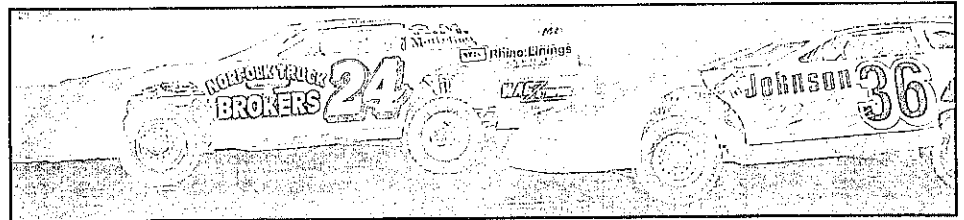
Weather Policy

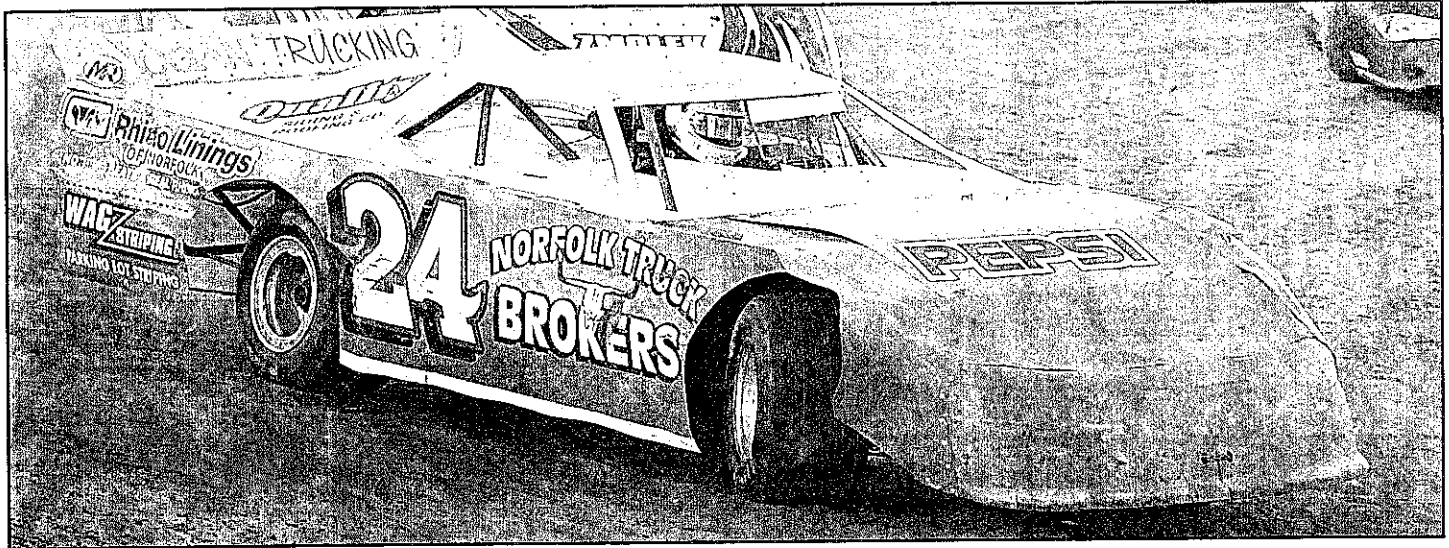
Birthday wishes and Announcements

It was as close as Jim Johnson (36) could get to passing Tom Wagner (24) from the lead in the "A" feature. The two finished one-two.



Veteran ends winless streak

The Grand National "A" feature started three times last week, but after it got going it went straight through to the end.

Veteran Grand National driver Tom Wagner of Norfolk picked up his first win since May 15, 2004.

Wagner led from the start of the 25-lap feature and led the entire distance. Jim Johnson of Plainview was the only driver to put pressure on Wagner late in the race, but Johnson could only get his fender along side.

By lap 17, Wagner caught

lapped traffic. Car by car, he worked his way through. Johnson closed in several times, but he had to deal with lap traffic.

Wagner went onto to win his first since 2004. Last season his best finish was third and 2005 he claimed a second place.

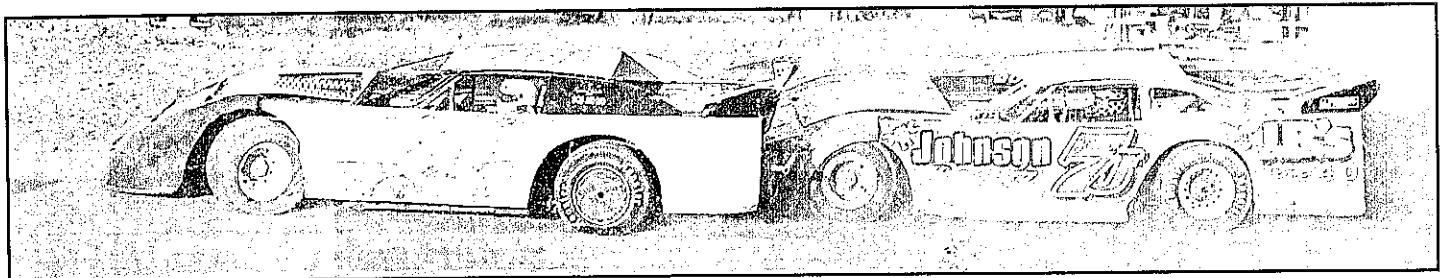
Johnson held onto second, as Billy Sukup of Norfolk run third. Fourth went to Jeff Haase of Norfolk, has three-straight top 4 finishes.

Rounding out the top 5 was Cory Haase of Norfolk, his third-straight top 5.

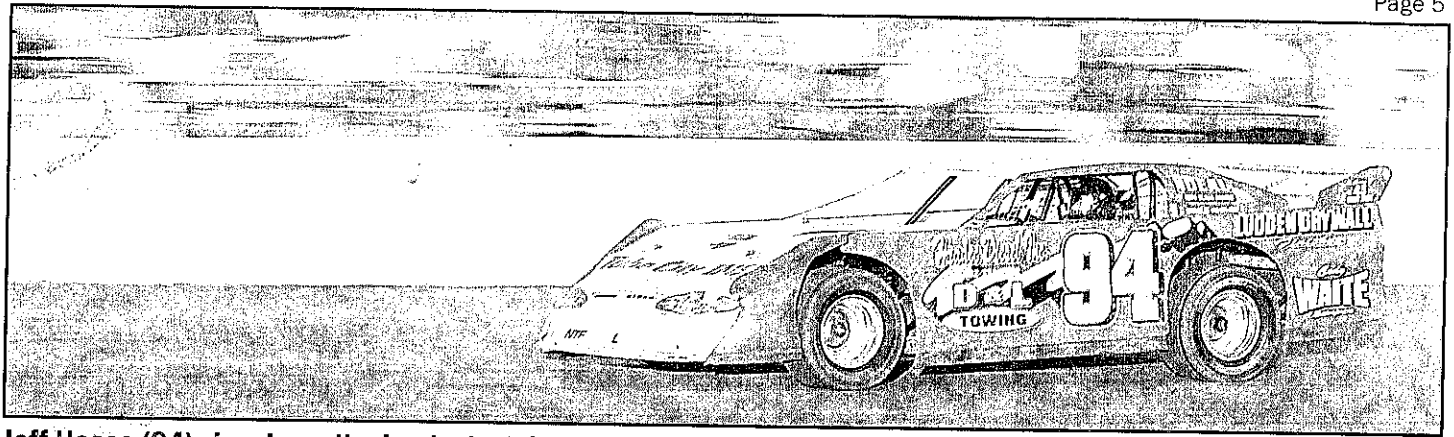

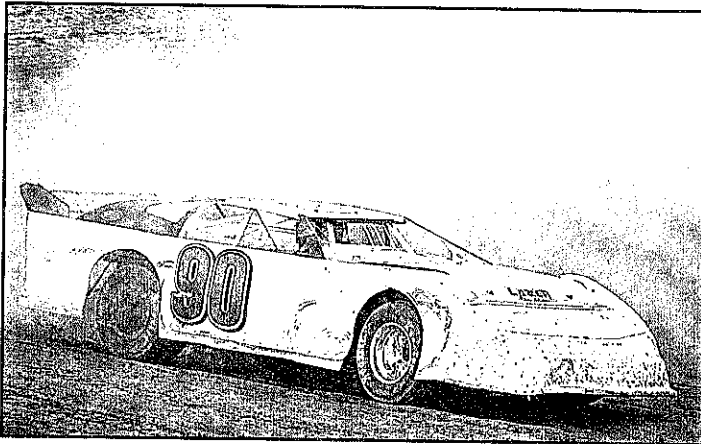

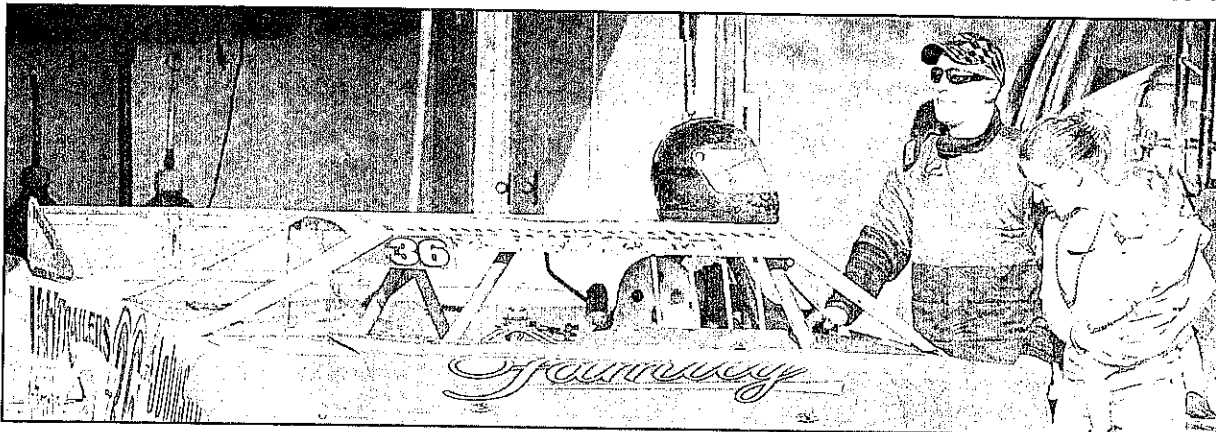

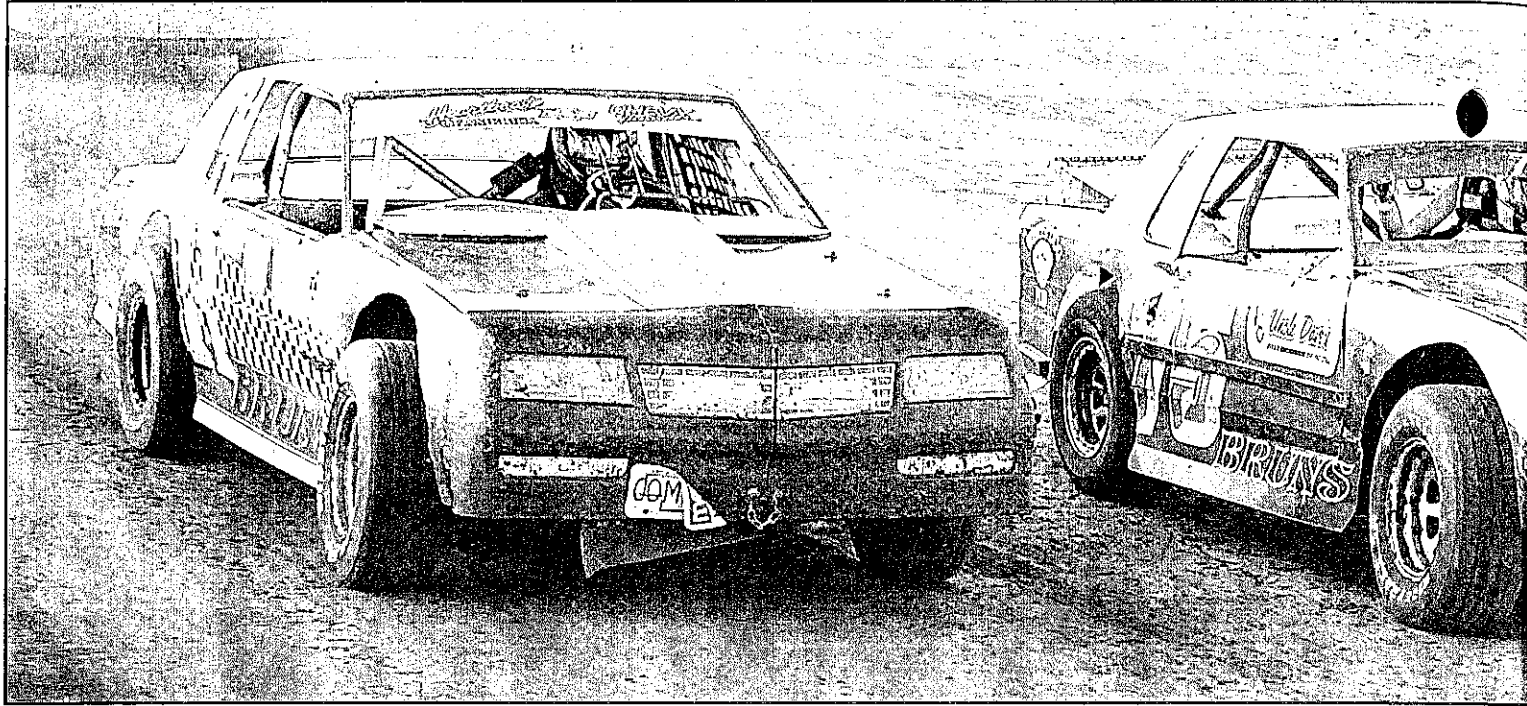

It was Troy Brunns' first win.

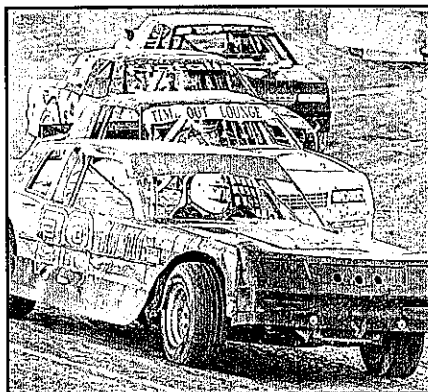
Primrose took the runner-up position.

Jason Hames of Crofton finished third for his third finish.

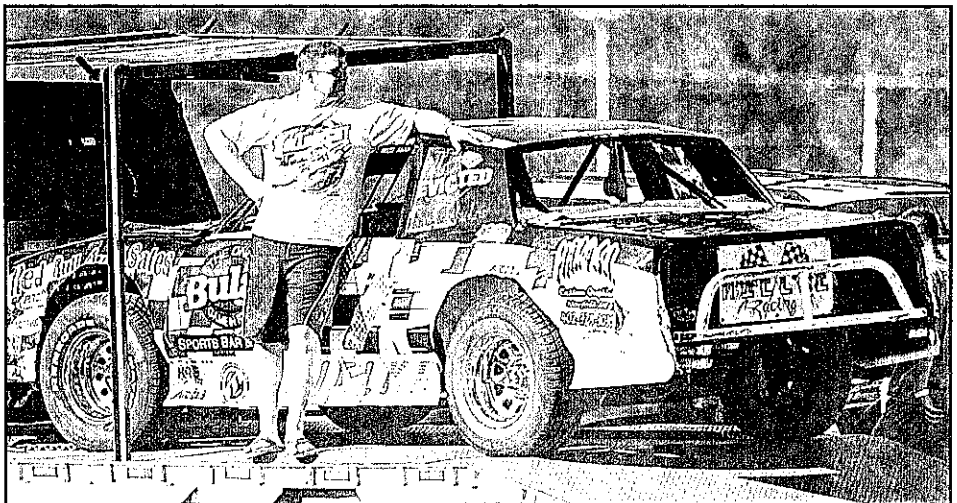
TeJay Mielke of Norfolk finished fourth and Brian Koch of Crofton rounded out the top 5.

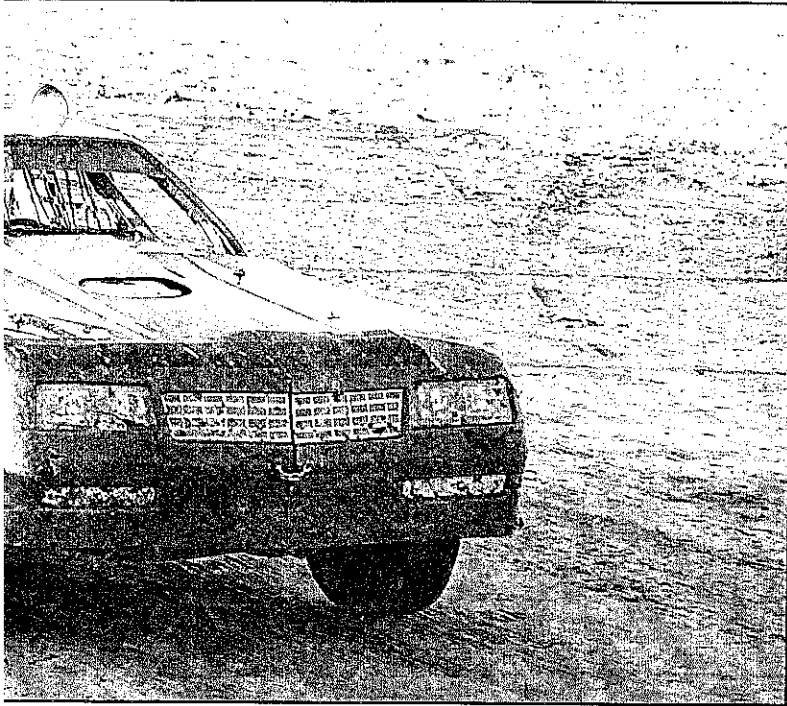

Kimmel drove away but did not return. Brabec car was drug to the infield.

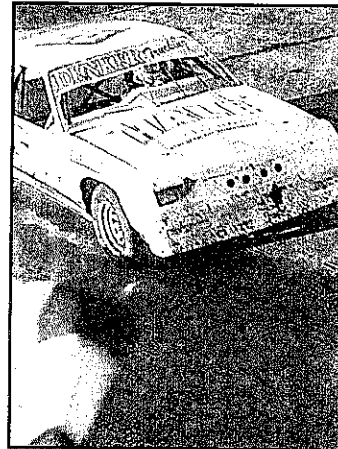
On the restart, Hoskinson was leading, Michael Tomasek of Norfolk and Spann were running two and three.

Spann pressured Hoskinson and on the final four laps, the two drove side-by-side. Spann edged out Hoskinson at the line to cross first.

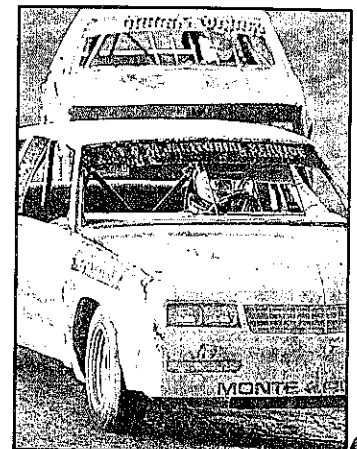
Spann was later found with illegal heads on his engine.

Kersten grabbed the fourth place and Jereme Knoell of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.



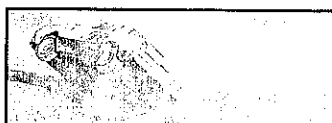
Johnny Kerby (25) takes the checkered in his heat.

Jeremy Brabec (99) talks with the wrecker crew after he had hard contact with Jim Kimmel (17) in the feature.

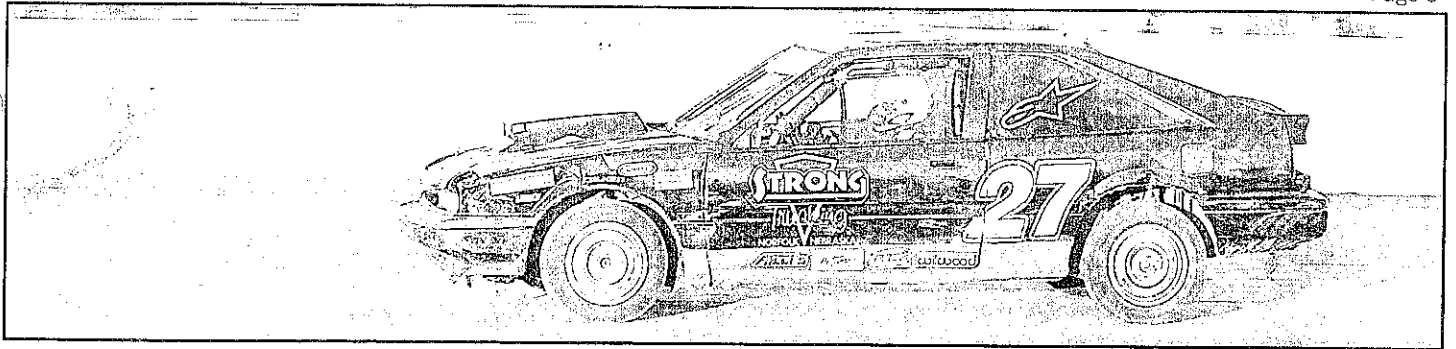


Jake Timm (29) flips his stock car in his heat race.

Shannon Pospisil of Norfolk has dominated the class and Saturday night was no different.

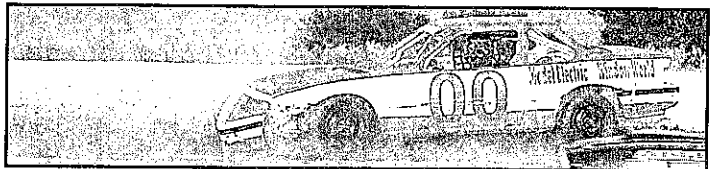
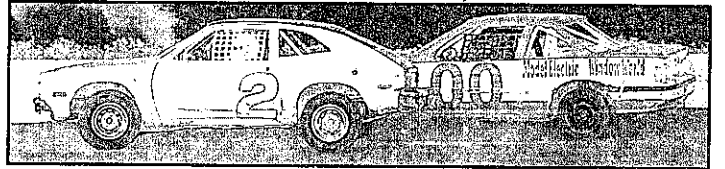

Eric Sloan of Norfolk, who shares a ride with Jeremy Barg, also of Norfolk, has been look-

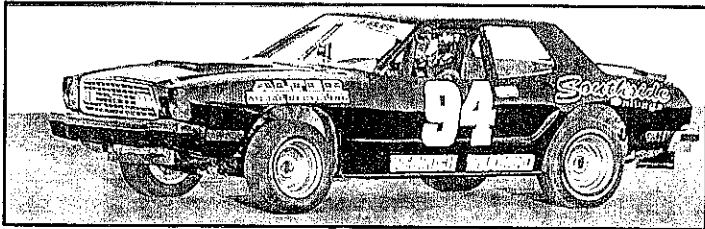
ing for a win for weeks, but circumstances has left them short of a victory each time.

Kevin Haase of Norfolk placed fourth and rounding out the top 5 was Angie Collins of Norfolk.

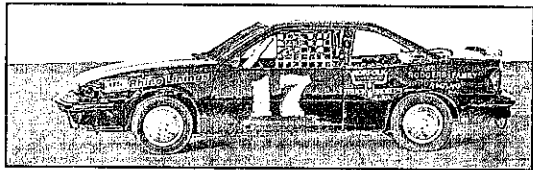
