Throener makes it to victory lane

Norfolk driver grabs second career win

After having a slow start this year, Jason Throener of Pilger qualified for his first Street Stock "A" feature of the season last Saturday night and 15 laps later he was winning his second feature win of his career.

Throener said the key to his win was running a smooth, evenly paced race and hugging the bottom of the track.

The Wisner-Pilger High School graduate started on the outside of the front row. On the start of the main event, pole-sitter Ned Hodgson of Norfolk grabbed the lead, but would spin in turn three in front of the entire 14-car field.

The field would pin ball off each other damaging several cars. Greg Johns of Osmond and Ryan Rohde both left the track and never returned. Dennis Martz of Norfolk suffered a bent rim, but selected to stay on the track.

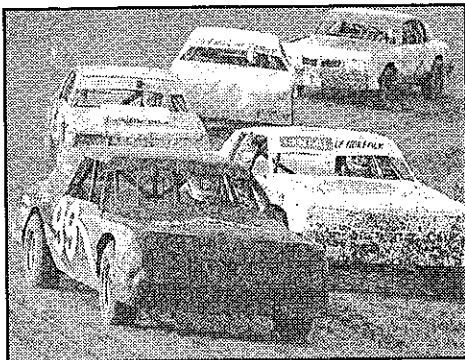
Throener would inherit the the lead for the restart with Terry Walker of Norfolk second and Nick Opfer of Hartington third.

For the next 14 laps, Throener would glide his car into the corners and flawlessly hug the inside, not allowing Walker the opportunity to get to the inside of him.

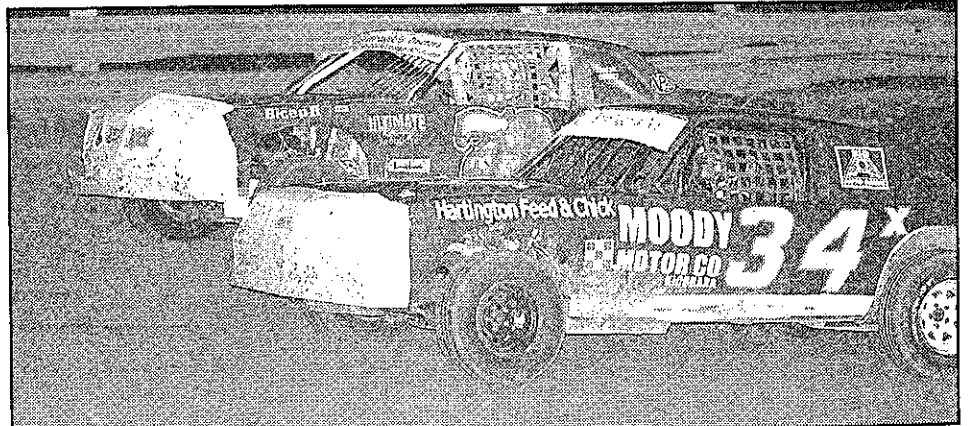
But Walker would have his own hands full with Opfer. Lap after lap, Opfer moved his Street Stock along side of Walker coming out of the corners, but could not carry the momentum down the straightaways.

While the top three battled each other, the top five point leaders slowly worked

This is as close as Nick Opfer (34x) could get to second place, as Terry Walker (79) was able to hold him off.

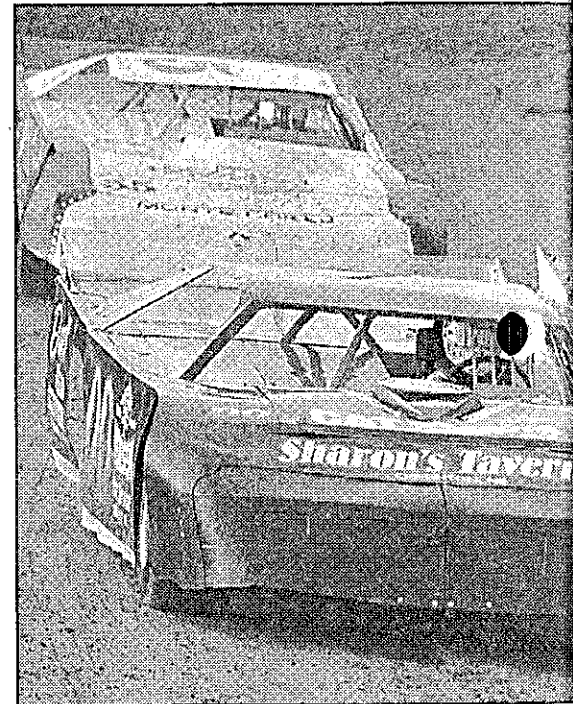
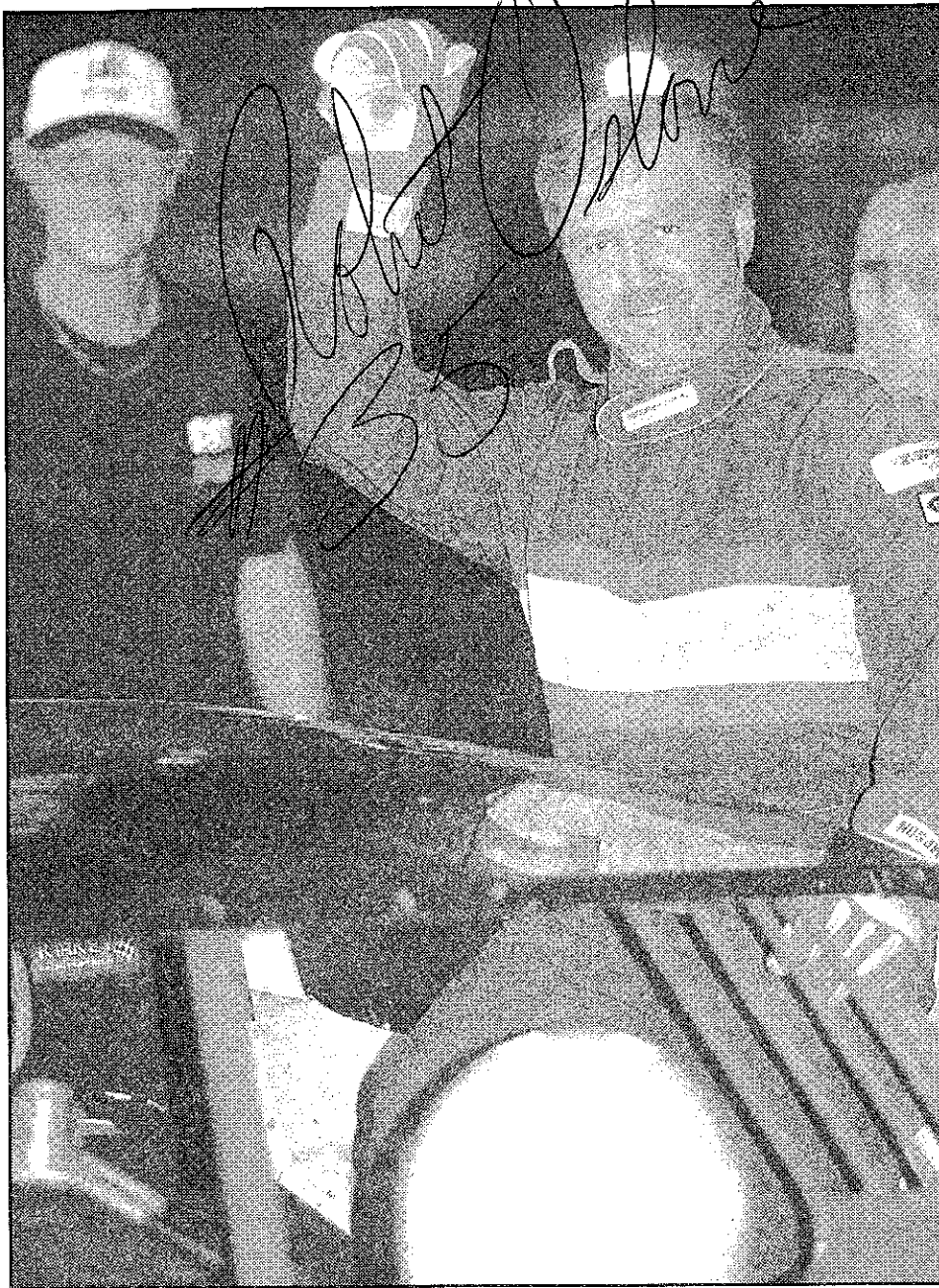
Henery tak

It was toward the end of last season, when Mark Henery of Norfolk jumped into Jay Smith's Grand National and took it to victory lane.

Last Saturday night Henery jumped into Mike Kruse's Grand National and outlasted a field of 15 cars to take his second Grand National win at Riviera Raceway.

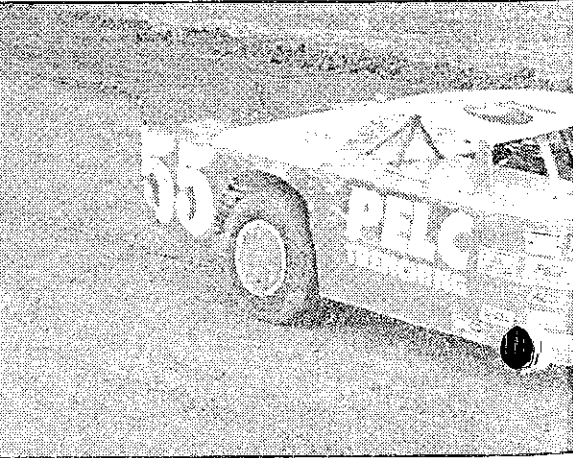
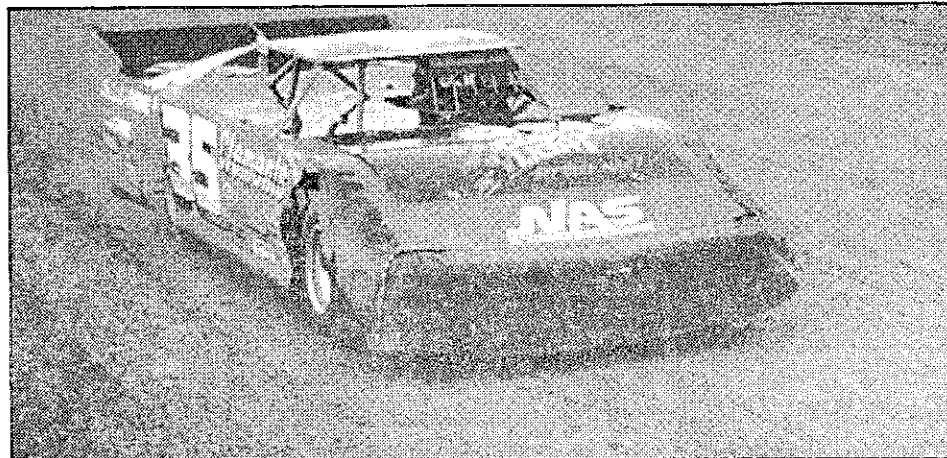
Henery is a Street Stock regular at Boone County Raceway and subs for different car owners in the area. Kruse hurt his hand in an off-the-track incident and asked the service of Henery.

It looked to Henery as if Kruse would be out for the season. Henery said he would more than likely be in the car again tonight.

The substitution required a few changes. The stock car was on the scales for a couple hours before the races started last week. Henery said a few things were changed to suit his driving style.

The last minute changes would pay off as he was able to hold off the likes of Travis Dickes of Madison and Jay Smith of Norfolk.

However, Henery got plenty of breaks: After running 16 of the 25 laps, a caution flag flew bunching the field, erasing a small lead Henery had built up.

Henery said he was somewhat thankful for the caution, because he found out the low line was working a lot better than the

one he was using.

But he had to find it out the hard way.

On the restart, Henery went into turn one too high and watched Dickes fly by to pick up the top spot. Just as quickly as Dickes pickup the lead, he lost it as a caution flag flew again before the field finished one lap.

The cars lined back up with Henery out front and Dickes second. This time Henery was going to keep the car low.

Taking another restart Henery managed to hang on through turns one and two, but said he did not do it in three.

"I screwed up," said Henery. "I missed the bottom and went through the slick part and drifted high."

Dickes again flew by on the bottom to take the lead only to have it taken away again for yet another caution.

This time, Henery changed the braking distribution to the four tires to help keep it low on the track, which he would do for the final nine laps to pick up his win.

Dickes managed beat Smith back to the line for second. It was Dickes first top five finish of the season. Smith registered his fourth top five.

Steve Matthies of Norfolk grabbed his second top five with a fourth place finish. Chad Jensen of Norfolk would come home fifth — his first Grand National top five of his career.

Doug Tomka of Meadow Grove won the "B" feature. Tomka defeated Curt Zuhlke of Bancroft and Jon Haase of Plainview.

Winning their heat races last week were Jeff Haase, Jensen and Matthies.

It was each drivers first heat race win.

In the points, Robert Osborne holds onto the top spot. He finished ninth last week. It was his first week outside of the

top five.

Smith moves back into the second spot over Vic Lovejoy of Meadow Grove, who fell to third. Reggie Roth of Bancroft did not attend for the second week falling to fourth. Matthies climbed up three spots to take over the fifth spot.

Dickes second place propelled him up four positions to sixth. Jeff Haase of Norfolk remained at seventh. Keith Hansen of Norfolk fell two spots to eight, while Raymond Haase, who did not make it to the "A" feature fell four spots to ninth.

Bob Milander of Norfolk rounds out the top five dropping one position.

their way through the field, until they started working on each for position.

In the later laps of the race, Chris Johnson of Bloomfield led his brother Jim Johnson of Osmond with Travis Loecker of Bloomfield behind him.

On the final lap, Throener would take the win and Walker followed through for second. Both drivers would take home their best finishes of the year.

Chris Johnson would make a move on the final lap passing Opfer at the line to take home third. Opfer would finish fourth for his third top five of the season. Rounding out the top five was Loecker, which was his fifth top five.

Darrell Doerr of Plainview would qualify for the "A" feature, when he won the "B" feature over Kelly Meilke of Norfolk. Third went to Scott Fredrickson of Carroll, his third third place in the "B" feature.

Winning the heat races last week were Pat Herley of Norfolk, Martz and Walker.

It was the first ones for both Walker and Herley, while Martz won his third of the season.

In the points race, it got tighter, but there were no changes in the top eight position.

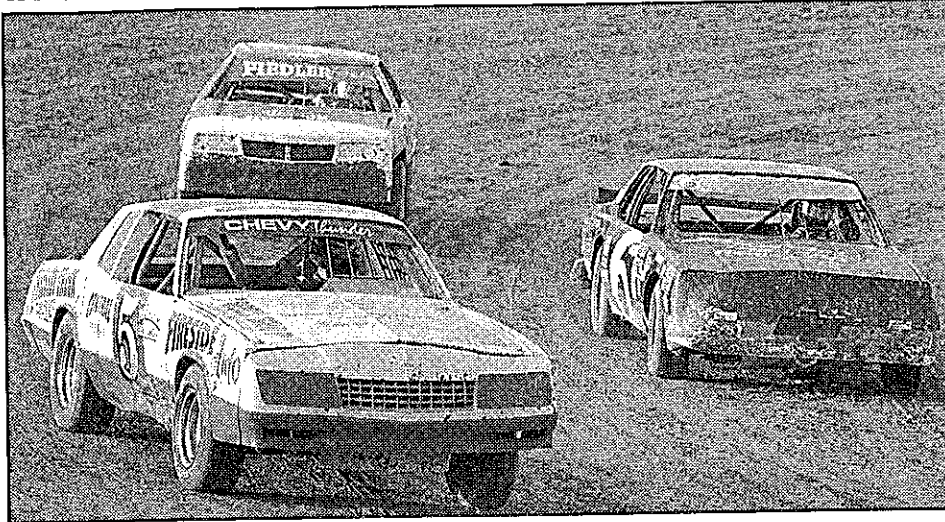
Jim Johnson lead fell to only four points over Loecker and Chris Johnson. Last week, Jim Johnson had a nine-point lead over Loecker and 19 over Chris Johnson.

Doerr maintained a 34-point deficit. Martz took a hit in the points, but did not lose his fifth position. Martz's tire problem finally let loose ending his night.

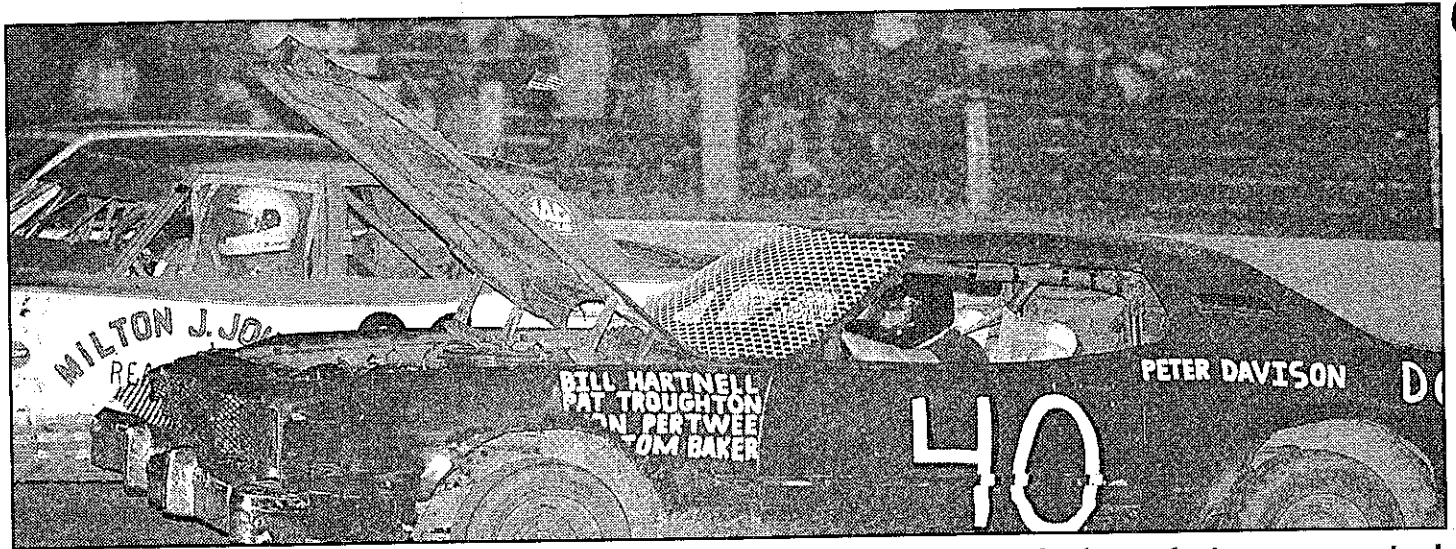
Opfer remains sixth, Johns is seventh, while Mike Timm of Pierce sits eighth.
