Brian Koch of Norfolk may have scored the win, but he would have rather battled for it.

Koch started in the 11th position and worked his way through the field at the laps clicked away.

By lap 11 of the 18-lap feature, Koch was running third to Travis Birkley of Wakefield, who led from the drop of the green flag, and Tad Behmer of Winside.

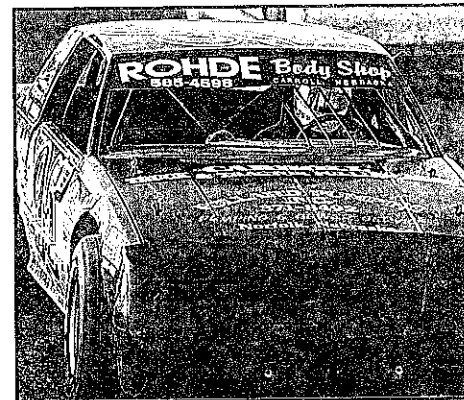
With two laps remaining, Birkley and Behmer got together in turns one and two when Behmer went for the lead. The two got together again exiting turn two.

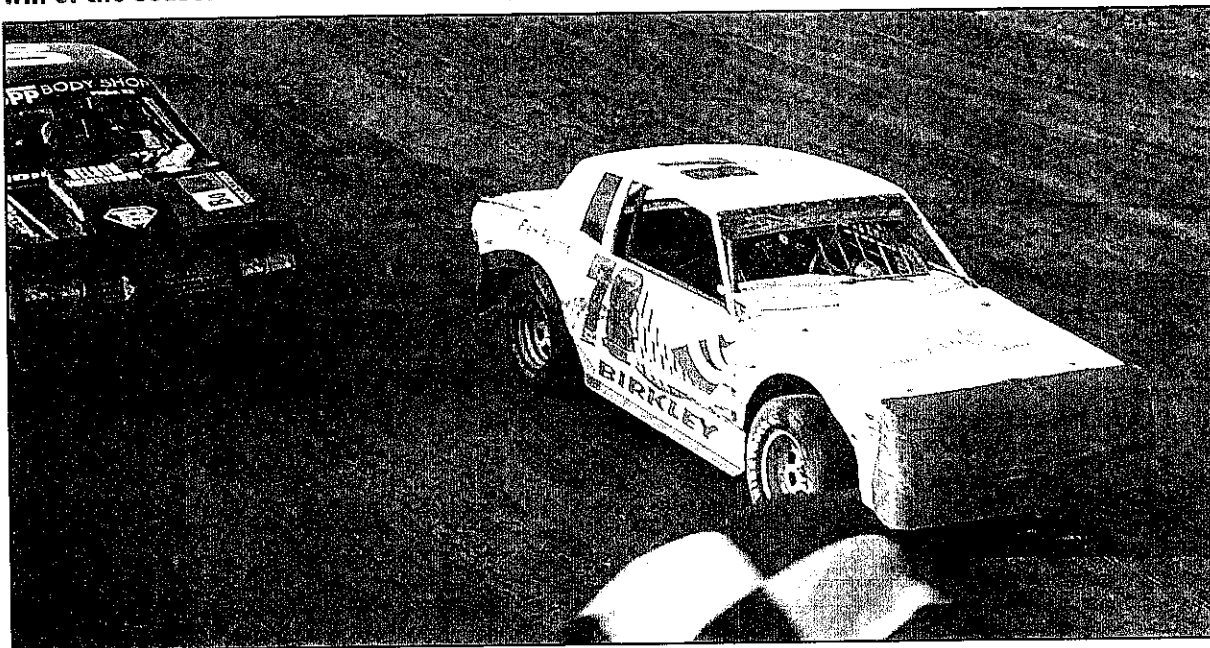
That incident moved Koch to second behind Behmer.



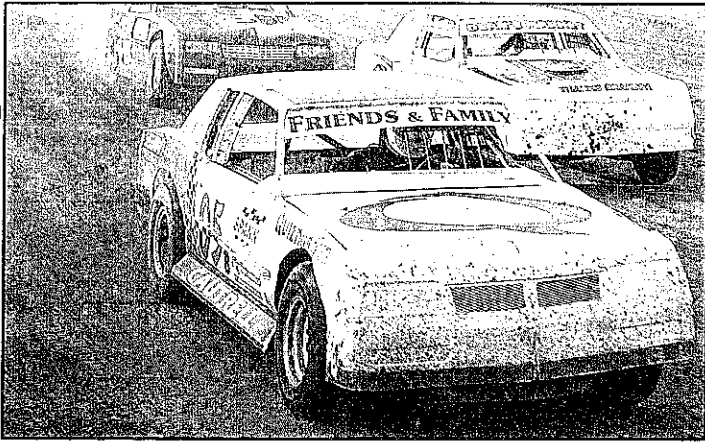
Brian Koch (96) won both his heat and the "A" feature. It was his second win of the season.

Pettitt, who finished fourth, caught a break when shortly

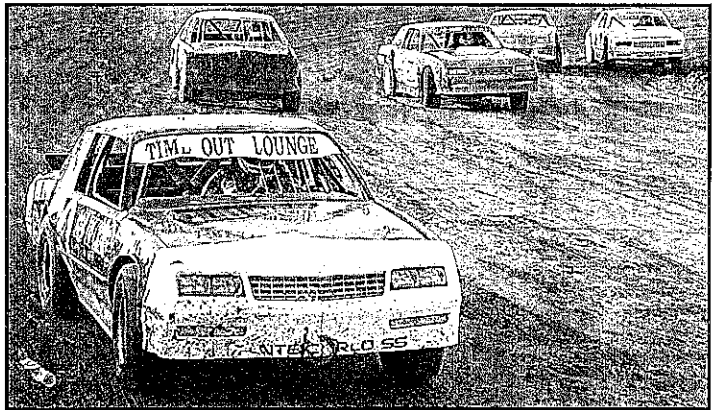
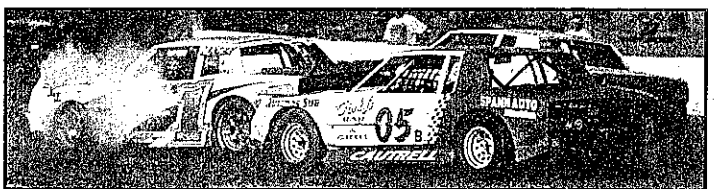
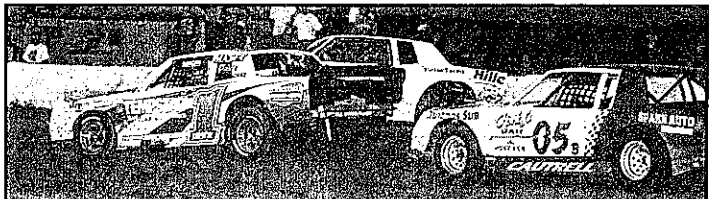
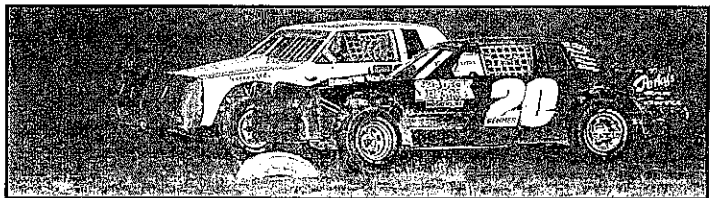
after suffering a flat tire a caution came out. Restarting at the rear of the field on lap seven, Pettitt worked his way back to the fourth place.

TeJay Mielke of Norfolk won the "B" feature with Eric Haase of Norfolk and Troy Bruns of Wayne taking second and third.

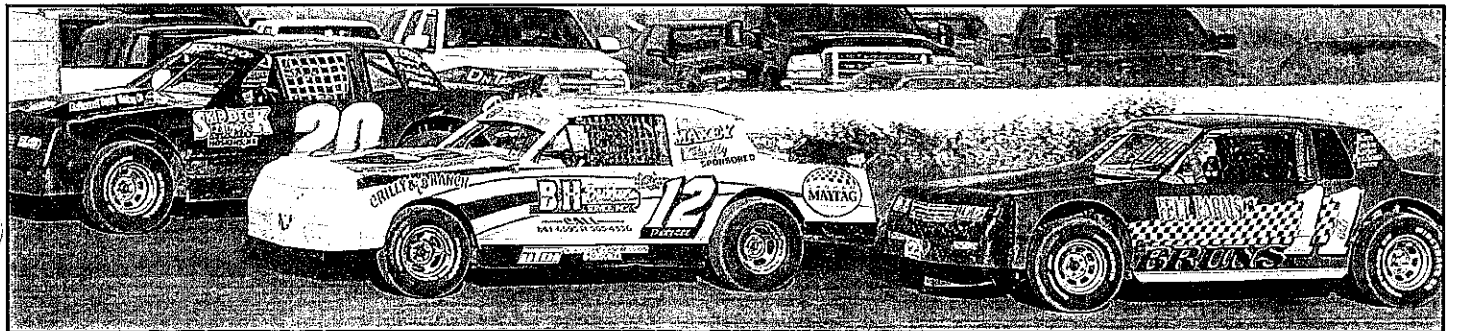
Pettitt, Koch and Rohde each won their heat race.

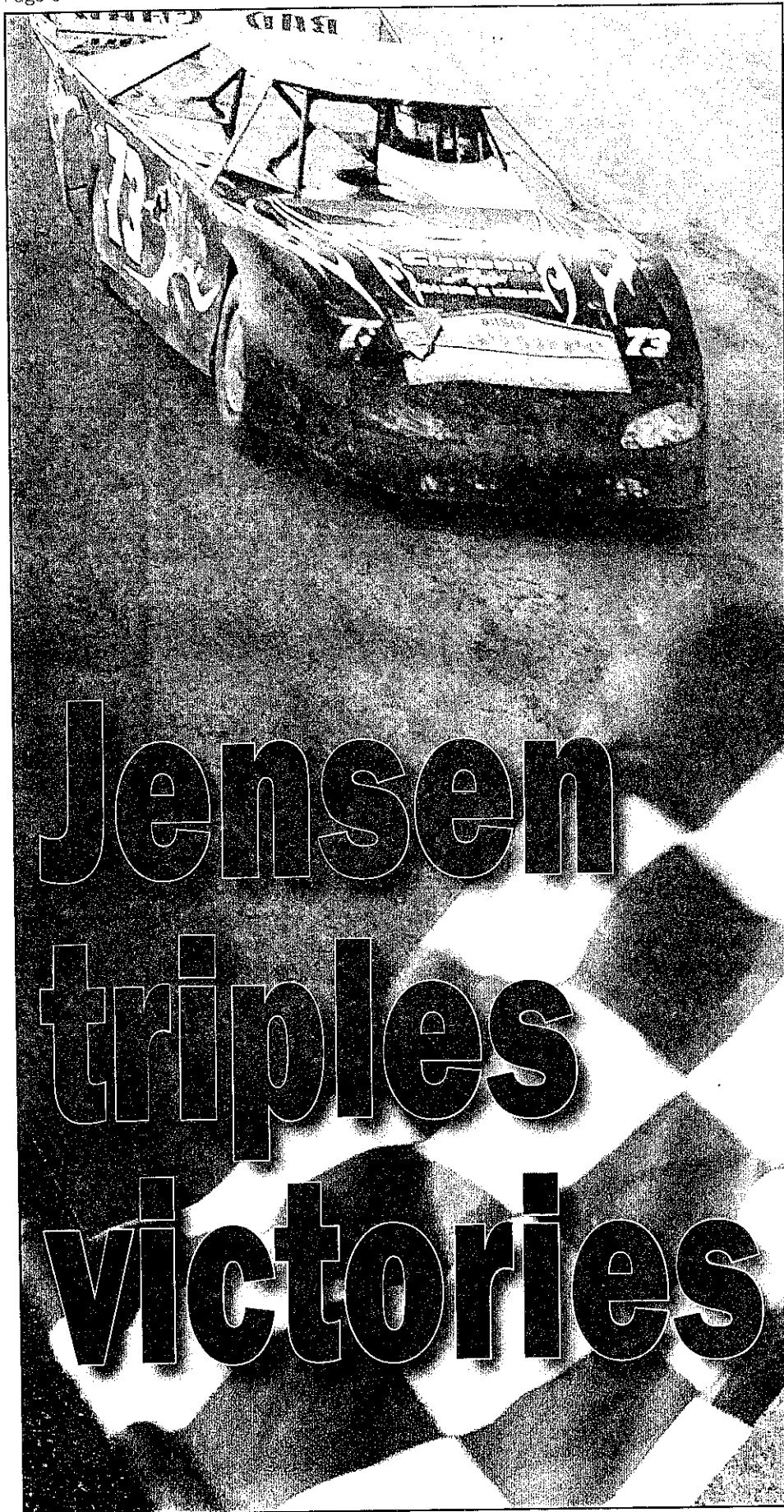

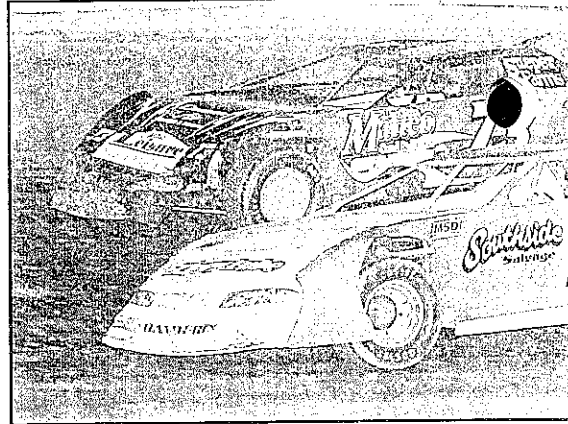


Tad Behmer (20) , Ron Pettitt (12) and Chad Bruns (11) compete in their heat race.

Johnson led through the first 10 laps on the same track.

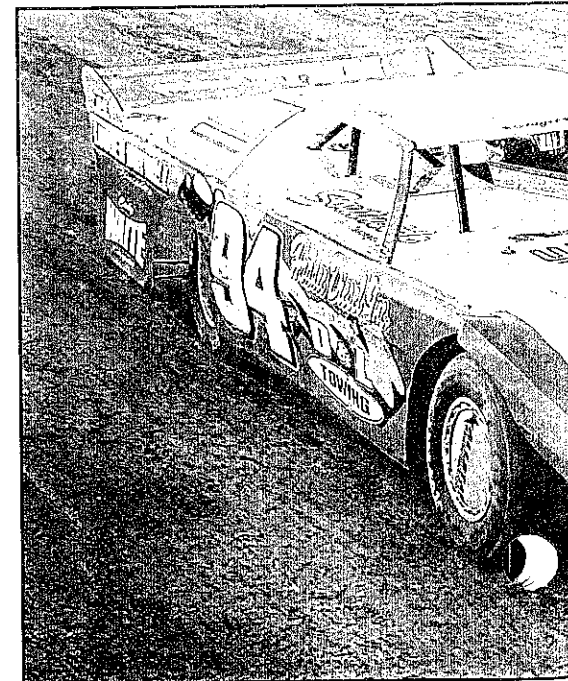

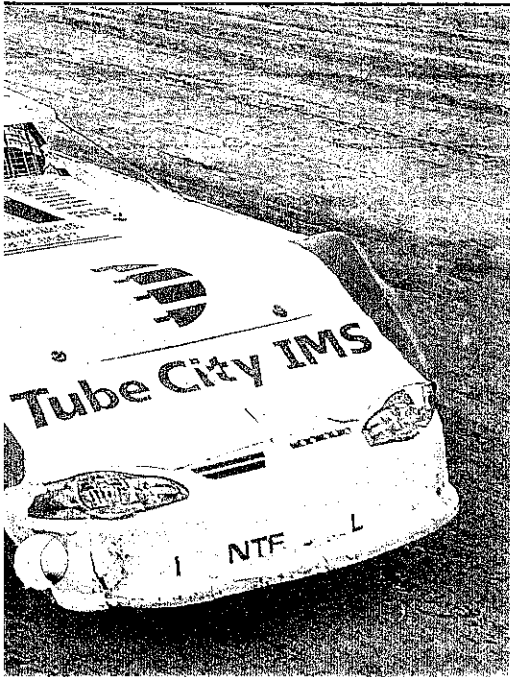


Chad Jensen takes over the top spot in the track standings with his win last week.

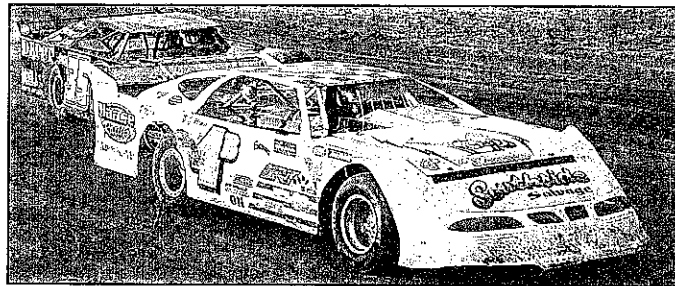

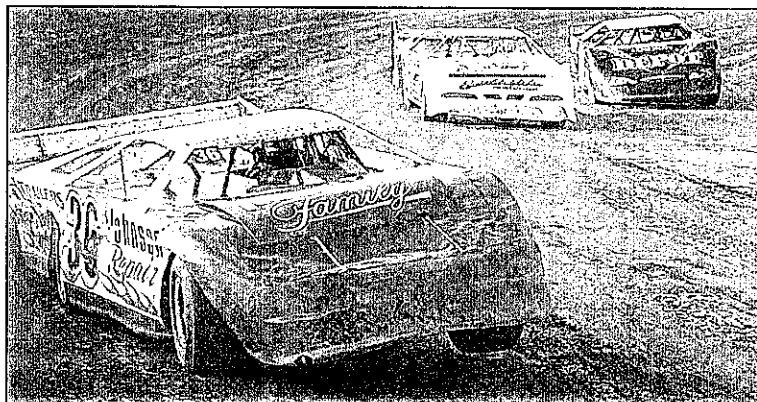

Kruse held onto second, as a third-place battle kept the field busy behind him.

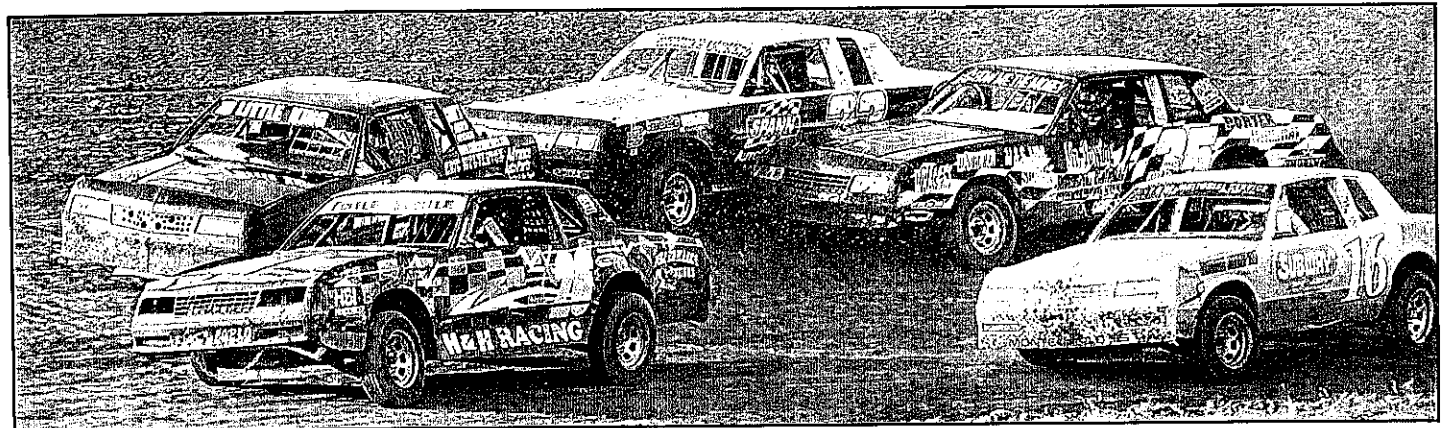
The battle was between Jeremy Hoskinson of Norfolk and Kimmel. The two drivers swapped the position several times in six laps as they raced

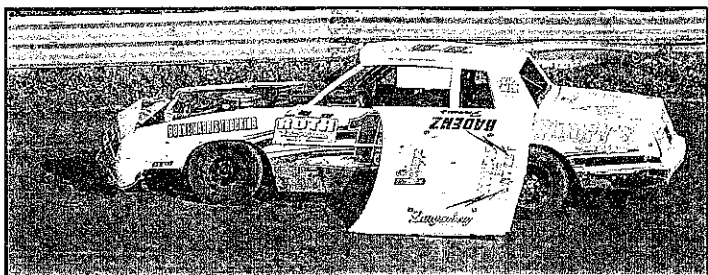
