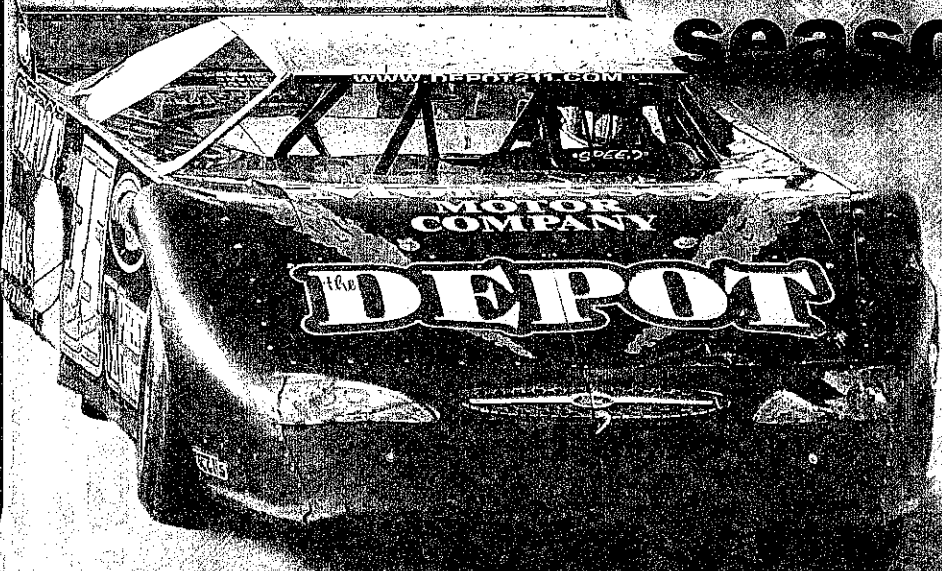

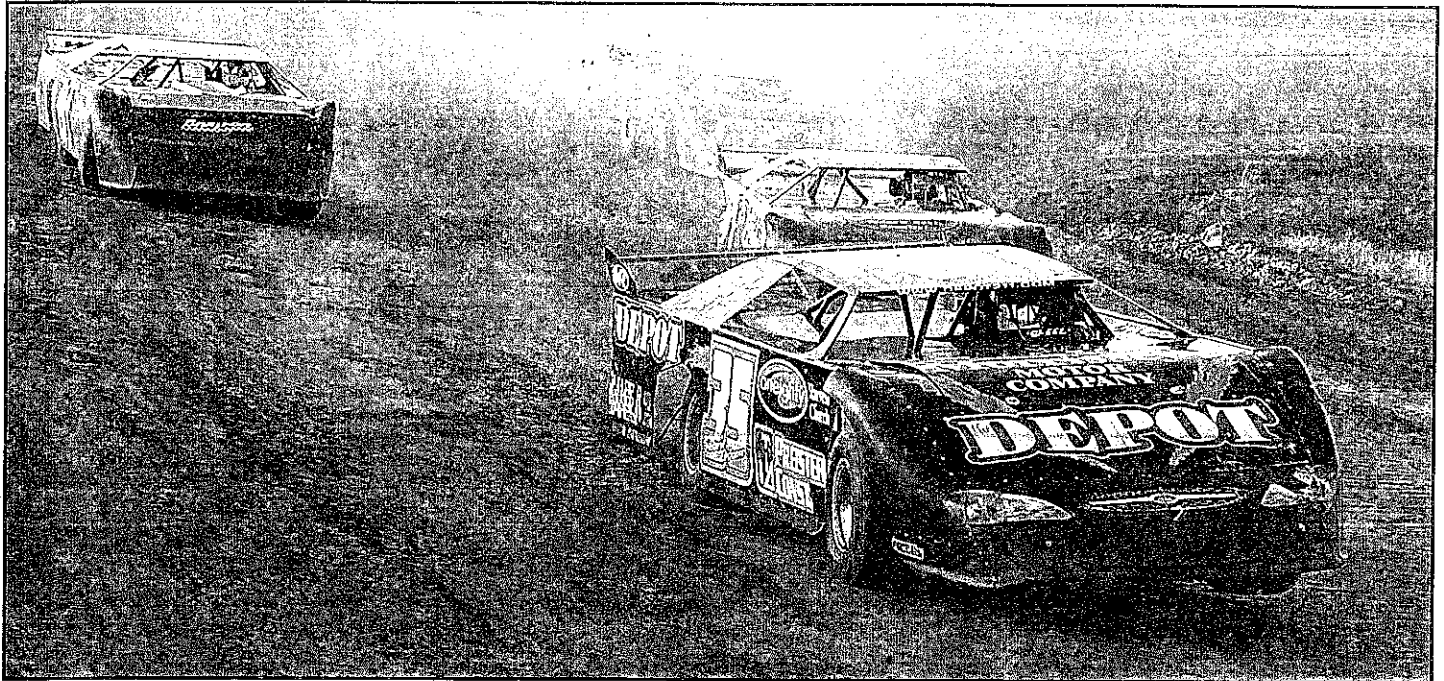


Weather Policy

Osborne doubles victories

Last week was one of those nights you look to the sky to find the full moon.

But even the moon did not want to get blamed for the misfortunes on or off the track.

Not having a stellar year, Robert Osborne of Norfolk has only finished in the top 5 half the time, three other drivers having more.

Osborne started last week's "A" feature on the inside of the third row and quickly moved into the top 3 on the second lap.

BJ Haase of Norfolk led the first four laps when Warren Jensen of Norfolk took over.

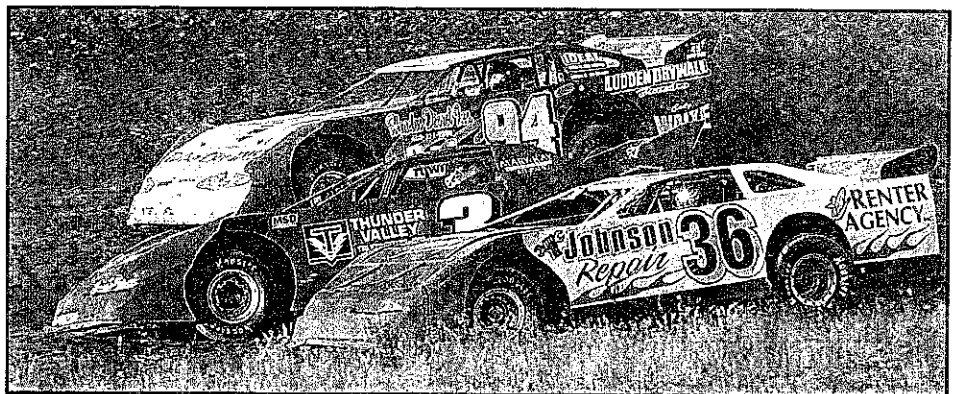
Osborne, who could not get passed Haase or Jensen, lost a position to Billy Sukup of Norfolk in his attempts to get by Haase.

Osborne settled back to watch and see if Sukup could make the pass on Haase.

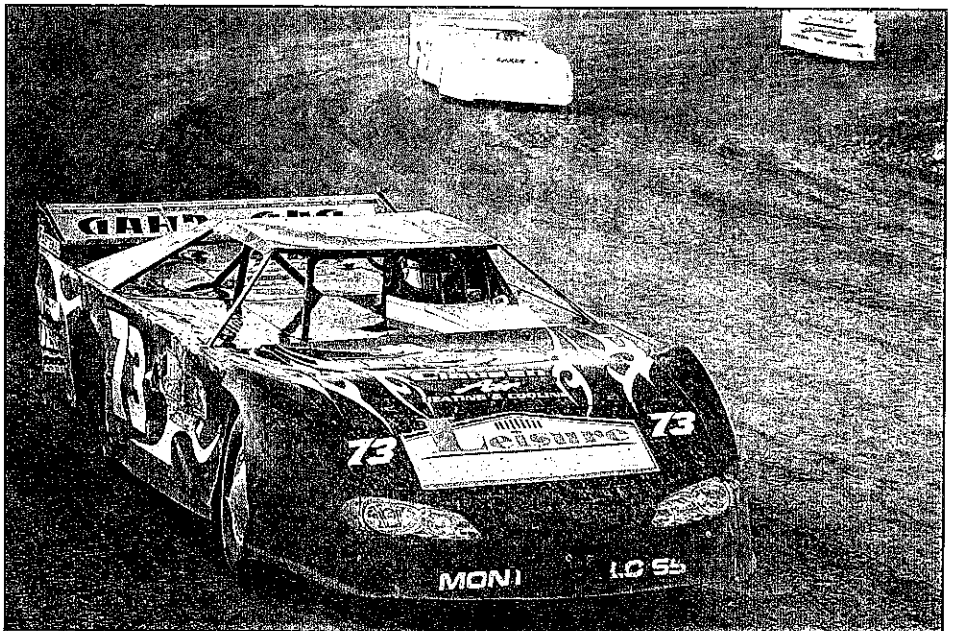
Haase brought out the second caution after he spun.

On the restart, Sukup got a good run off turn two and could not avoid making contact with the leader Jensen.

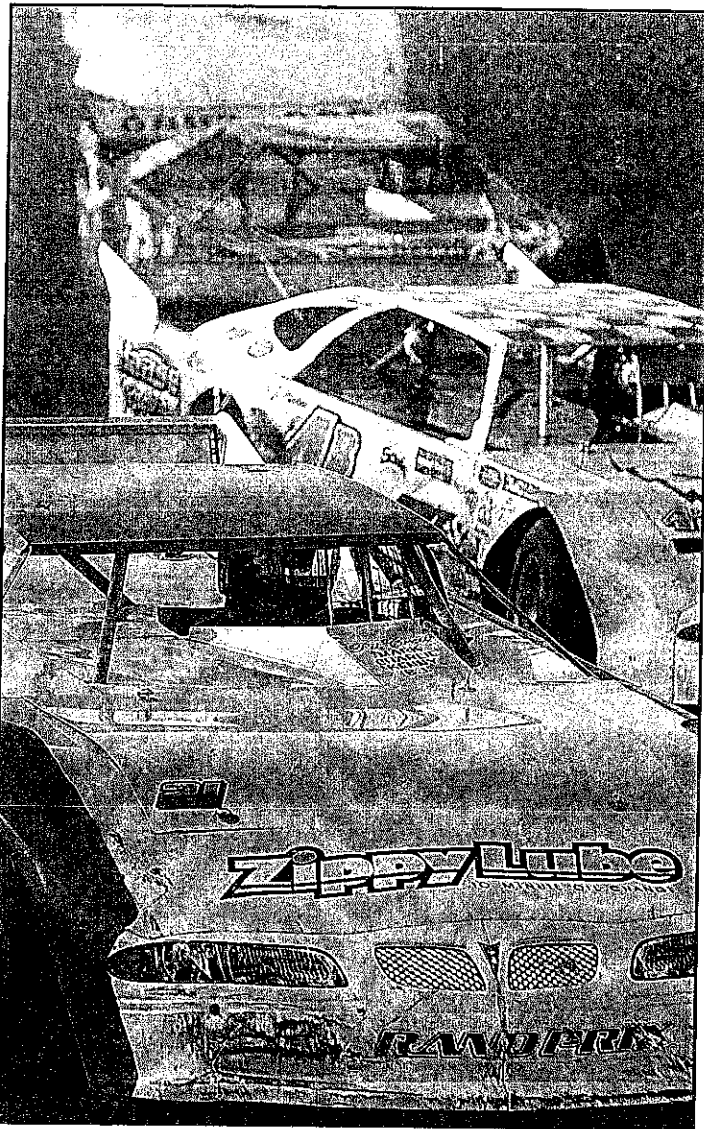
Jensen spun out sending Sukup to the pits for his second rough driving penalty.



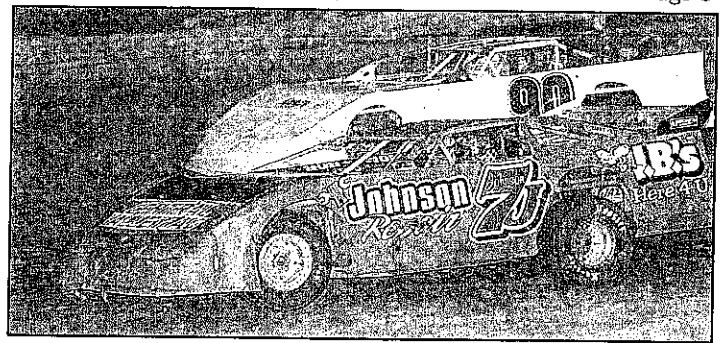
Jim Johnson (36) runs the inside on JR Strong (3) and Jeff Haase (94) in their first race. Haase placed second in main event.

Jensen led lap 11, but as Jensen and Osborne were completing lap 12, the two touched. Jensen bounced off Osborne and ended up in the wall.

Officials said Jensen caused the incident. That put Osborne first, second to Jeff Haase of Norfolk, who had gotten around Cory Haase on lap 11.

The rest of the race went green and Osborne checked out. He started lapping the field on the 18th circuit and had a straight away advantage over second by lap 19.

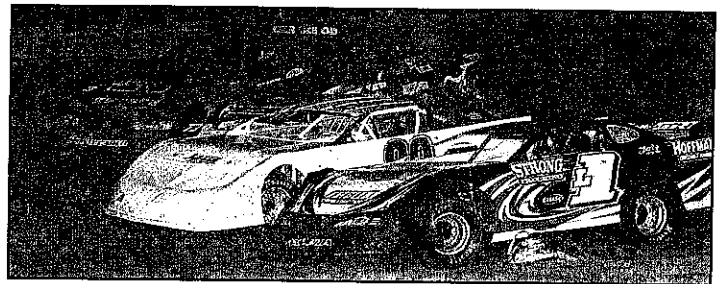
Osborne pickup his second win of the season and Jeff Haase matched his best effort of the season at second.

Chad Jensen of Norfolk slipped passed Cory Haase on lap 20 of the 25-lap feature to take third place. It was Jensen's fourth straight top 5 finish.

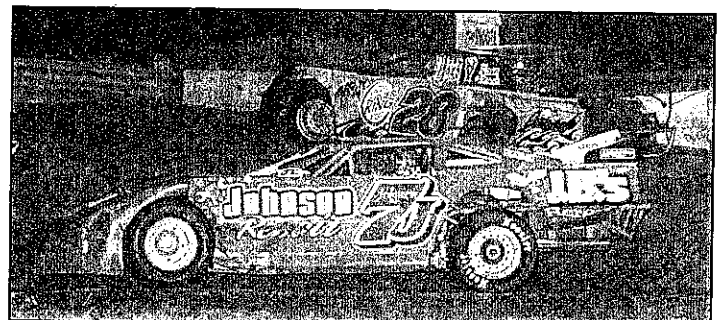
Cory Haase best effort of the season and his first top 5 at the fourth position.

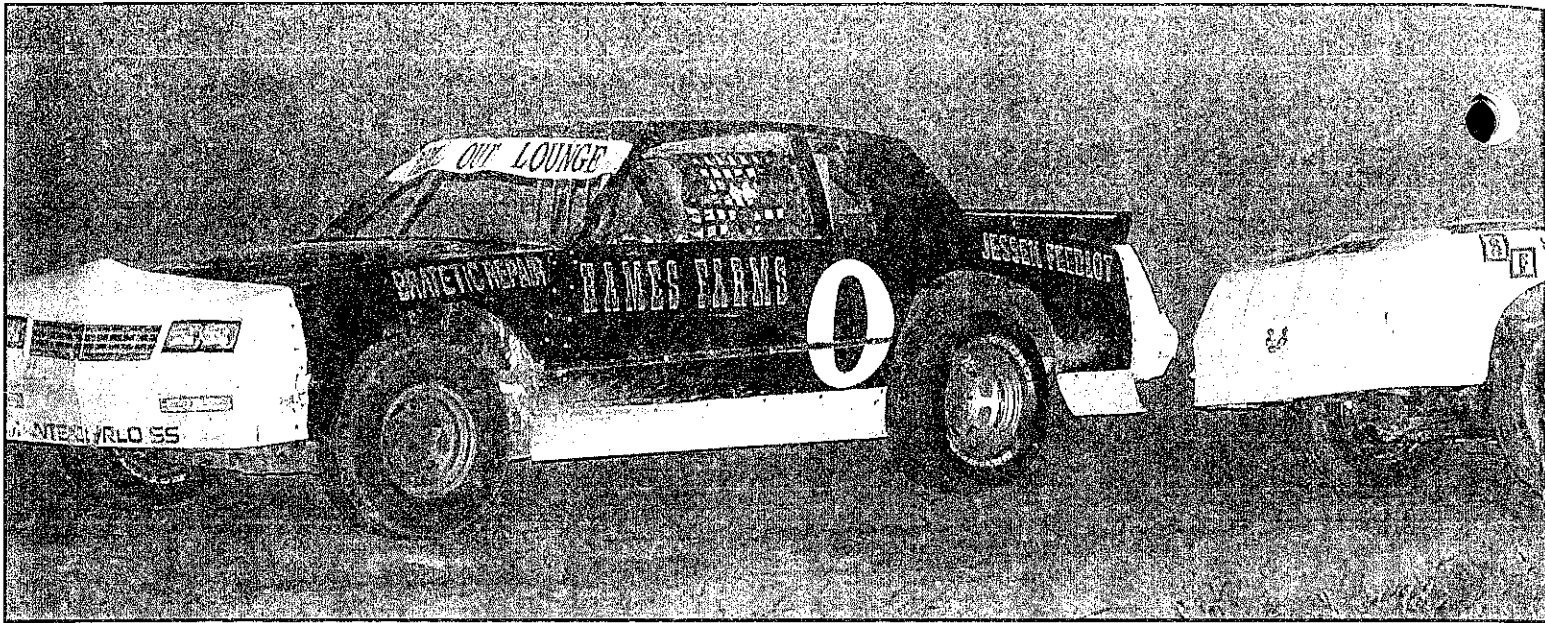


Chris Johnson (7) passes Warren Jensen (28), who crashed into the front stretch wall while racing for the lead.

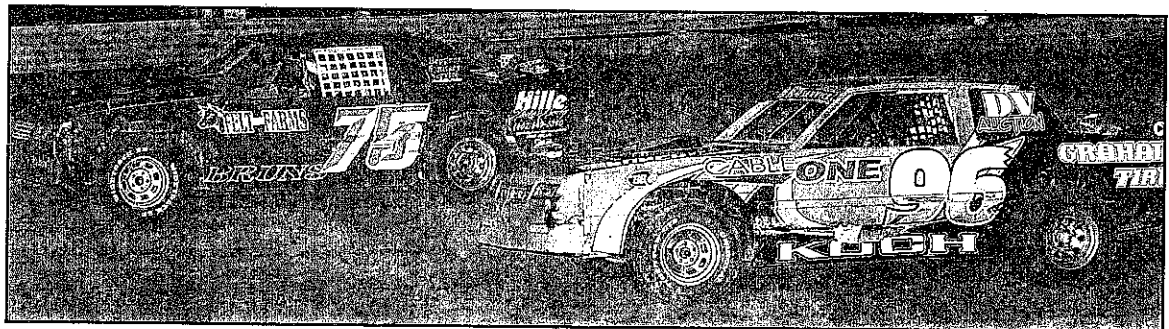
Jason Freeman of Bloomfield won the "B" feature with Tate Weinrich and TeJay Mielke, both of Norfolk transferring to the main event, as well.

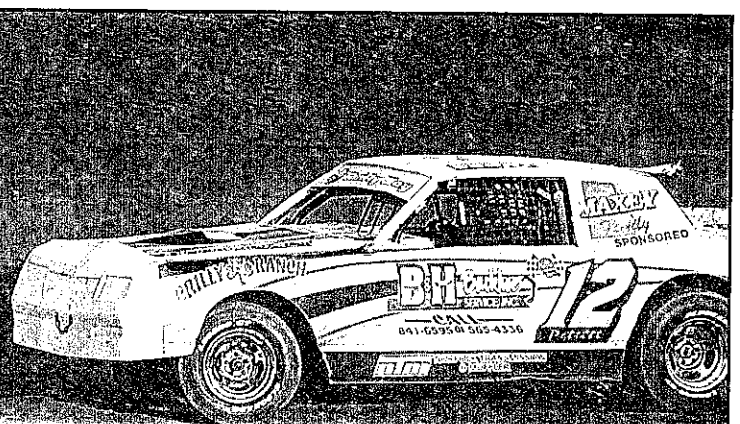

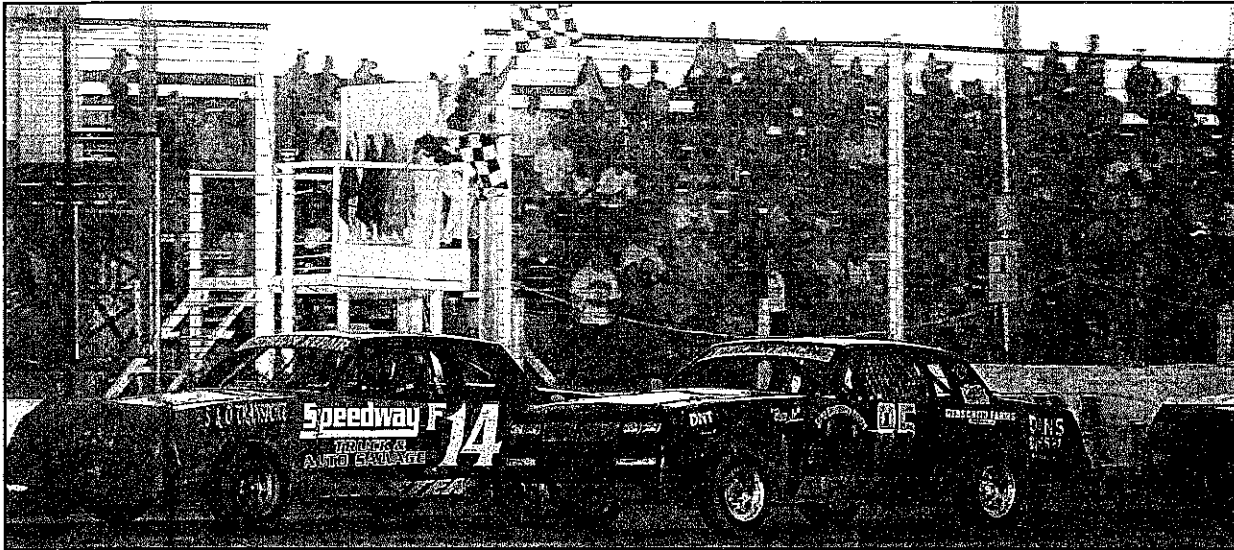

Kersten first in close finish

In one of the best races of the season, four drivers challenged for the win in the final laps.

Matt Kersten of Norfolk may have come out on top for his first win of the season, but it came down to the finals laps.

It was the only feature to go green-white-checked, even though cars dropped out of the race like flies.

Grant Hurlbert of Winside grabbed the early lead and led the first 13 laps. Kersten, Mark Arduser of Battle Creek and track points leader Sean Spann of Wayne slowly closed in on the leader. Arduser moved into the second spot by lap four.

On lap 11 of the 15-lap feature, Kersten moved into third

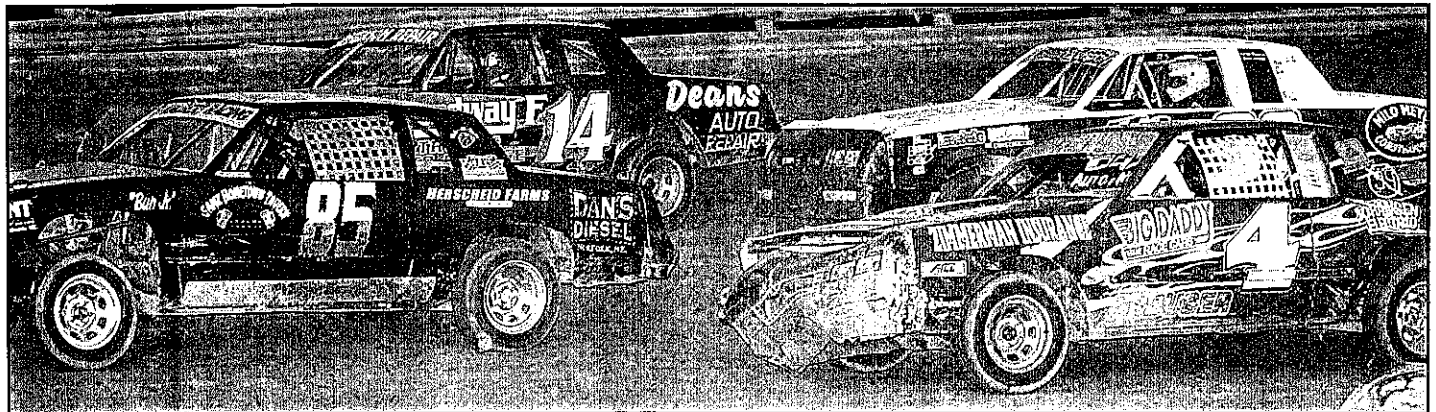
and Spann fourth.

Kersten managed to get by Arduser on the next lap, but as the cars finished lap 13 they were three wide. Hurlbert held the edge over Kersten, who had the edge over Spann.

Kersten led lap 14 with Hurlbert alongside with Spann and Arduser crossing the line side-by-side behind the leaders.

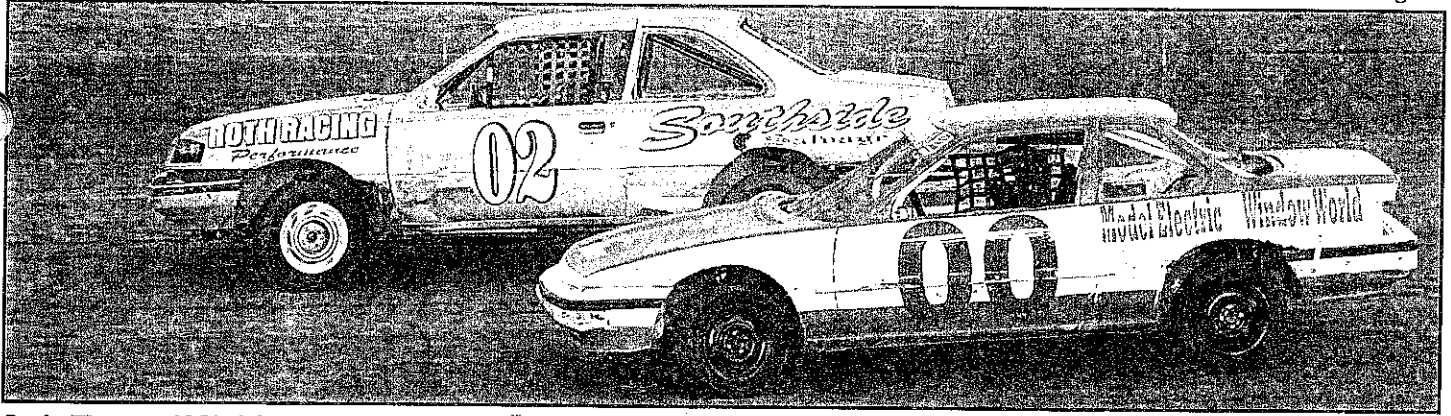
Kersten held off Hurlbert for the win as Hurlbert took home second. Arduser got back by Spann in the final lap for third place. Spann was fourth.

It appears it does not matter who drivers the double zero car, it just finds its way to victory lane.

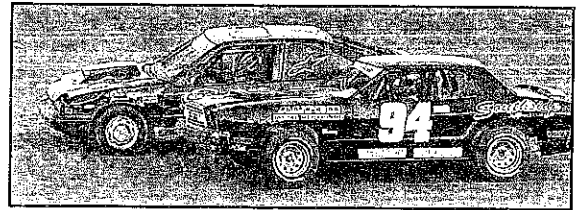
Shannon Pospisil of Norfolk won the first four feature races and now Cody Thoene took the car to victory lane.

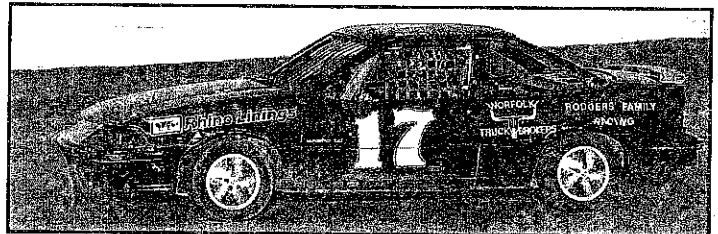
Haase's car was done allowing Kevin Haase of Norfolk to inherit the lead with Thoene running second.

It took one lap for Thoene to make the pass for the lead. He went onto win for the cars fifth-straight feature.

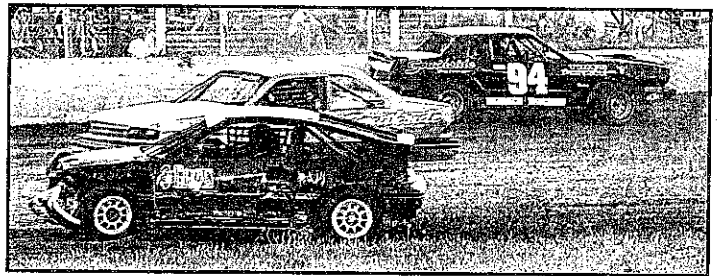
Kevin Haase was second, Adam Wagner of Norfolk finished third, Jeremy Barg of Norfolk was fourth and Collins rounded out the top 5.

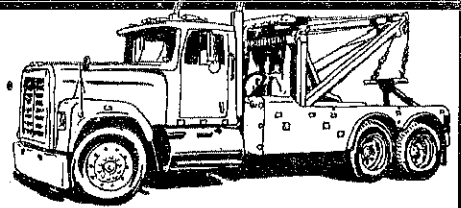

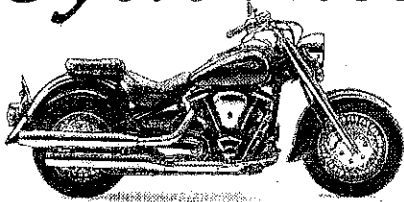

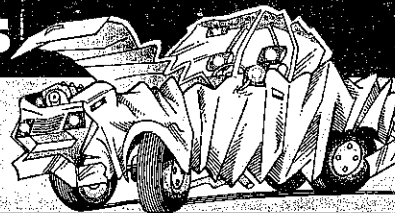
