




Weather Policy

The Plainview driver took control of the race from the drop of the green flag and lead the entire 25-laps.


But the race was no picnic. A rough track became another obstacle and running out was a plus as he could pick and choose where to avoid the trouble


After the race, Jim Johnson said he could avoid most of the potholes, but the holes in turns one and two were tough to avoid.

Both Christand Jim Johnson and Caldwell won their heat races.








Warren Jensen (28) cruises by Justin Bertschinger (8) after Bertschinger suffered a flat tire in their heat.



Pettitt, who started 12th in the 15-car field broke into the top three on lap 11. He got by Freeman on lap 14 and tried to run down his teammate but settled for second.

Freeman suffered a flat tire after completing lap 15. He dropped from

the field after stopping on the track.

That set up a three-lap shoot out with Primrose leading, Pettitt second, Eric Vanosdall of Hoskins third and Chris Johnson, who was subbing for Nick Cautrell of Winside.


Cautrell suffered an eye injury and was sideline from the action.


Eric Haase of Norfolk won the "B" feature advancing with Tate

Weinrich of Hoskins and TeJav Mielke of Norfolk.





Pospisil grabbed second


on the next lap and went after Barg, who had run away from the field.




