Johnson runs away from field for win

Jim Johnson's 15th place finish on opening night helped get him a good starting position for the "A" feature.

The Plainview driver took control of the race from the drop of the green flag and lead the entire 25-laps.

But the race was no picnic. A rough track became another obstacle and running out was a plus as he could pick and choose where to avoid the trouble.

However, behind him was another story.

Cory Haase of Norfolk and Doug Tomka of Stanton traded paint lap after lap with neither driver giving up the inside lane. The two ran second and third for the first 15 laps before Jeff Haase of Norfolk got a great run off the corner on lap 15 and passed both Tomka and Cory Haase for the runner-up spot.

Jeff Haase was later run down by Chris Johnson of Bloomfield. Haase and Chris Johnson took the white flag side-by-side.

Chris Johnson was unable to make the

Chris Johnson on the final pass through turn two. Haase took second, as Chris Johnson edged out Caldwell in a side-by-side battle to the checkered flag.

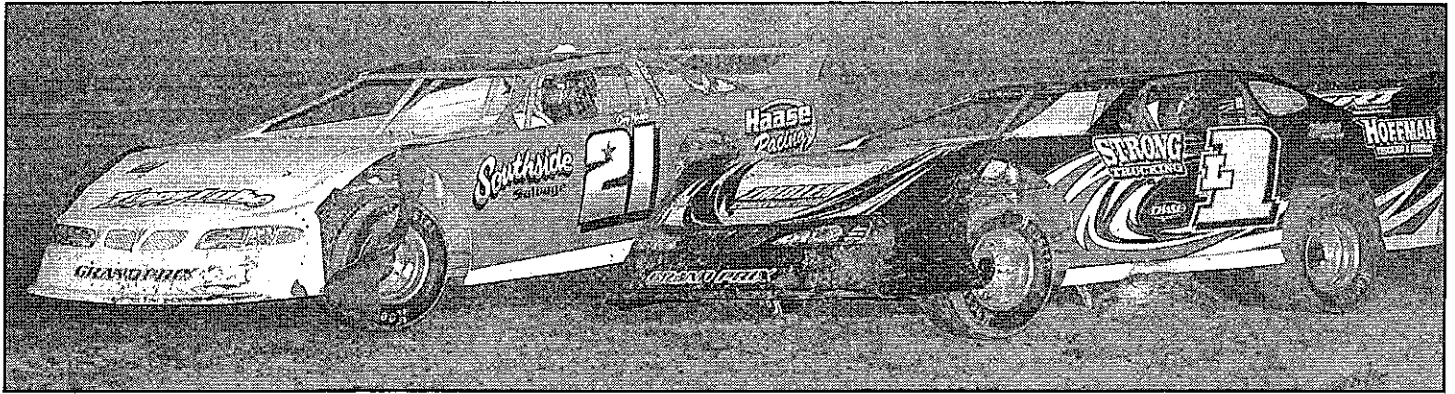
Tomka hung onto a top 5 position his first of the season.

After the race, Jim Johnson said he could avoid most of the pot-holes, but the holes in turns one and two were tough to avoid.

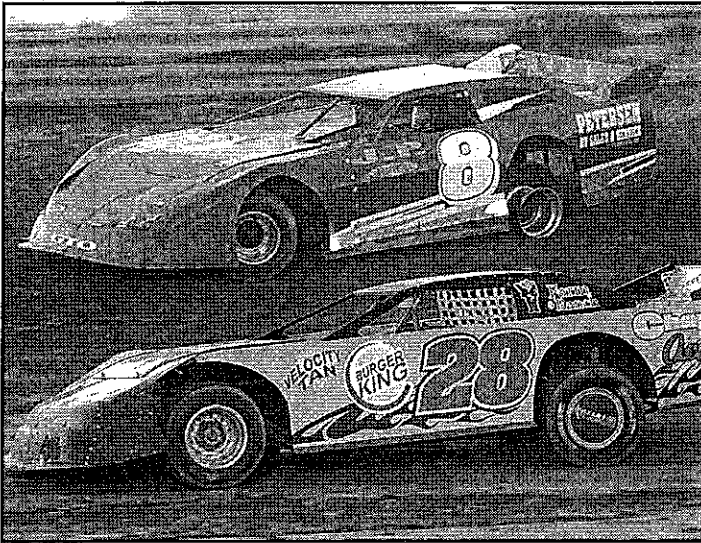
Both Chris and Jim Johnson and Caldwell won their heat races.

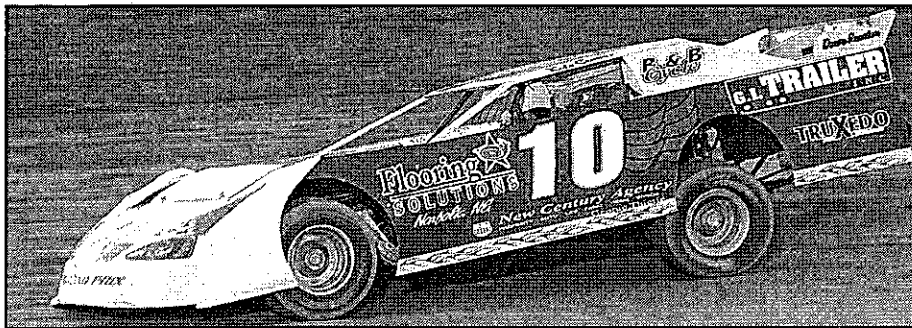

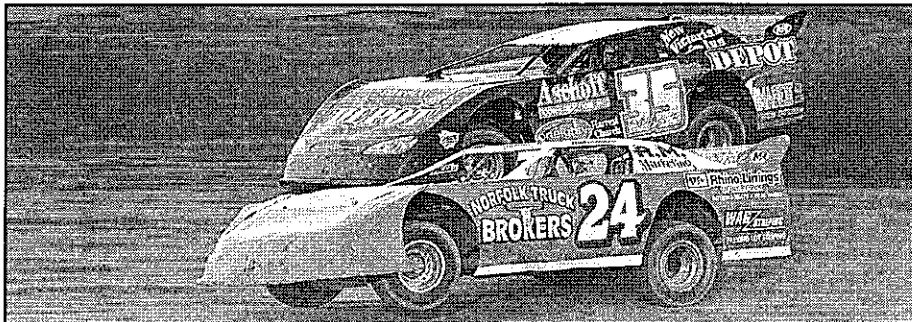

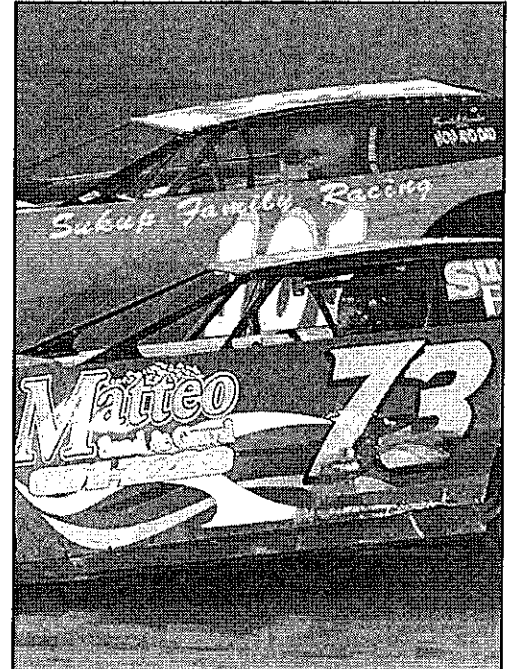

Pettitt, who started 12th in the 15-car field broke into the top three on lap 11. He got by Freeman on lap 14 and tried to run down his teammate but settled for second.

Freeman suffered a flat tire after completing lap 15. He dropped from

the field after stopping on the track.

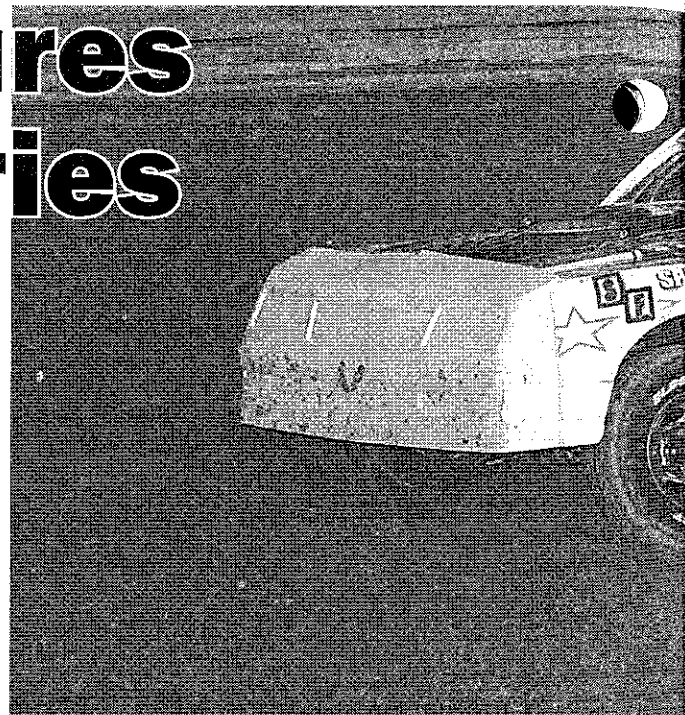

Cautrell suffered an eye injury and was sideline from the action.

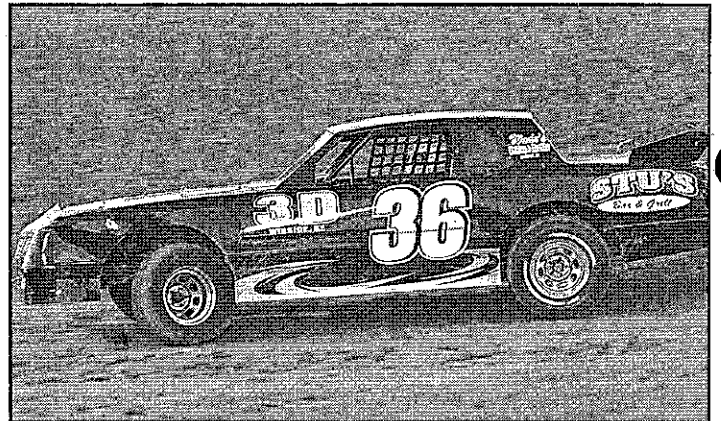

Eric Haase of Norfolk won the "B" feature advancing with Tate Weinrich of Hoskins and TeJay Mielke of Norfolk.

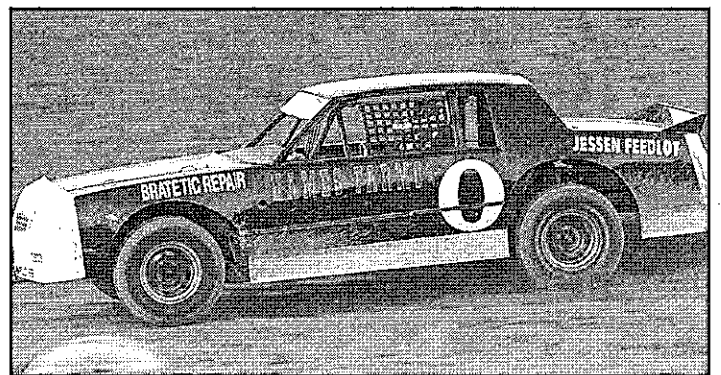
Hames, Brent Obanion of Norfolk and Vanosdall each won their heat race.

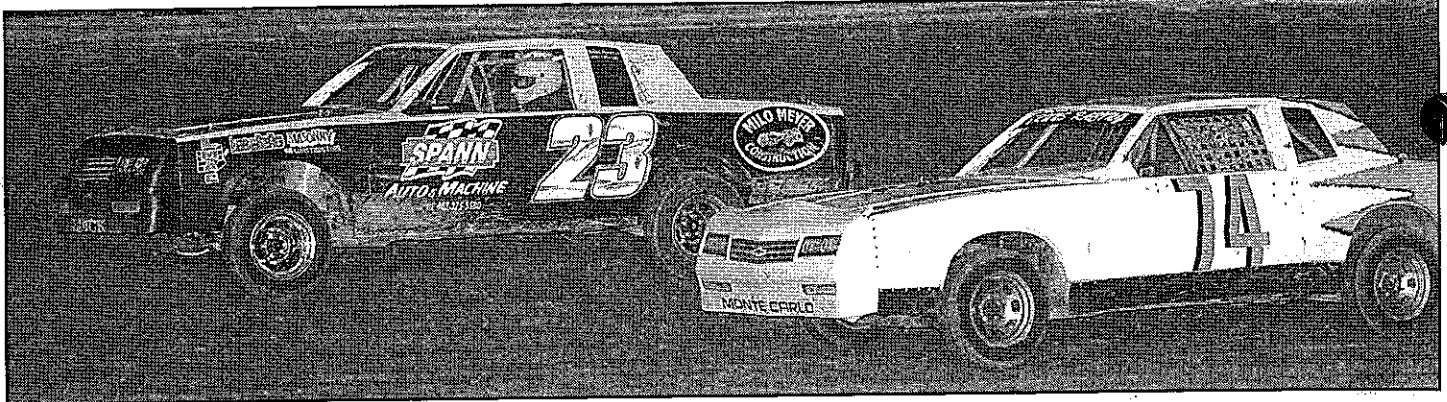

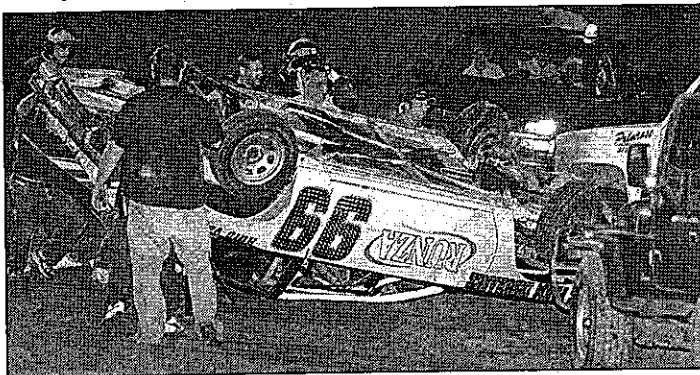
Sean Spann inherited the lead and endured three more cautions in the final four laps, including roll over by former Hobby Stock track cham-

pion Jeremy Brabec of Norfolk. Brabec walked away from the incident.

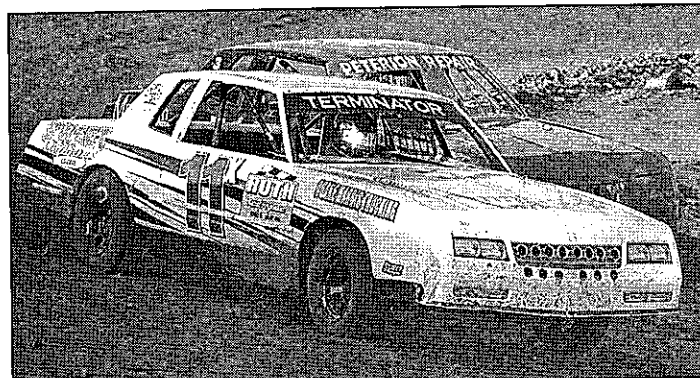

Pospisil grabbed second

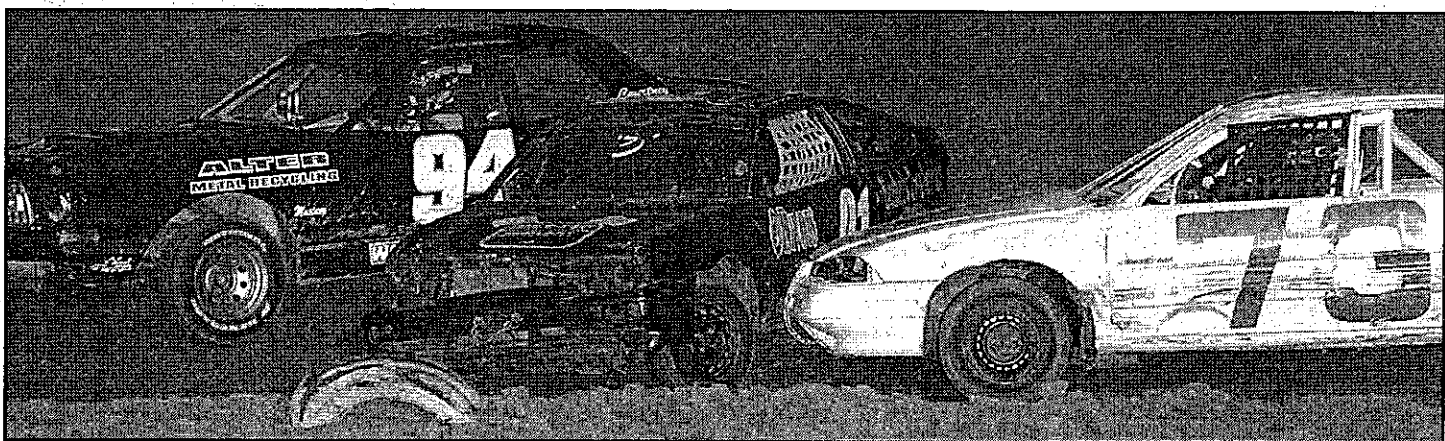
on the next lap and went after Barg, who had run away from the field.

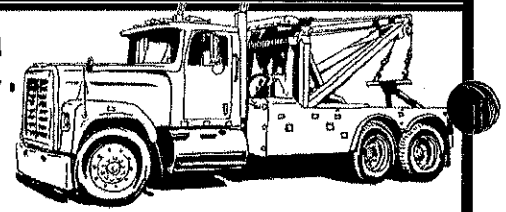

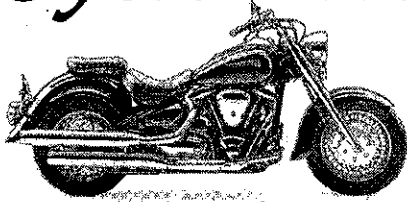

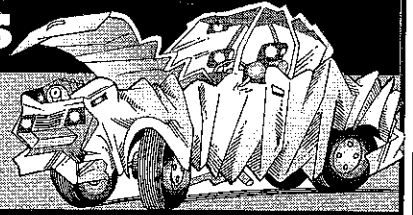
