


Weather Policy

flag racing was seven laps, which Primrose had turned into a large lead.


Primrose continued to run hard, as the race for second heated up in the closing laps, as Ron Pettitt of Norfolk caught up with Freeman.

Pettitt made the pass for second on the final lap and made it the second straight night that Primrose and Pettitt finished one-two.


Freeman finished third. Fourth went to Troy Bruns of Wayne and Brian Koch of Norfolk rounded out the top five.

Ryan Rohde of Carroll won the "B" feature, transferring







Norfolk driver claims first win of season

Chad Jensen of Norfolk started on the inside of the third row, but it took 15 laps for him to find the top spot.

A rough track dictated the way round the dirt oval making the drivers race the track as well as other drivers.

JR Strong of Norfolk led the first 13 laps, before Cory Haase of Norfolk paced the field for a lap.

On lap 15, Jensen moved out front. Five laps after Jensen took the lead, the only caution was thrown erasing a straightaway lead.

On the restart, it was Jensen first, Doug Tomka of Stanton second and Billy Sukup of Norfolk third.

Jensen went back to work and ran just high enough to miss the craters created in turns three and four forcing any who wanted to challenge for the lead to go through the very rough part of the track.

Jensen won and Tomka held onto second.



Starting 10th, Taylor Caldwell of Stanton raced his way to a fourth place finish. It was his third straight fourth place.


Sukup rounded out the top five.



Chris Johnson (7) prepares to hot lap at the start of the night. He finished third in his heat race.








Billy Sukup (101) and Jim Johnson (36) run side-by-side in their feature, while Johnson placed sixth.







Taylor Caldwell (90) runs with BJ Haase (4) in their heat race. Caldwell finished fourth in the "A" for the third time.

Nelson Vollbrecht of Stanton won the "B" feature.



was a little sideways going into the turn and by the time he reacted, it was too late.






