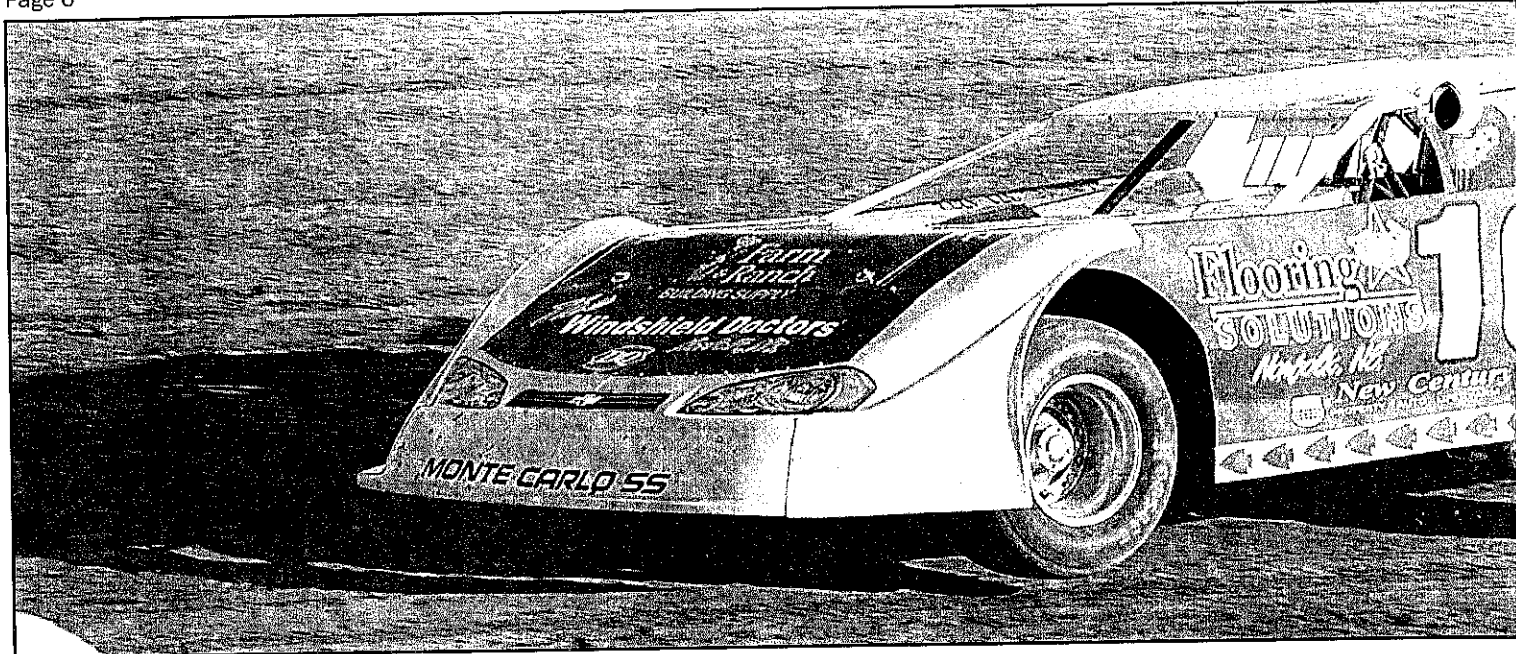

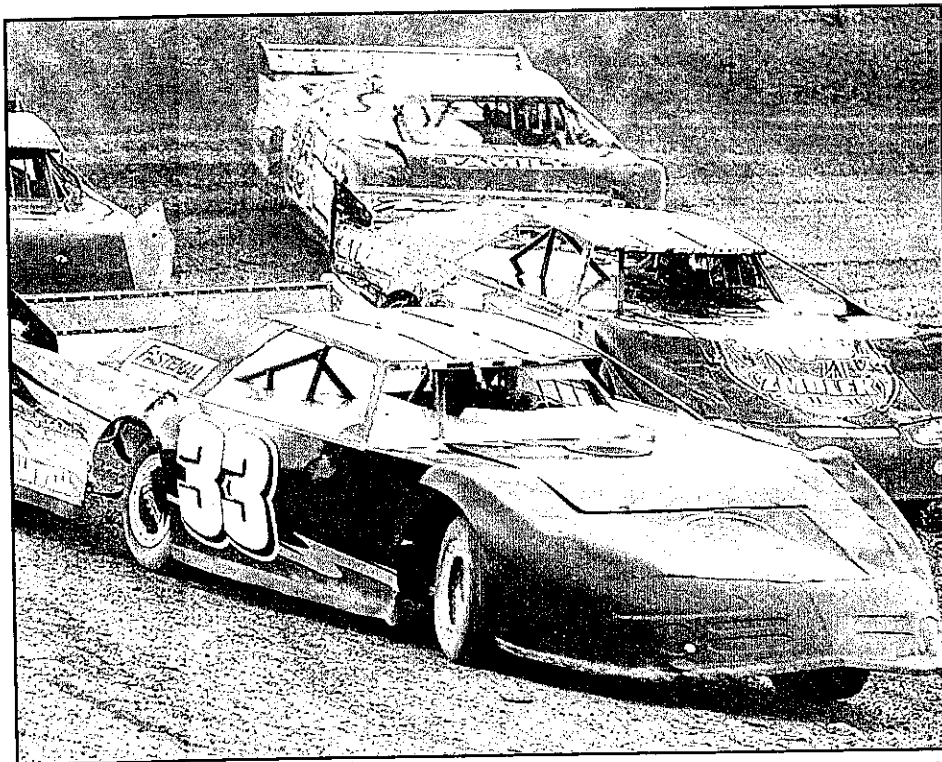
It does not happen too often, but a father and a son picked up their first wins of the season on the same night.

Tony Coover won the Hornet class subbing for another driver and then got to watch his son win the Grand National division.

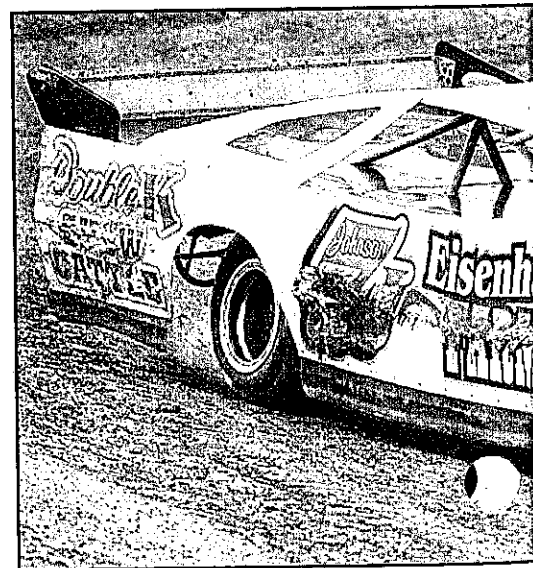
Tony's son, Kyle Coover, started his career learning from the back of the pack in 2006 and in his third year he led the field for 25 laps for the win.

The younger Coover took off from his pole position and maintained his speed on a dusty-slick track surface for the first 15 laps.

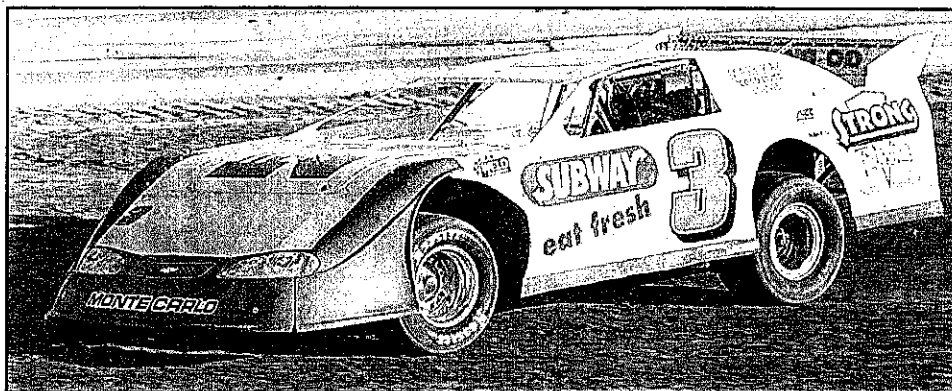
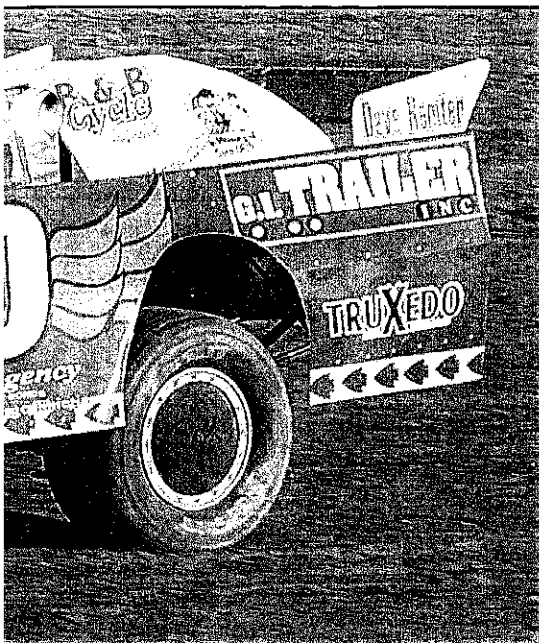
On lap 16, he bobbled and gave the second place car of Cody Cox of Norfolk a shot to get along side.



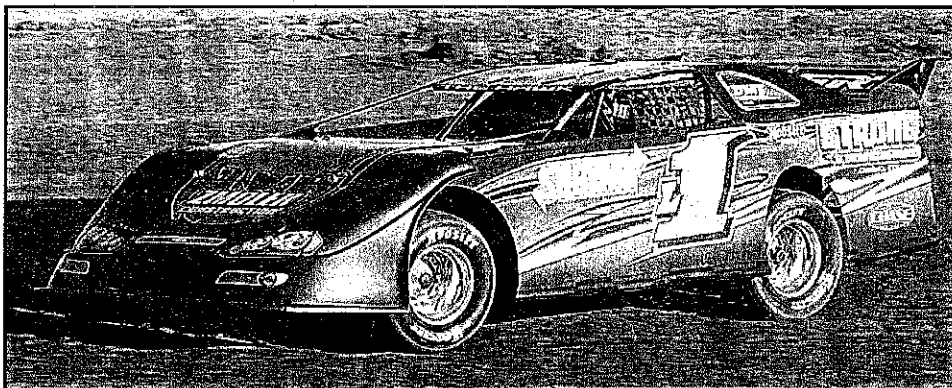

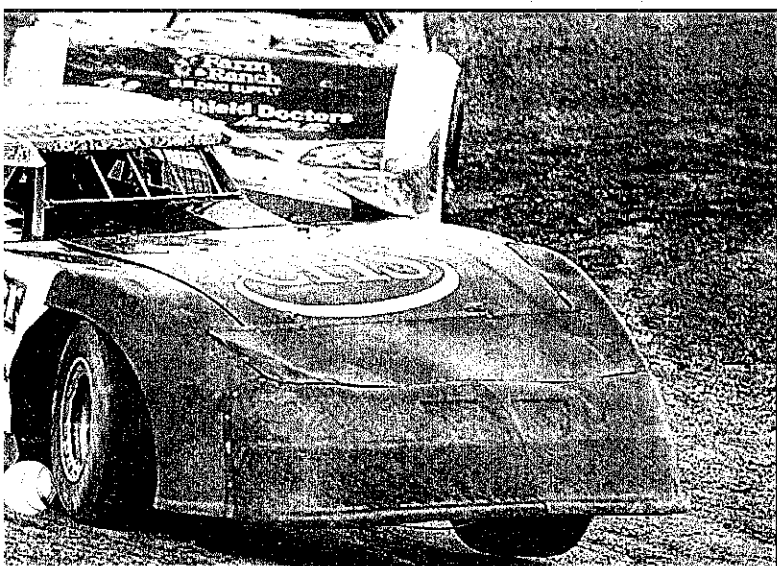

Not only did he lose the win, but he dropped from the points lead which he has had since the start of the season.

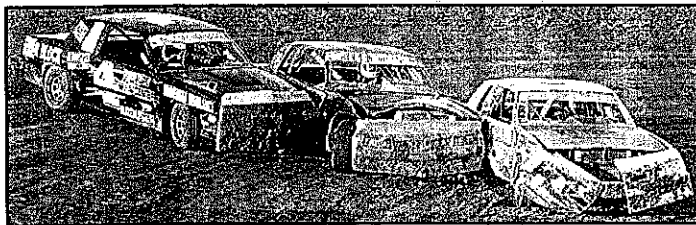

So Kimmel led the first three laps, before Sean Spann of Norfolk led his first lap of the season. He went onto lead a total of eight laps.

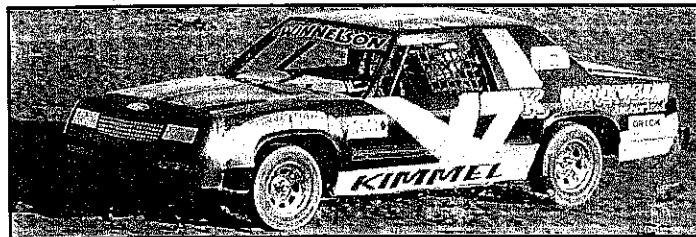
Wilkinson moved into the second spot on lap six and looked for an opening to get around Spann. It did and on lap 12, the door opened and Wilkinson jumped through.

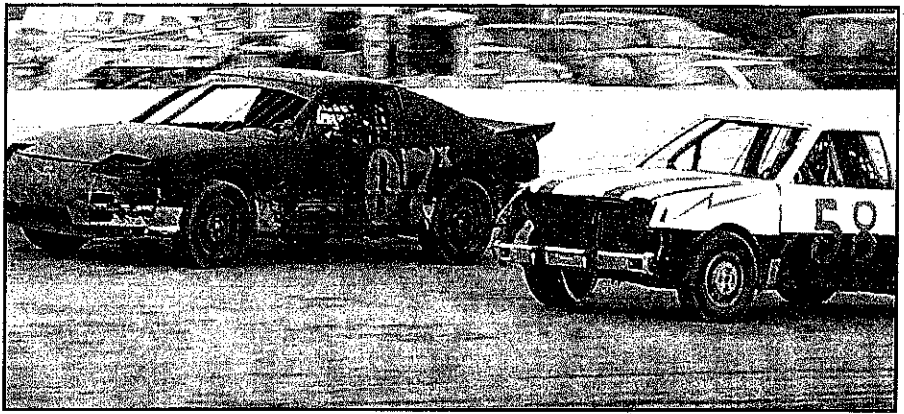
Coover tops the field
