However, for Jason Hames of Crofton it was smooth sailing out front of the pack.


Rick Hansen of Norfolk led the first lap, before Hames took over on the second lap.

On the restart, Hames was let loose again and he pulled away to lead the final laps.


Hansen raced second until the caution came out. However on the restart both Ryan Rohde of Carroll and Chad Bruns of Wayne slipped passed.


Hames picked up his first win at the track after starting in the 2000 season. Rohde finished out the race second, backing up his win from the previous night.

Bruns posted his second top 5 in three nights, taking his best effort at third place.


Koch worked his way back through the field to finish fourth. Rounding out the top 5 was Eric Vanosdall of Winside.

Jason Freeman of Bloomfield won the "B" feature with Tad Behmer of Winside and Brad Brabec of Norfolk finishing second and third, respectively.







Rounding out the top five was Jason Re of Thurston.









of Thurston running second.



It was Harrison's first night at the track this season. It was his third win in his third season at the track.



Shannon Pospisil has five wins and his second driver Cody Thoene has one.


Last Saturday, Chris Collins of Norfolk led the first three laps. Following a caution, Barg took over the top spot on the restart.


Ryan Crisp of Norfolk made a last attempt to catch Barg at the checkers but came up short for his first time at the track.






