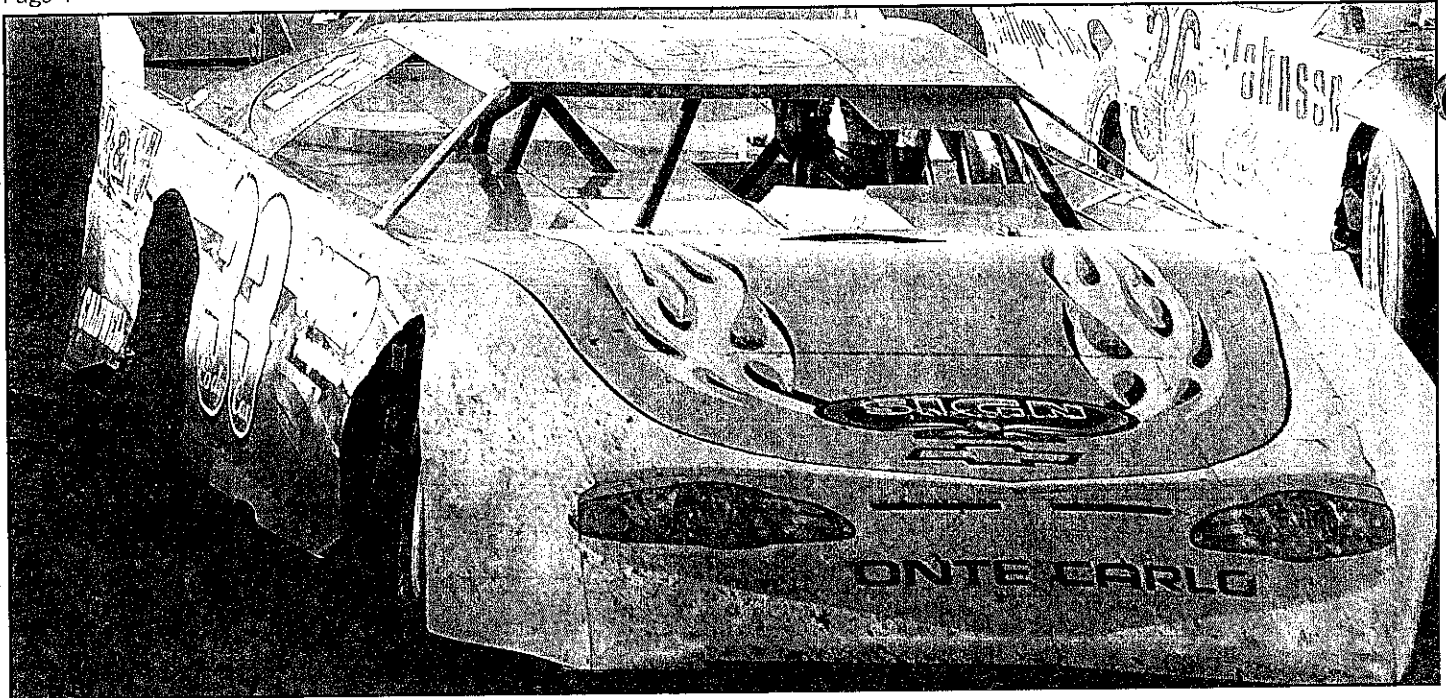

Cox hustles to first win

Cody Cox of Norfolk aggressively took off from his pole position two weeks ago and led the entire 25-lap feature to pick up his first win at the track.

The race went caution free and Cox ended up catching the rear of the field with five laps left.

Picking his way through, the gap between first and second only got closer. It was the fifth "A" feature start for Cox since he started racing at the track in 2005.

The runner-up position went to Doug Tomka of Stanton. Tomka, who had won the main feature July 3, jumped into the second position on the second lap and tried to run down the leader.

Tomka at first looked to be closing, but after several laps the interval maintained the same until they came up on lap traffic.

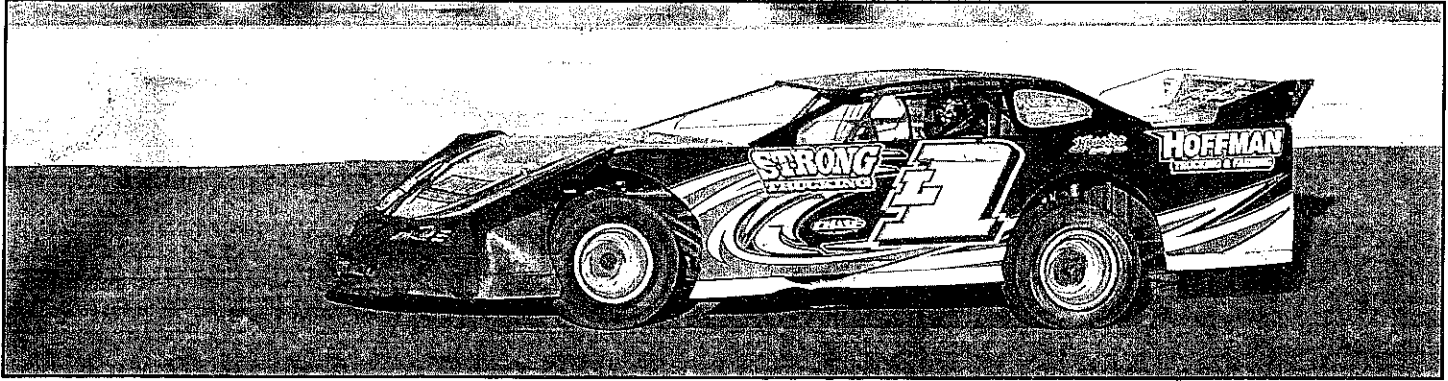
Jim Johnson of Plainview ran third for 14 laps when Chad Jensen of Norfolk made the pass for the position.

However, when Jensen was tried to catch Tomka and he went too hard into turn three and four on the final lap.

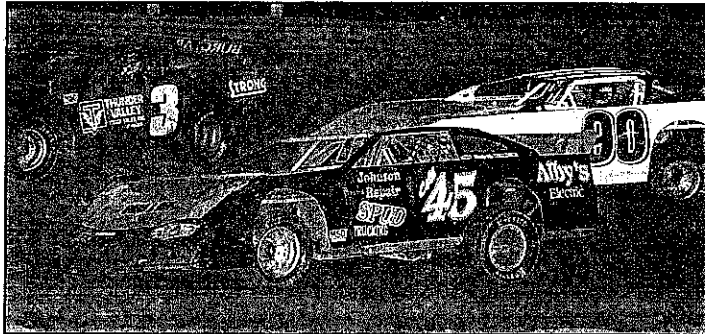
Jensen spun out sending him to a 14th place finish.

Johnson took the third place finish and his brother Chris Johnson of Bloomfield finished fourth.

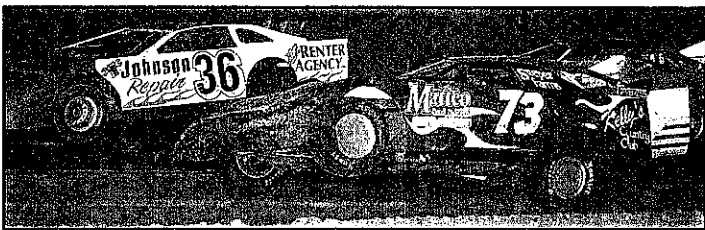
Jon Haase of Plainview rounded out the top 5. It was his second top 5 finish since 1998 when he moved to the class.



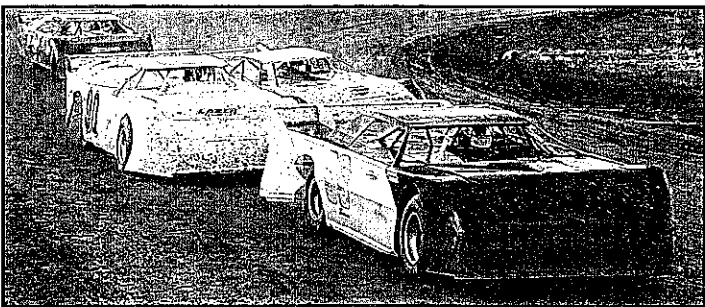
Doug Tomka (1) blasts down the back stretch to win his heat race. He finished second in the "A" feature.



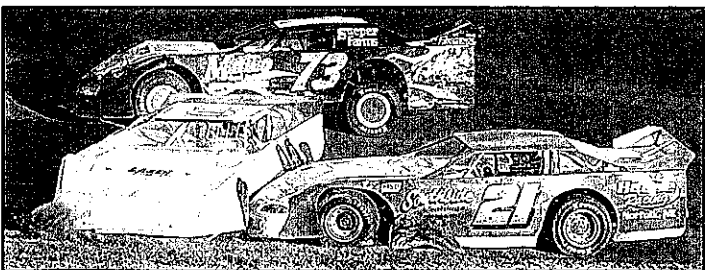

Jason Throener (99) leads a group in his heat race.

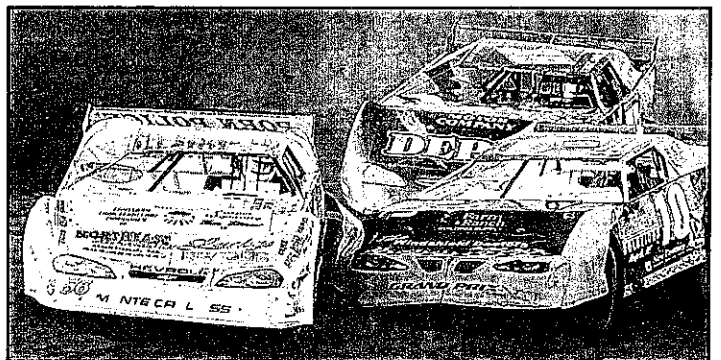

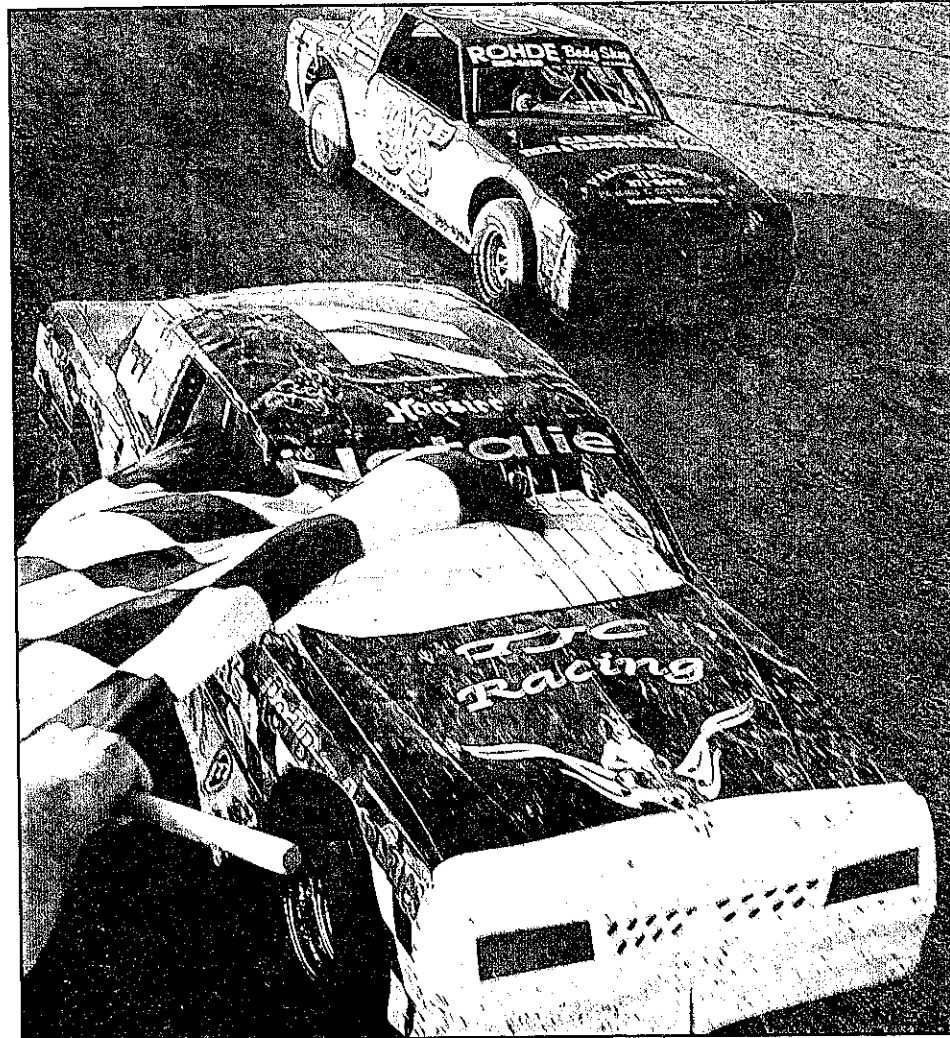

Vanosdall endured two cautions with Travis Birkley of Wakefield nipping at his heels.

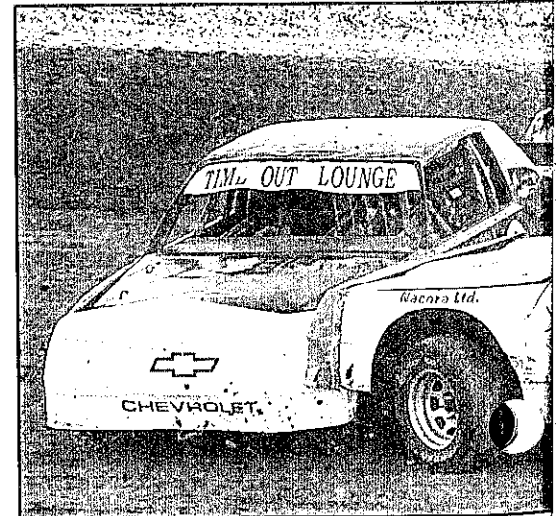
On both restarts, Vanosdall pulled away from Travis Birkley of Wakefield, who was running second.

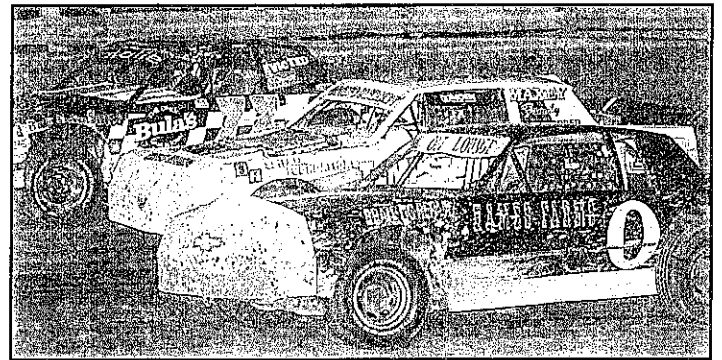

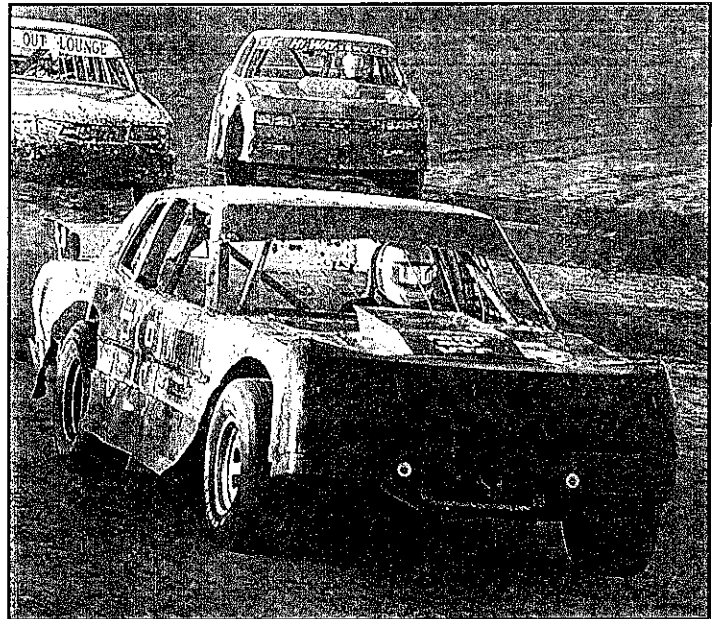

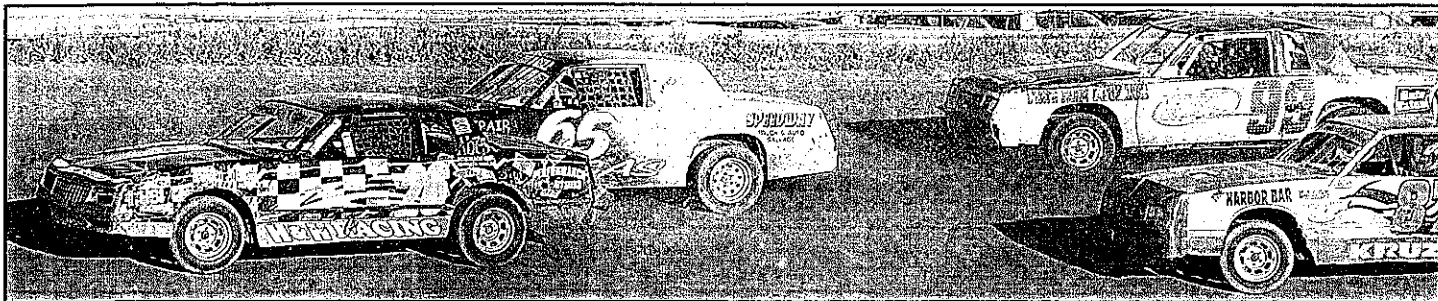

Jeremy Hoskinson of Norfolk looked like he was in a class by himself.

the field behind him.

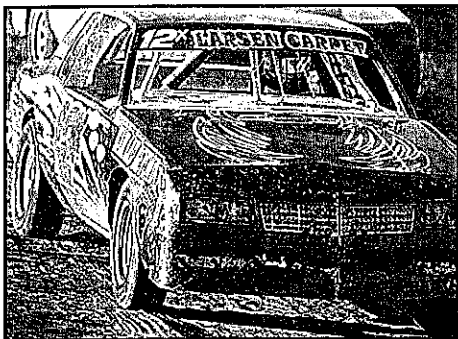
Jim Spencer of Norfolk started beside Hoskinson and also moved through the field. He moved into the top three after the second of two cautions, which came out after the completion of lap nine.

Two laps later he was second after battling with Tom Marksmeier of Norfolk for the position. Spencer finished second, his third top 5 and best effort of the season.

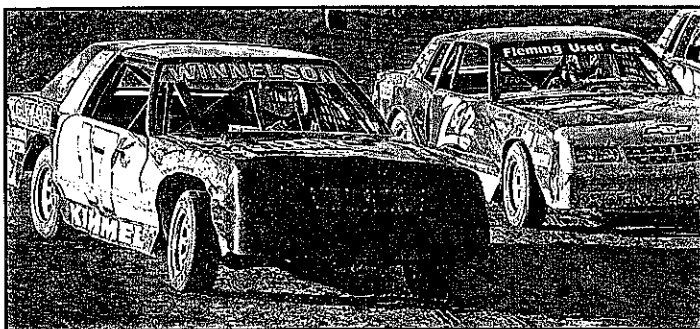
Marksmeier, who led the first seven laps, collected third place. It

Neil Bruns of Norfolk crossed fourth passing Johnny Kerby of Wisner on the final lap. Kerby rounded out the top 5.

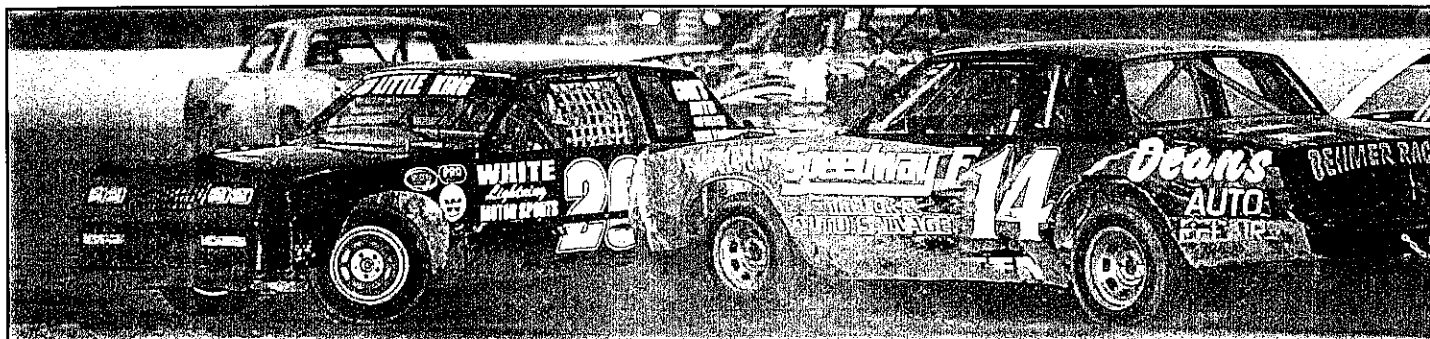


Tyler Larsen (12) won the first heat.

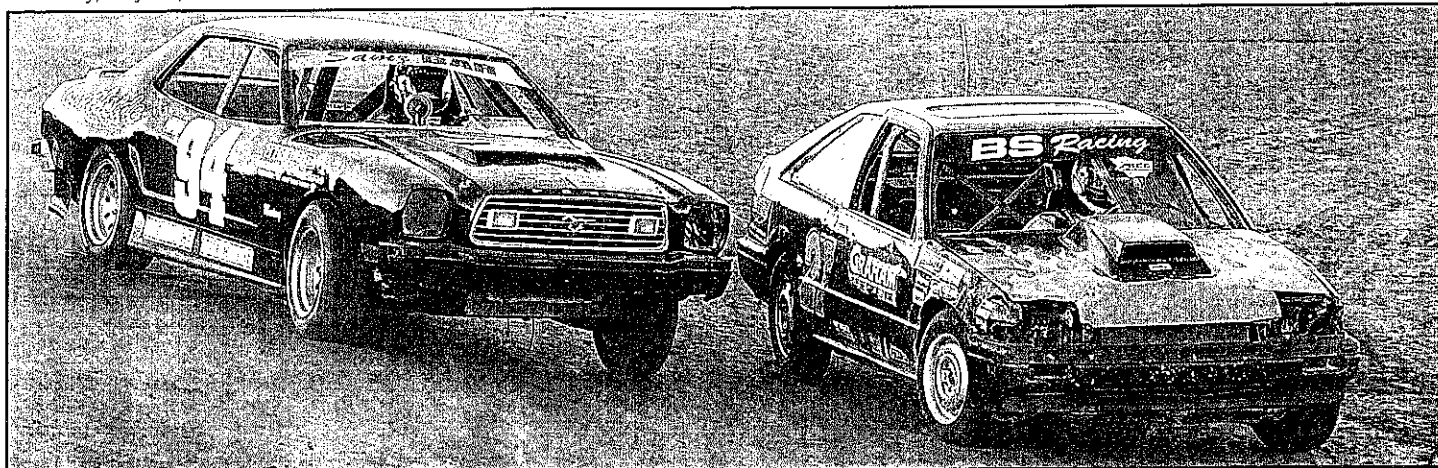


Jim Kimmel (17) runs his heat race with Tom Marksmeier (92). Marksmeier took his second top 5 finish, placing third.

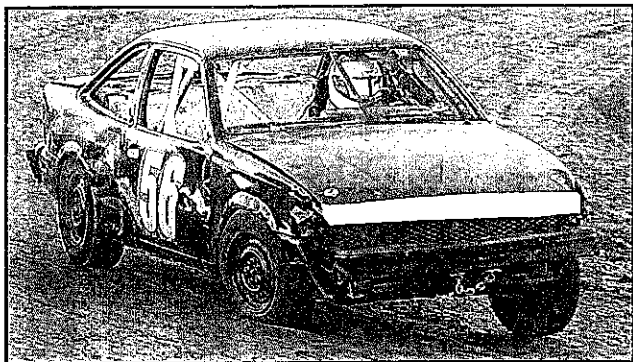

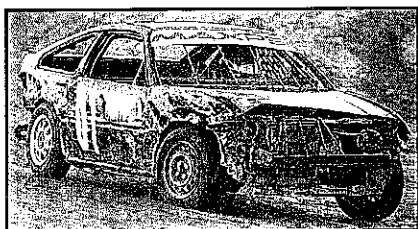
