Pettitt made the pass for second on the final lap and made it the second straight night that Primrose and Pettitt finished one-two.

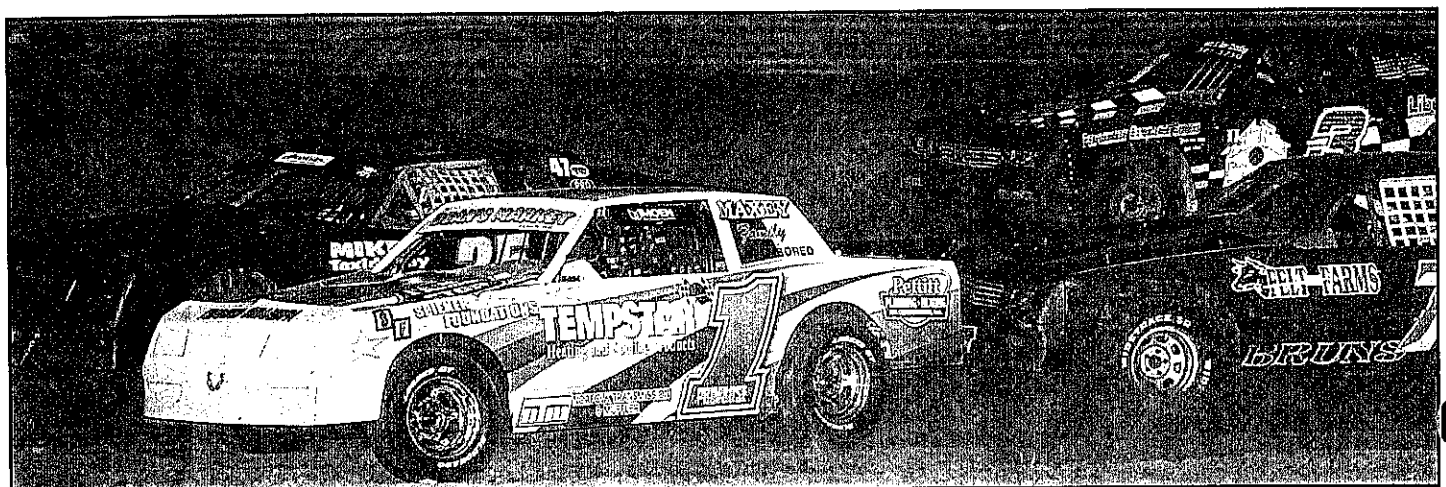
Freeman finished third. Fourth went to Troy Bruns of Wayne and Brian Koch of Norfolk rounded out the top five.

Ryan Rohde of Carroll won the "B" feature, transferring

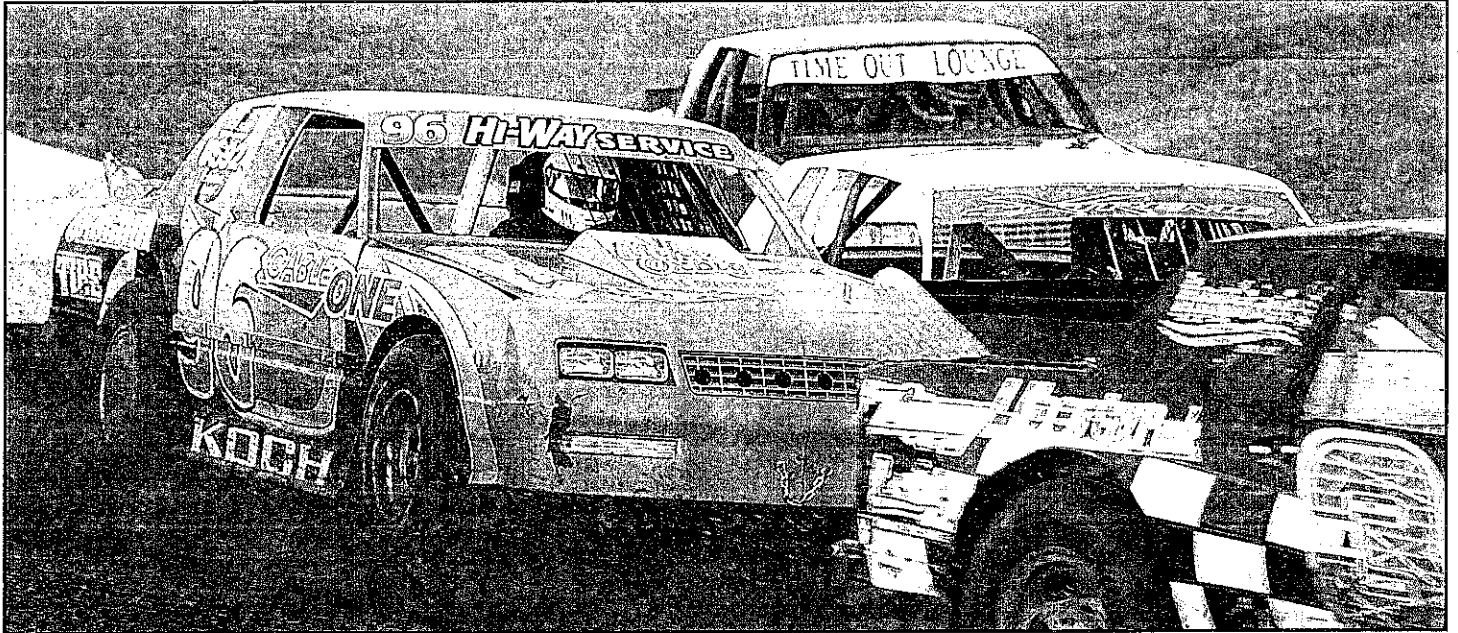

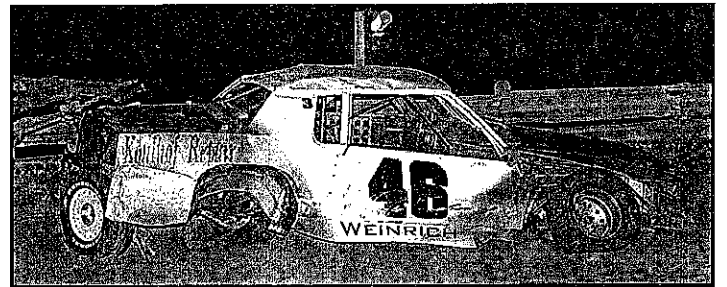

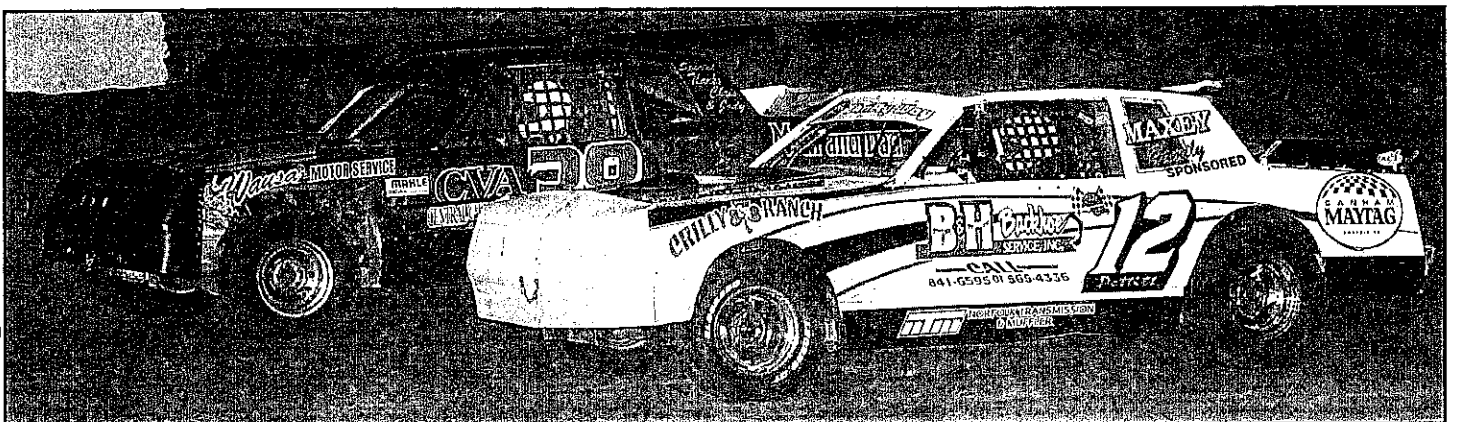

Chad Jensen of Norfolk started on the inside of the third row, but it took 15 laps for him to find the top spot.

A rough track dictated the way round the dirt oval making the drivers race the track as well as other drivers.

JR Strong of Norfolk led the first 13 laps, before Cory Haase of Norfolk paced the field for a lap.

On lap 15, Jensen moved out front. Five laps after Jensen took the lead, the only caution was thrown erasing a straightaway lead.

On the restart, it was Jensen first, Doug Tomka of Stanton second and Billy Sukup of Norfolk third.

Jensen went back to work and ran just high enough to miss the craters created in turns three and four forcing any who wanted to

challenge for the lead to go through the very rough part of the track.

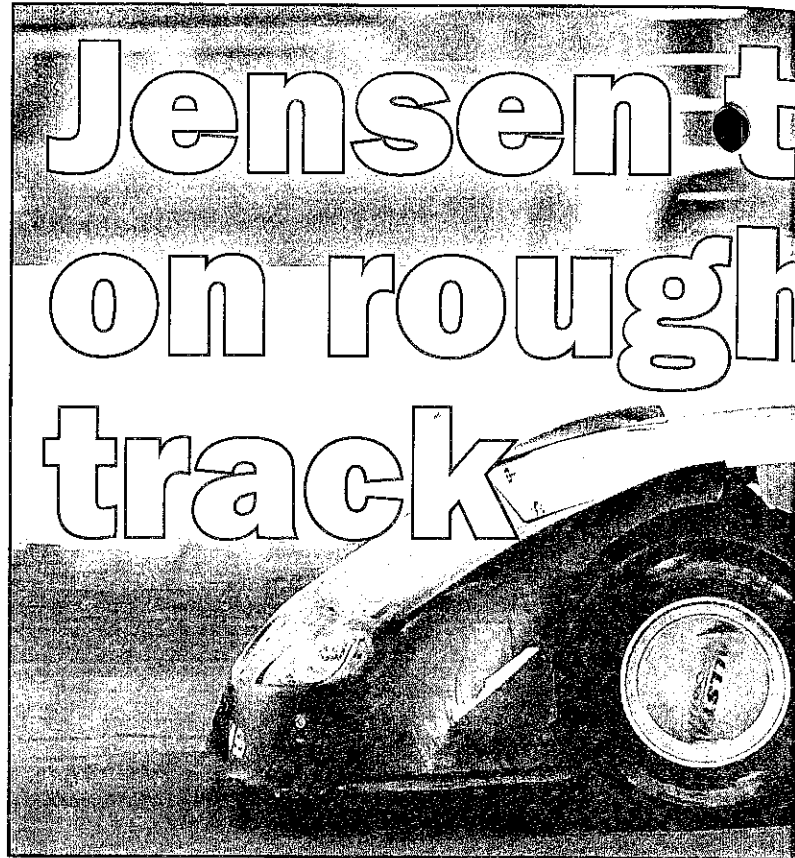
Jensen won and Tomka held onto second.

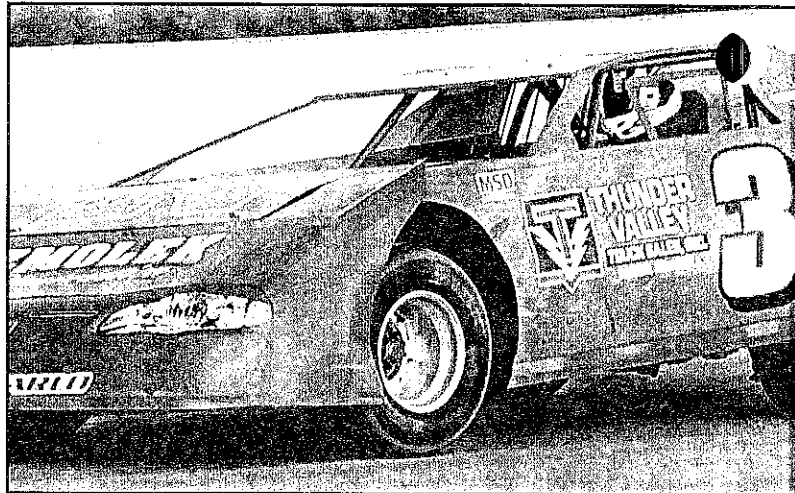
Starting 10th, Taylor Caldwell of Stanton raced his way to a fourth place finish. It was his third straight fourth place.

Sukup rounded out the top five.

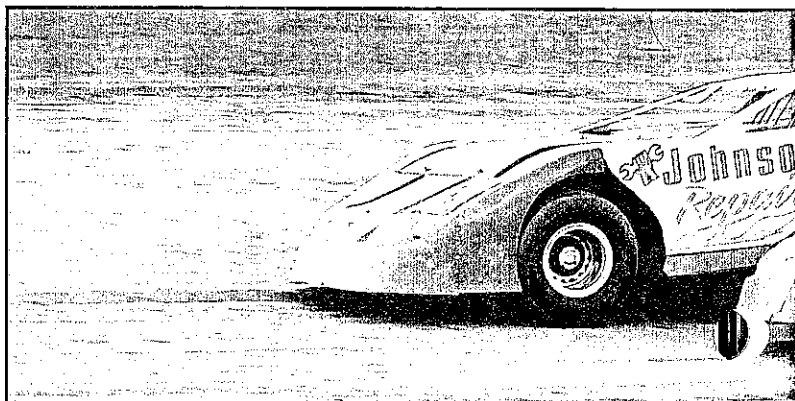
Tomka, Jim Johnson of Plainview and Jensen each won their heat race.

JR Strong (3) led 13 laps in the "A" feature. He finished eighth.

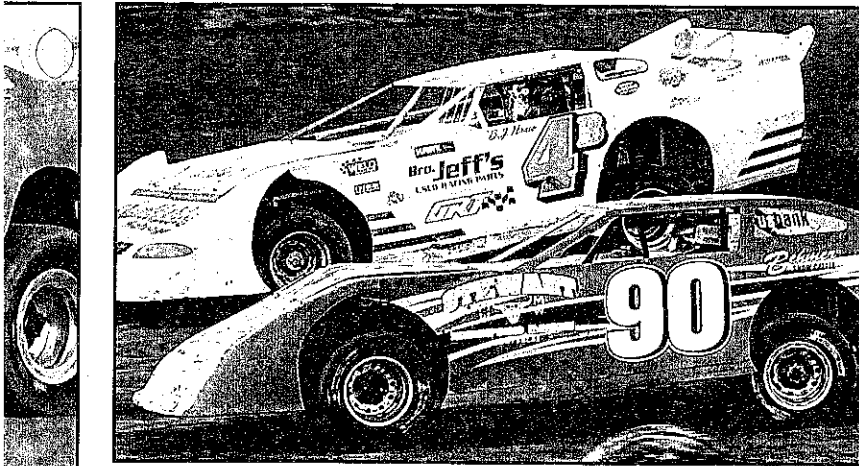
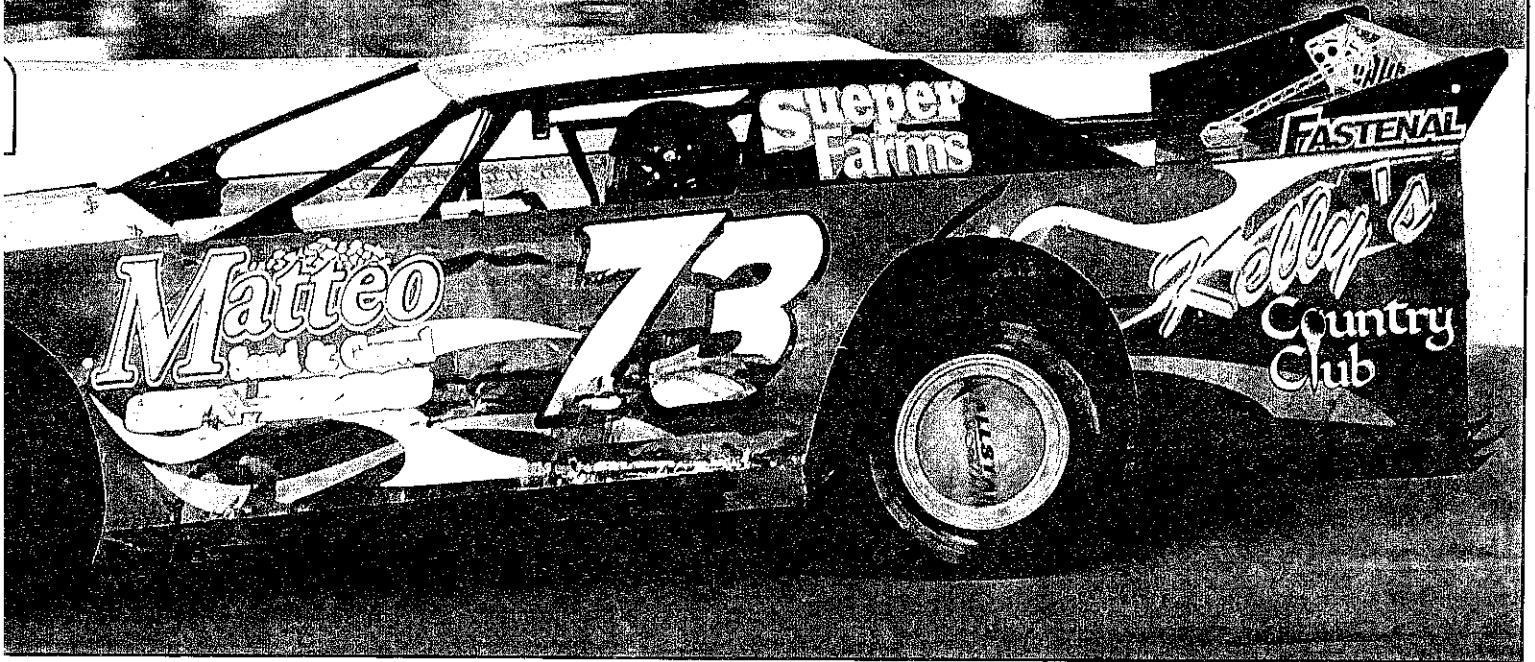


Billy Sukup (101) and Jim Johnson (36) run side-by-side in their feature, while Johnson placed sixth.

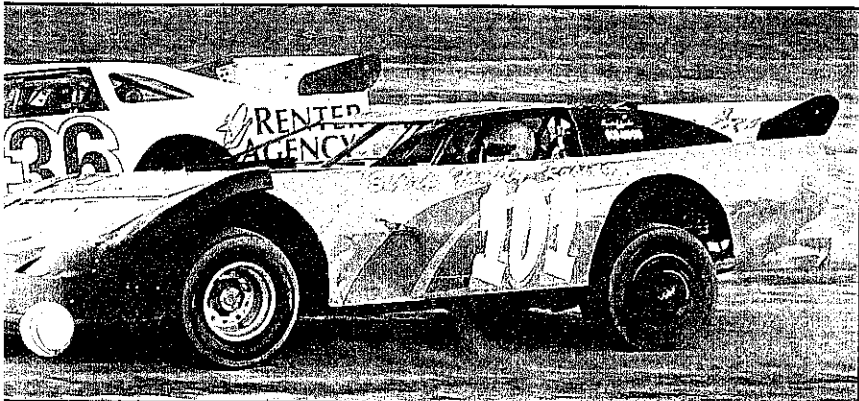

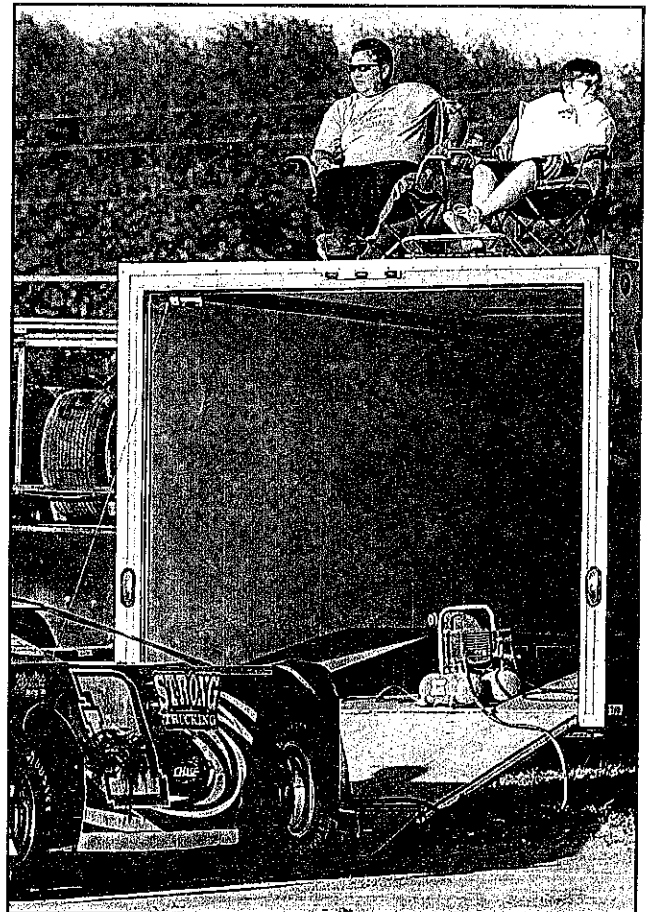

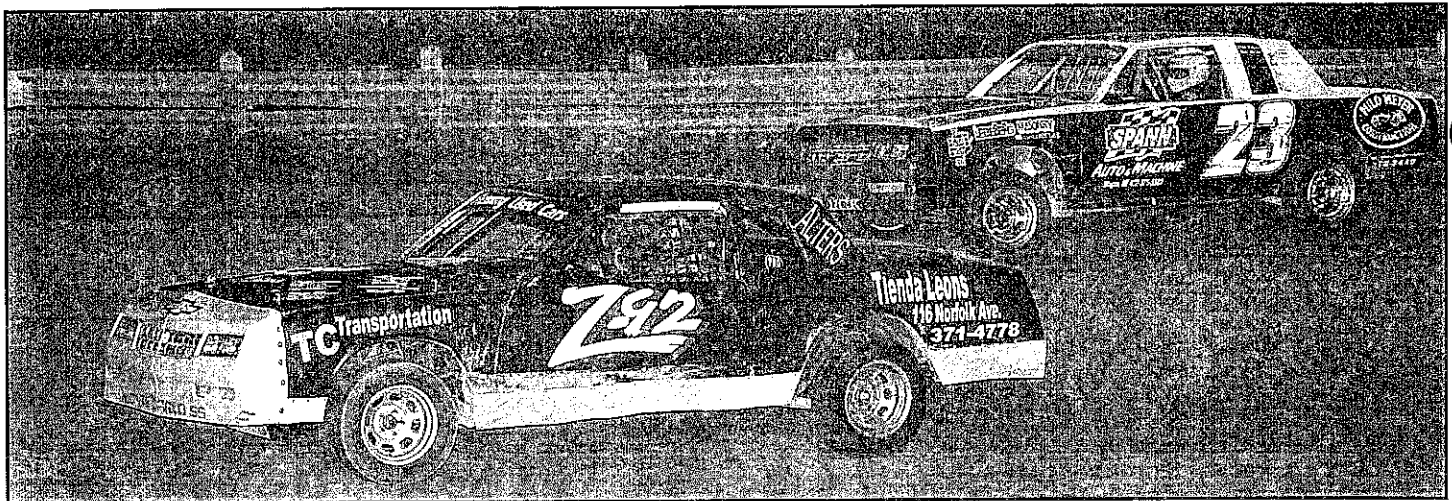

Michael Tomasek of Norfolk took home his third top five at with a fourth

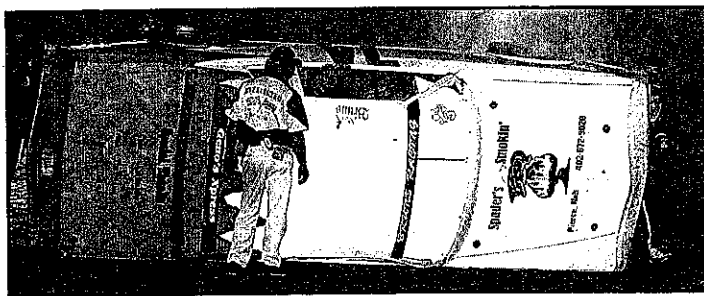
place. Jeremy Brabec of Norfolk rounded out the top five.

Nelson Vollbrecht of Stanton won the "B" feature.

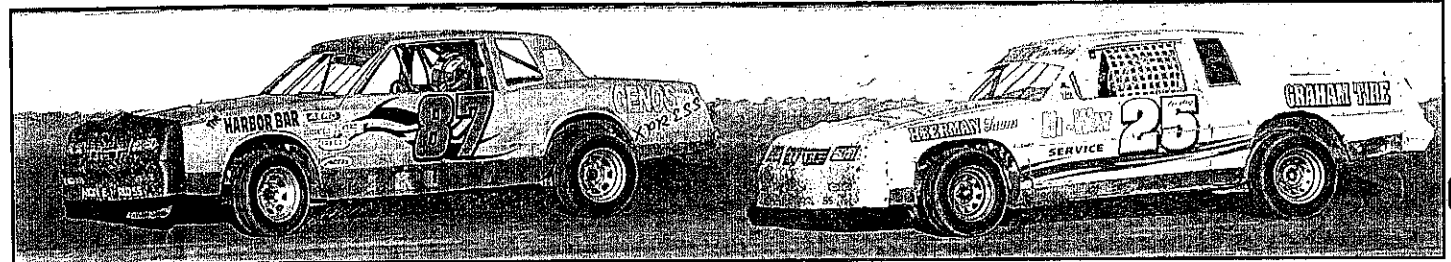

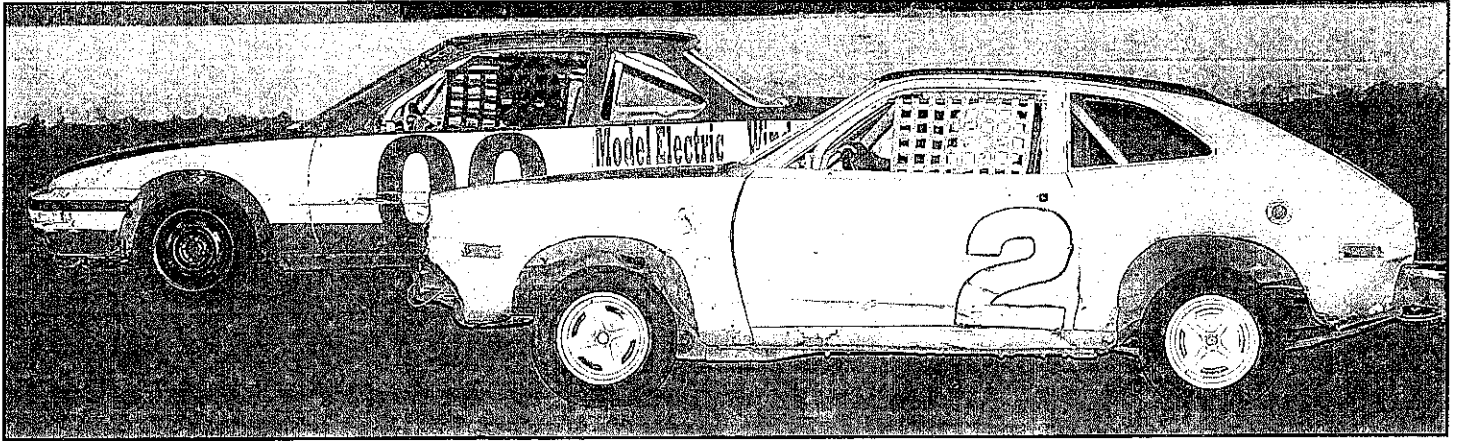

Pospisil said it is important to keep the car's momentum going through the corners because it takes a lot for the four-cylinder engines to get back up to speed.

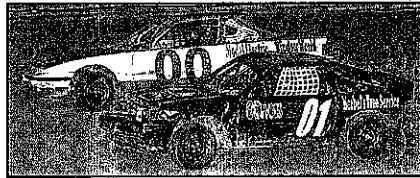
When the three-time winner went into turn one behind leader Darrell Doerr of Plainview the two touched spinning out Doerr.

was a little sideways going into the turn and by the time he reacted, it was too late.

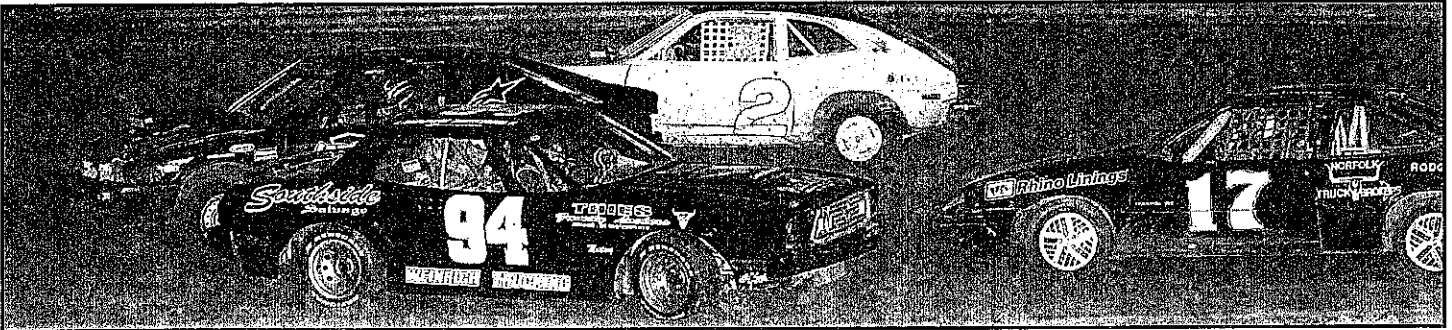
Pospisil was warned for the incident and went onto the win. Angie Collins of Norfolk took sec-
