





Loecker survives slick track

Bloomfield driver takes first win

It was the first race of the season last year when Travis Loecker of Bloomfield won his last race, but Saturday night he broke the drought and was able to stop Osmond's Jim Johnson's winning streak to three "A" features.

Loecker ran the only line usable to pick up his first win of the year on a night when the track surface became slick.

Loecker picked up the lead on lap five of 15 from Ned Hodgson of Norfolk. He then put his car on the bottom of the track and never budged.

He knew Johnson was behind him after several cautions and said if Johnson was going to pass him he would have to do it on the high side.

Johnson knew Loecker was not going to make any mistakes and leave the low line, so Johnson said he decided to take second instead of attempting to make the pass and fall back in the 15-car field. He also said he did not make the move to the front early enough, as Loecker beat him to the front.

Loecker succeeded in holding the line and took home the trophy. Johnson did make a last minute effort, but came up a car length short giving him second.

Darrell Doerr of Plainview took the challenge of attempting to pass on the high side and found out how difficult it was.

Doerr ran third behind Johnson, but Nick Opfer of Hartington found a way to get around him.


Doerr said he worked hard to get back around Opfer, but it only made it worse, as Dennis Martz of Norfolk was able to get by Doerr, when Doerr's car slid to high.

Opfer landed his best finish of the year at the third position, as Dennis Martz finished fourth. Doerr rounded out the top five, with his fifth top five finish.

Ryan Rohde of Norfolk won the "B" feature over Mike Timm of Pierce, as Scott Fredrickson of Carroll, who came from the "C" feature, finished third. All three advanced to the "A."


Fredrickson won the "C" feature and Tate Weinrich of Norfolk finished second. Both advanced to the "B" feature.

Winning their heat races were; Doerr,

Osborne dominates field, again

Riviera Raceway was the accelerator, as a slick track made it difficult to get traction.

Grand National driver Robert Osborne of Norfolk had no trouble handling the slippery surface winning his division's "A" feature.

Osborne has shown his horsepower in the past weeks pulling his left front off the ground out of the corners, but Saturday night horsepower was the drivers nightmare.

The track started getting dry-slick during the Street Stock "A" feature, so when the Grand Nationals got to the track the surface was dried out and slick.


Osborne said the key to his win was staying out of trouble. He watched Steve

The biggest enemy Saturday night at Matthies of Norfolk slide into the guard rail on the back stretch and Norfolk's Bob Milander smashed into the side of him. Milander's car ended up on top of Matthies. Jeff Pendergast of Norfolk was a third vehicle involved when he had no where to go.

As bad as it looked, all three vehicles made repairs and returned to the track.

Osborne said it developed in front of him and he dove low to avoid the incident. He would slowly work his way to the front, breaking into the top three on lap five of

Tom Wagner was leading the race and Raymond Haase of Norfolk was second, when Wagner drifted high on lap seven, allowing both Haase and Osborne to get by.

Osborne would lead Haase by less than a car length to cross the line to lead lap eight. The two drivers would go side-byaide for a couple of laps, before Osborne anally took over on lap 10.

Rarely using the accelerator to get off the corners, Osborne used the middle of the track where rubber had built up to pull away from the field.

Osborne said he started catching slower traffic and watched them going in different directions on the slick track.

Osborne pulled off his third win of the season and his second straight win.

Haase held on to finish second, as his son Jeff Haase of Norfolk finished third. It was Raymond Haase's best finish of the season.

Vic Lovejoy of Meadow Grove wrapped up fourth as Keith Hansen of Norfolk grabbed his second top five of the season with a fifth place finish.

Hansen also won his second "B" feature of the year. Bill Wells of Norfolk was second after returning to the track from motor trouble. Mike Kruse was third.

Winning heat races were Jeff Pendergast of Norfolk, Raymond Haase and Osborne. It was Pendergast and Raymond Haase's first wins, while it was Osborne's second win.


With the suspension of Travis Roth of Bancroft for an incident on May 15, points contender Reggie Roth, his father, did not make the trip to Norfolk, as well.

Osborne increased his points lead to more than 130 points. Reggie Roth hangs onto second, as Lovejoy moves passed Jay Smith for the third spot. Smith, who had trouble in the closing laps fell to 13th. Smith is fourth in the points.


Raymond Haase made the biggest jump in the points moving from 10th to fifth. Hansen sits sixth in the points, as Jeff Haase makes the move to seventh.

Matthies falls two positions to eighth. Milander suffers the most, falling four spots to ninth. Travis Dickes rounds out the top ten.






Robert Osborne (35) uses the cushion to pull the left front off the ground during his heat race.

Loecker, Johnson and Martz. Loecker and Johnson won their third ones and Doerr and Martz picked up their second wins of the season.

In the points battle, Jim Johnson finally arrived at the top spot. A DNF in the season opener put Johnson near the bottom of the points list, but with three straight wins and a runnerup finish, Johnson takes the lead over his brother Chris Johnson of Bloomfield.

Loecker would also get by Chris Johnson in points with his win in both the heat race and "A" feature.

Chris Johnson, who had a flat tire during the "A," had to fight his way from the back of the field. He finished seventh, his worse finish this season. He would fall to third in points.

Doerr's consistency keeps him at fourth. Doerr's best finish is third and his worse finish is sixth. Martz, who had trouble at the start of the "A" feature came back and remains fifth in points.

Opfer made a three position leap to sixth with a third place finish. Greg Johns of Osmond, Timm and Ron Pettitt of Pierce fell one position each. Johns seventh, Timm eighth and Pettitt ninth. Kevin Hoffart of Norfolk stays at 10th.




