





Primrose's fifth win of the season slings shots him to the leader in the class.

In the "A" feature last week, Chad Bruns of Wayne led the first six laps.

Primrose quickly worked his way through the 15-car field and was challenging Rick Hansen of Meadow Grove by lap four. Primrose started ninth.

After getting by Hansen,

Shawn Primrose of Norfolk he worked on Vanosdall for second, however, Vanosdall was unwilling to give it up. Vanosdall battled with Bruns for the lead which he got on lap seven.

> Vanosdall led three laps before Primrose got out front to pace the field for the final nine circuits.


> Primrose recorded his fifth win and eighth top 5 in 11 nights. Vanosdall finished out the race second.

> TeJay Mielke of Norfolk worked from his seventh place starting position to break into the top three on lap 12 of the 18-lap feature.


> He battled side-by-side with Hansen a couple of laps, but secured the position for the final four laps.





Renz dropped to third on lap 18 of the 25-lap feature when Robert Osborne of Norfolk made the pass.


The gap between Caldw Osborne only slightly decreas though Caldwell starte realilapped traffic.

Caldwell went on to take feature win. It was the fourth top season for the teen driver.


Osborne picked up second phis fifth top 5. The multi-defend champion also regained the top the points.






