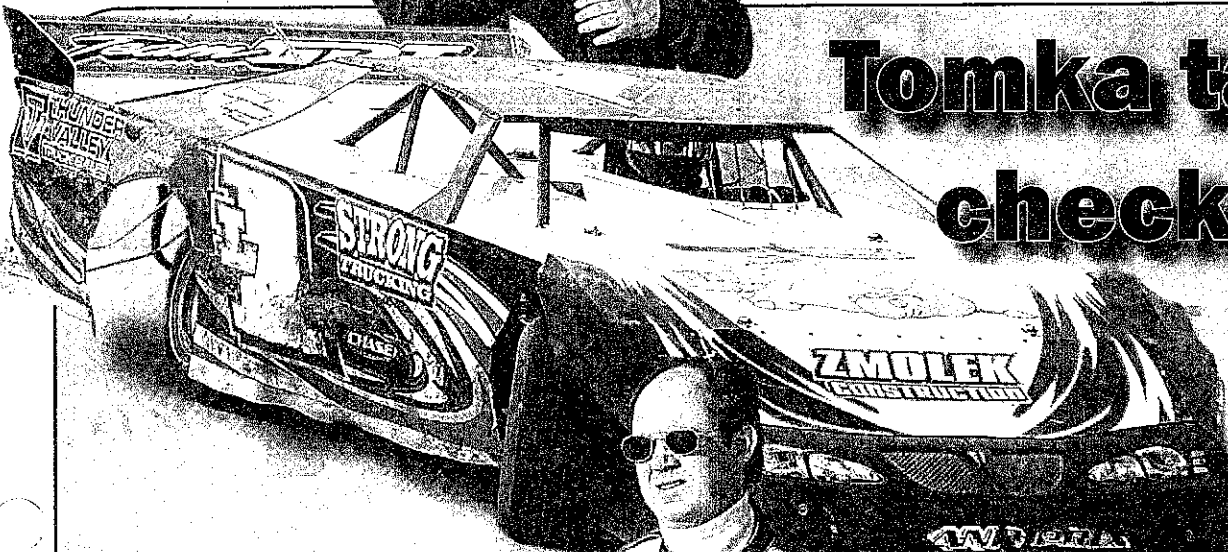

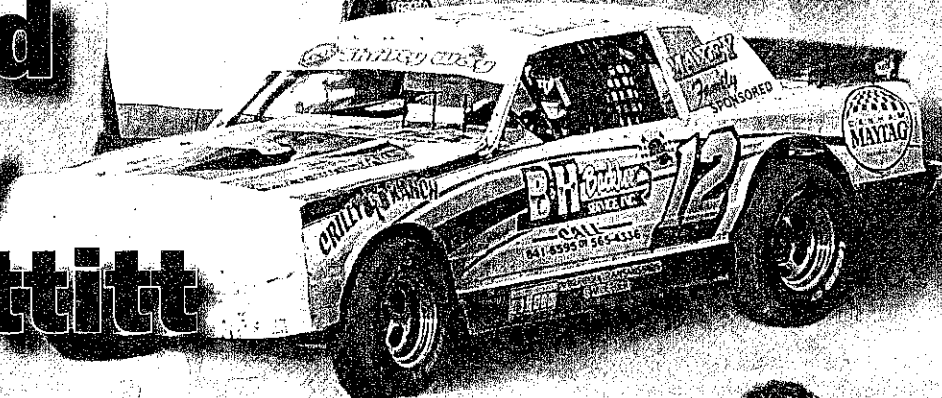

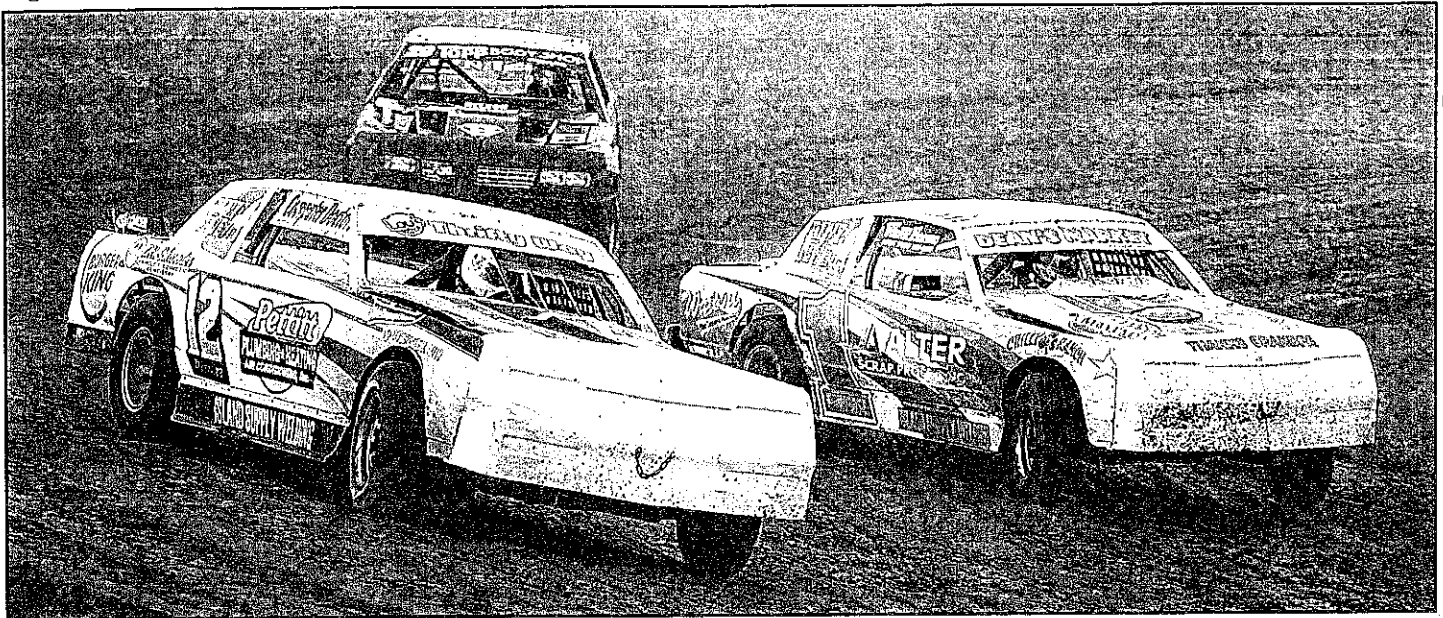

Pettitt doubles up on victories

Ron Pettitt of Norfolk found victory lane for the second time this season to continue to extend his lead in the track points list.

The former track champion started from the ninth place starting position in the main event. The feature was marred by five cautions, one of which erased a pass for the lead.

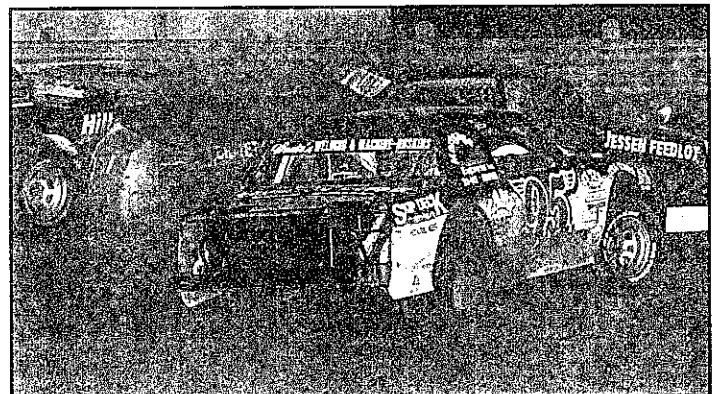
Pettitt had just got along side Travis Birkley of Wakefield for the lead, when the fourth caution flew. Birkley had led the first 12 laps.

When the race finally got back to green, Pettitt took a little time to move out front to pace the field. He led the final six circuits to take his second win of the season.

Birkley hung on for second and Tad Behmer of Winside placed third. Brant Obanion of Norfolk captured his first top 5 at the fourth position.

Jason Freeman of Bloomfield rounded out the top 5.

Birkley, Pettitt and Ryan Rohde of Carroll each won the their heat races.



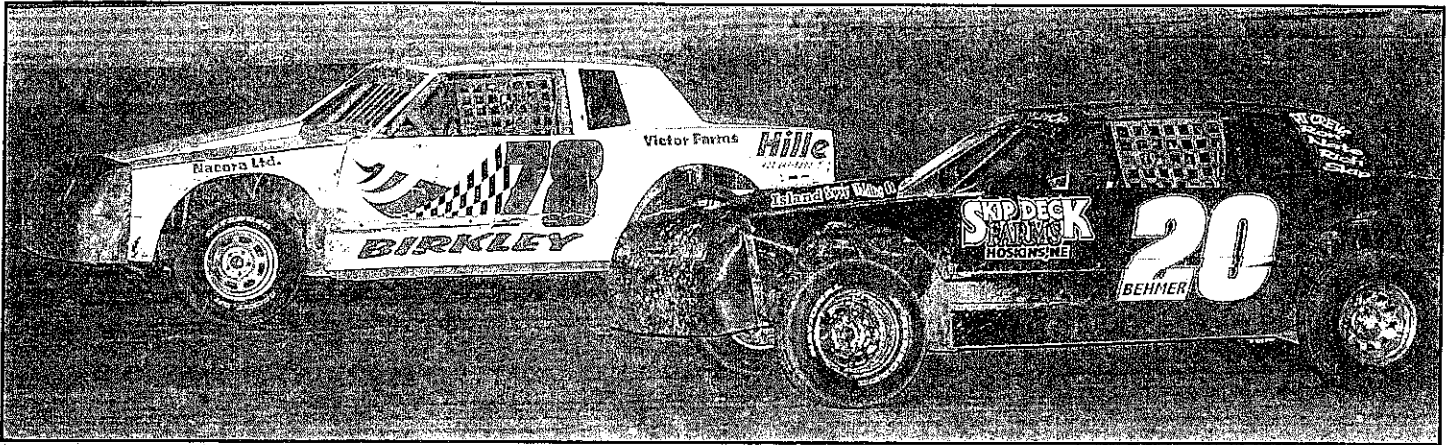
Ryan Rohde (95) gets spun out in the "A" feature. He recovered to finish seventh in the event.

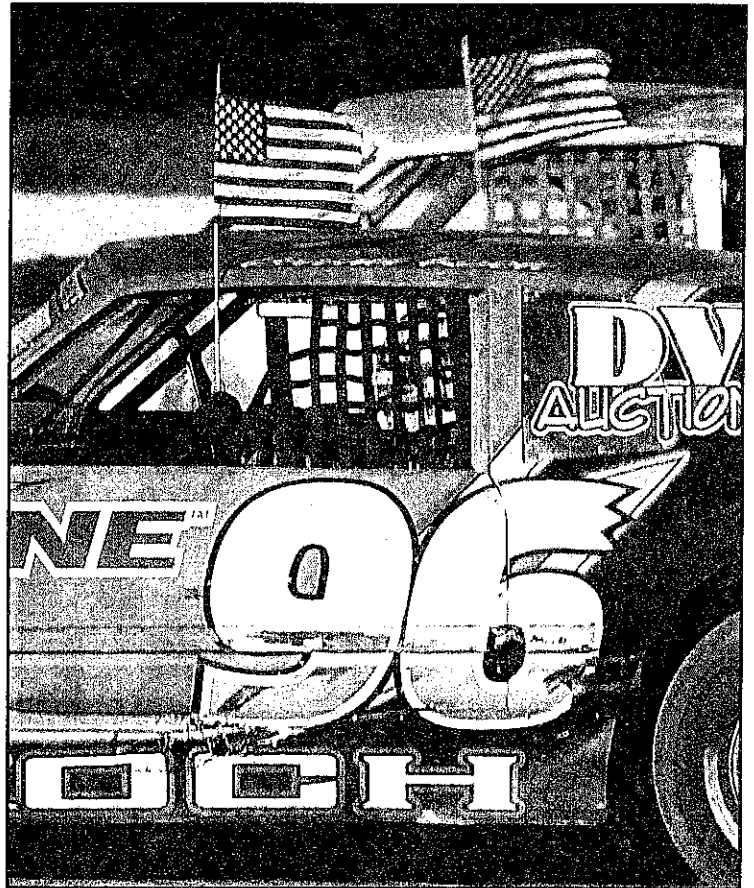
Jason Freeman (38) prepares his stock car for the night. Freeman finished fifth in the "A" feature.



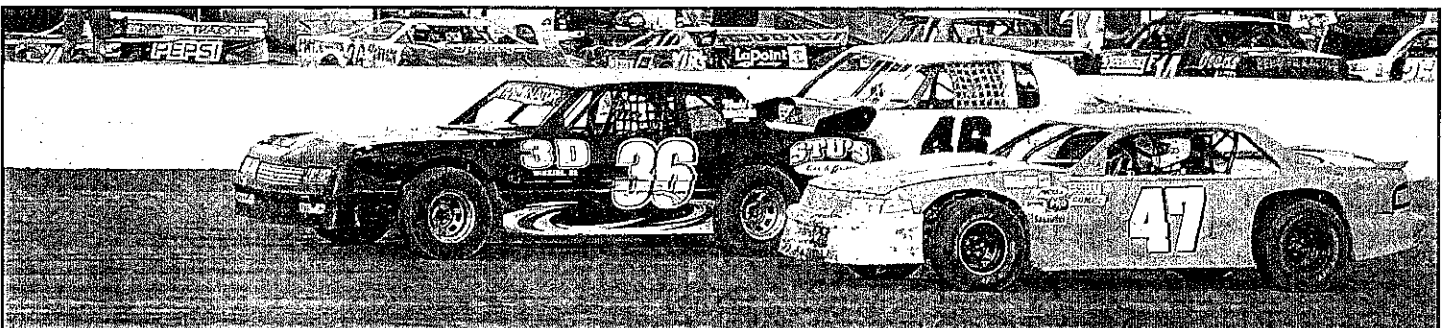

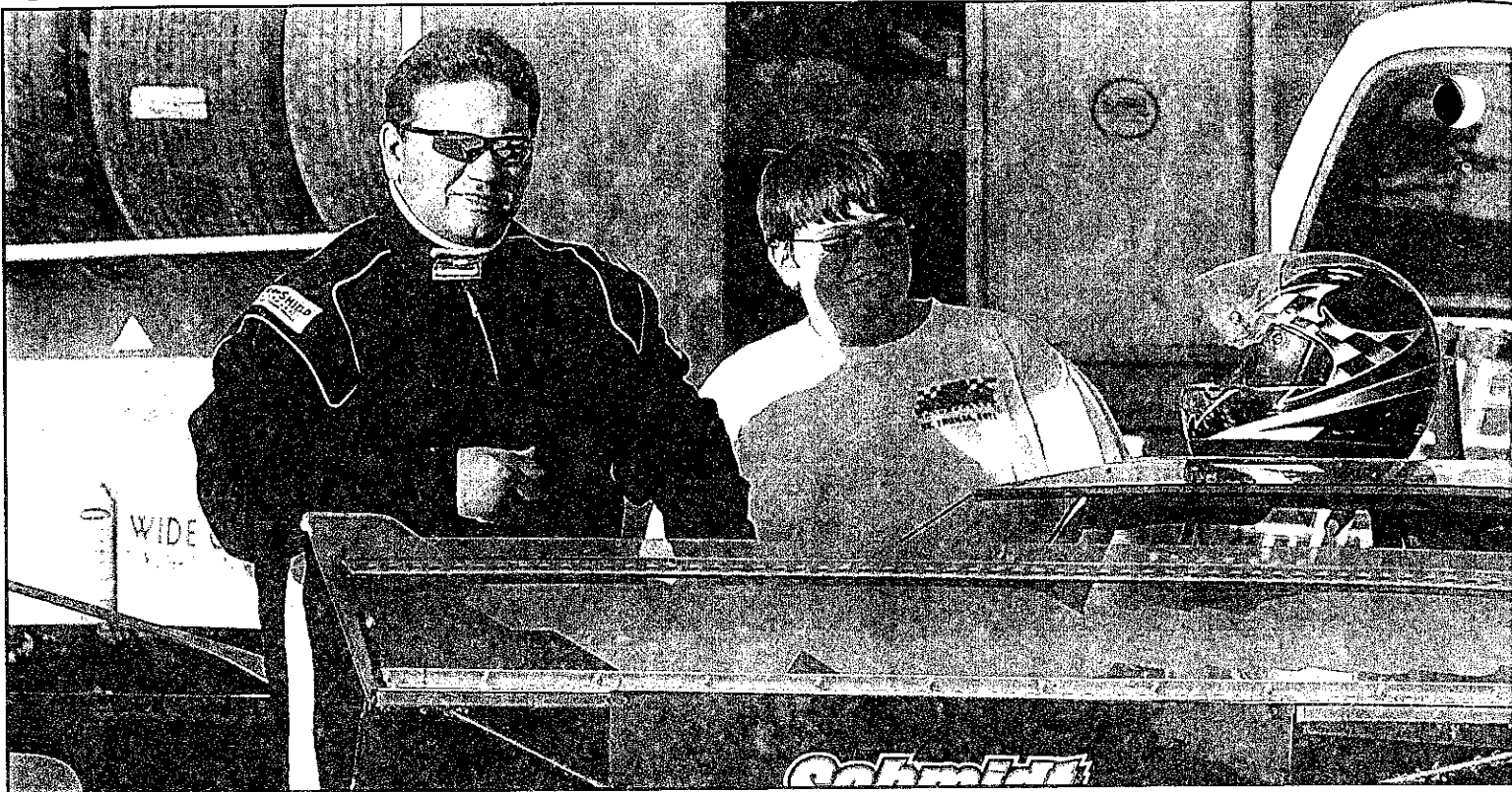

Tomka cruises to first place

Doug Tomka of Stanton started the 25-lap "A" feature on the outside pole. He grabbed the lead from the get go and ran hard enough to stay out front for the win.

He endured seven cautions, with the longest green segment of 11 laps. The next longest was four laps.

Tomka has had his set of troubles so far this season and the win helps put it behind him. It was his third top 5 in nine nights.

While Tomka was cruising to the win, it was a different story behind him.

As the faster cars worked

their way through the field, Kyle Coover of Norfolk fell into the second spot with Jason Renz of Thurston in third.

Renz first look to find the right time to slip by, but Coover, a second year driver, kept his car straight making it difficult to pass.

Renz used the chrome horn a couple of times to try and upset Coover's stock car, but officials picked up on it and warned Renz.

Renz backed off and tried various ways to get around the young driver but to no avail.

Just after the way half point, Renz turned from looking to ad-

vance a position. Renz lost his position. Billy Sukup of Norfolk made the first attempt by Renz, but Sukup couldn't find the room he needed to make the pass.

Renz's patience finally ran out with him as Chris Johnson of Bloomfield was next to challenge him. Johnson too struggled to pass, however, he had just enough of a nose to take the checkered flag first.

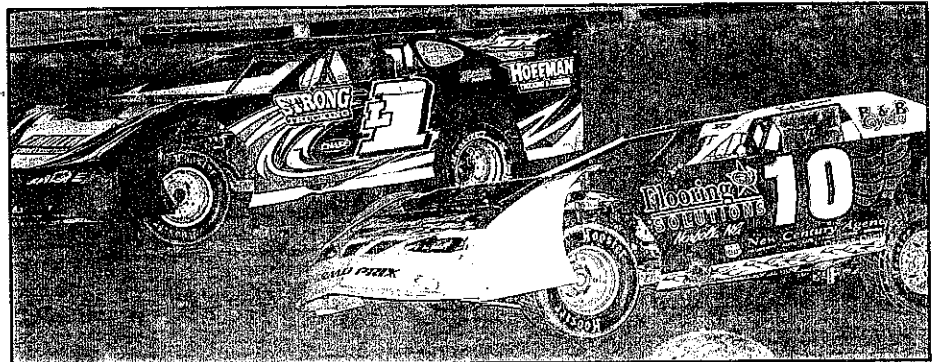
Coover picked up his career finish at second. Junior Coover took his victory last season, but his best finish going into

was ninth.

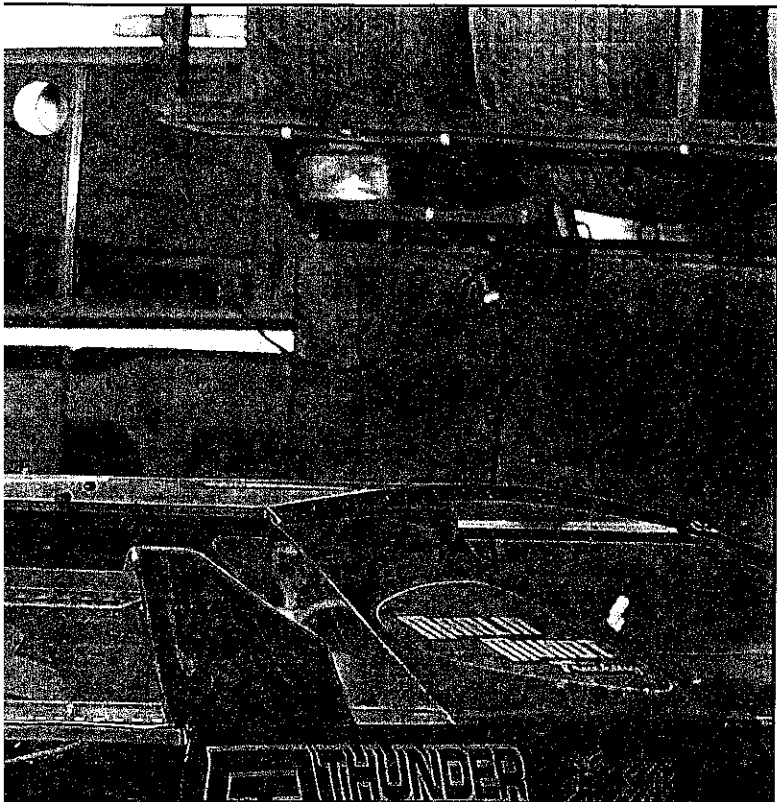
Johnson finished third, Renz slipped to fourth.

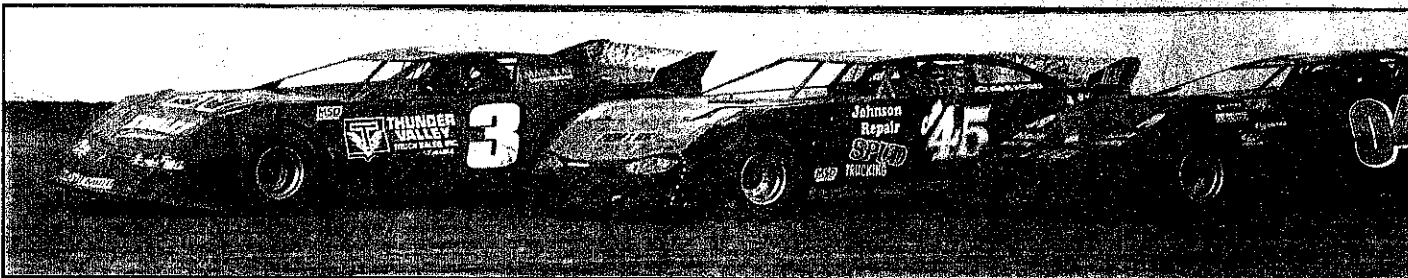
Jason Renz (56) stays ahead of Billy Sukup (101) in the "A" feature. Renz placed fourth and Sukup finished fifth.



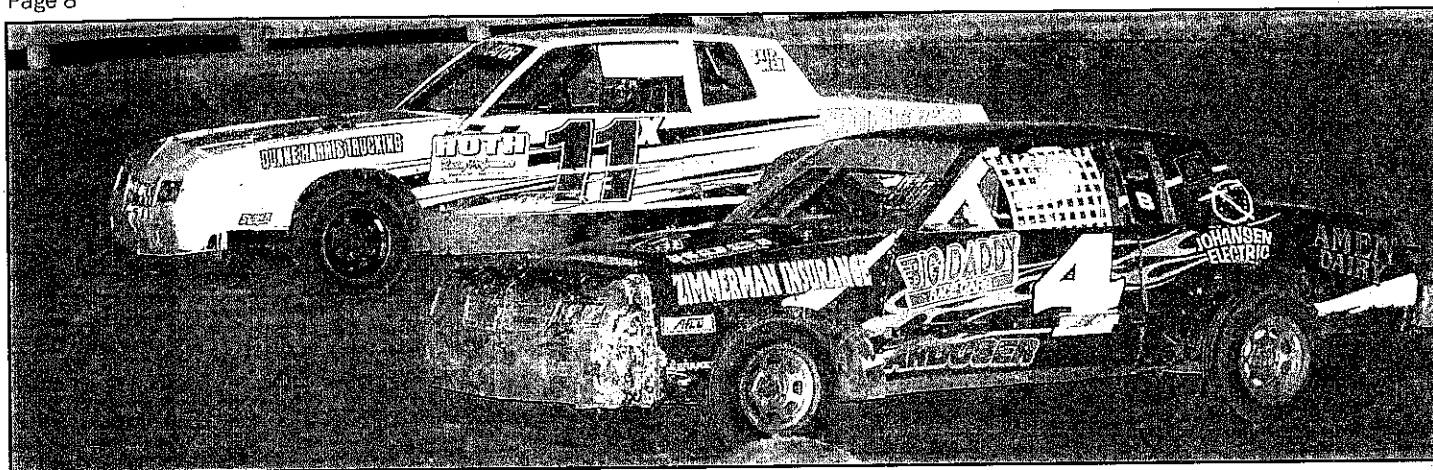
Cory Haase (21) runs to the checkered flag in his heat race. Haase tagged the concrete and caused the damage.

hampered the race.

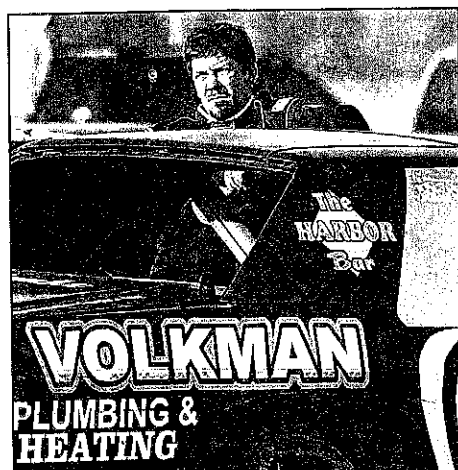
Two cautions fell in the first two laps before it went green the final 13 circuits.

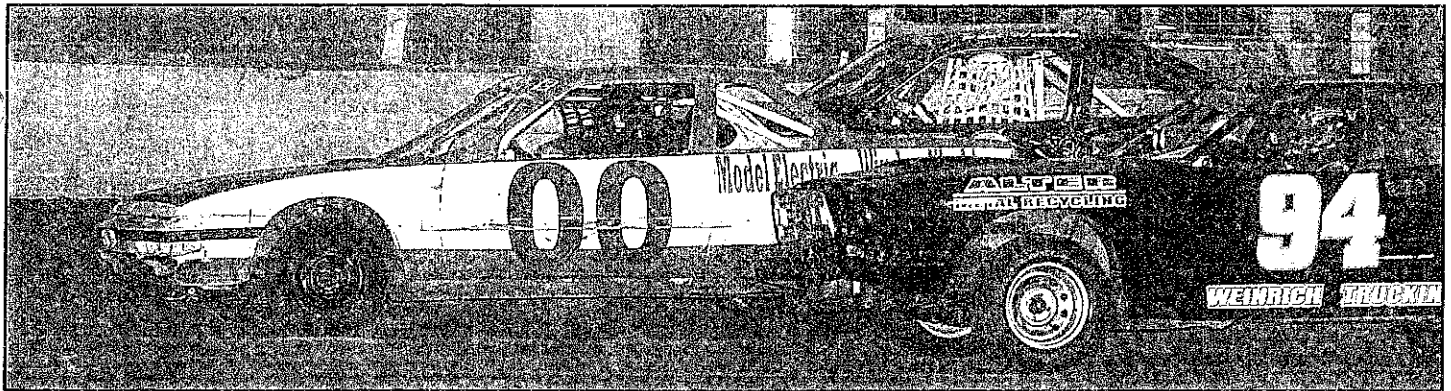

Pospisil does it again

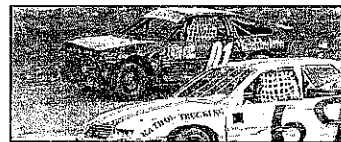
Shannon Pospisil continues to dominated the Hornet division with his sixth feature win of the seven nights the class has run.

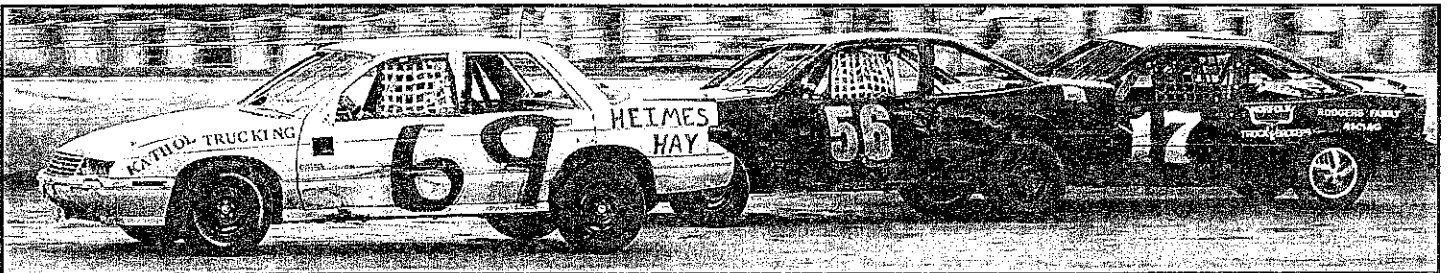


Angie Collins (01) grabbed a third place finish in the "A" feature.

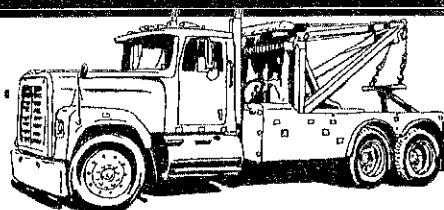

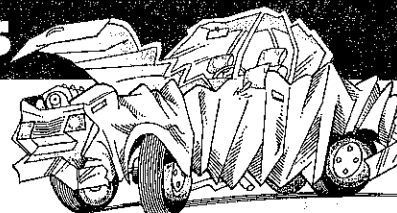

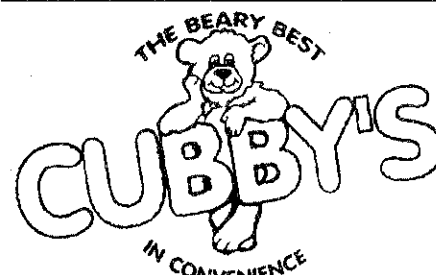
