





Bancroft drivers finish 1-2

Slip slide and away was the theme of Riviera Raceway Monday night, as a dry slick surface developed early in the night causing all divisions to baby the throttle through their respective "A" features.

For Grand National drivers Reggie Roth and Curt Zuhlke it was no problem, as both Bancroft drivers were forced to run the "B" feature to qualify for the main event.

Roth said the track was slick on the top and bottom groove and said he could drive his car anywhere on the track to make a pass.

Having switched his racing schedule to run at Park Jefferson on Saturday night Roth has been absent at Norfolk for most of the season. Having races on Wednesday and again on Monday night, it allowed the defending points champion and his son to return to Norfolk to try their hands at the oval, again.

Roth started the main event in the back of the 15-car field when he had to come through the "B" feature to qualify for the "A."

Roth said both the high and low groove were slick, but the top was a little better than the bottom. He said he followed current points leader Robert Osborne of Norfolk for the first few laps on the high side, until Osborne spun out on lap seven of the 25-lap race.

Roth was running seventh on the restart and would moved up to fifth one lap later. He than broke into the top three on lap 11 passing Keith Hansen of Norfolk for the spot just before the fifth and final caution flag flew.


That put Roth third behind race leader Bob Milander of Norfolk and Chad Jensen of Norfolk. Jensen had led the first 10 laps and Milander had just got around Jensen to lead lap 11 before the caution. Roth said he worked the heat back into his tires before making the move on Jensen. Roth passed Jensen on the high side, but had to find a different line around Milander.

Milander had the high side working, but it was not enough to hold off Roth.


Roth said after he got Jensen on the high side, he had to go low to get by Milander.

Roth took over the lead on lap 14 and

It was the second time this year a substitute driver has jumped in to a stock car and drove to a victory. The newest substitute driver was former track champion Larry Hockemeier.

Hockemeier piloted the vacationing Dennis Martz's Street Stock from the rear of the field to the front to return to the winner's circle.

Hockemeier took a break from racing several years ago and has been helping out various drivers the last couple of years when they need a driver.

Martz himself piloted the car to victory June 12 and finished second Wednesday. Now the car found its way back to winning.

"The car worked anywhere," said Hockemeier. "It was very slick and you had to miss the hole. Basically, I steered with the foot feet."

Hockemeier started the race 11th out of the 15-car field giving him a challenge.

But he would receive a break on lap five when a mix up allowed him to advance numerous spots. In fact, he moved to fourth behind, leader Kelly Meilke, Jason Jensen and Ryan Rohde.

Hockemeier would pick off a car a lap and three laps later he was leading the field.

But it would not be easy leading the field, as points leader Chris Johnson of Bloomfield took over second the same time Hockemeier grabbed the lead.

Johnson was able to stick his nose a long side of Hockemeier exiting turn two, but Johnson could not get the bit he needed to take the lead.

Johnson drifted back a couple of car lengths and never contend for the lead again. Hockemeier took the win, his first win of the year and the car's second trip to victory lane.

Johnson, who finished second in the "C" feature and "B" feature, held onto finish second. Third went to Darrell Doerr of Johnson second and Travis Loecker was Plainview, who continues to struggle after blowing a motor several weeks ago.


Doerr's wish came true when he said at the beginning of the night he wanted a dryslick track to help with his carburetor problem, which has taken his horsepower away.

Fourth went to Travis Loecker of Bloomfield and rounding out the top five was Jim Kimmel of Norfolk.


In the "B" feature, Doerr took the win,

In the heat races, Jason Jensen won the first one, Mike Timm of Pierce won the second, Jim Johnson of Osmond won the third and Greg Johns claimed the fourth







Chris Johnson (7J) gets to the inside of Larry Hockemeier (25), but could not get in front to win the Street Stock "A" feature.




Kelly Meilke (70) leads a group of cars out of turn four during his heat race.

Chris Johnson continues lead the points battle. Chris Johnson failed to make his heat race when his starter broke at the entrance of the track.


Having to run well in the three races, Johnson picked up more points doing it the hard way than if he had won his heat and won the "A" feature.

With Hockemeier's win, Martz jumps to second in points, three points ahead of Jim Johnson. Loecker sits fourth, Nick Opfer of Hartington is fifth.

Sixth place goes to Doerr, seventh is Timm and eighth is Johns. Brian Wagner of Creighton is ninth and Terry Walker is 10th.

would run uncontested for the final laps, pulling a huge lead in the closing laps.

Even though the hide side was faster, Roth said he chose the more defensive line and ran the lower groove, forcing any challenger to pass him high.

It was Roth's third win at the track in six starts. Taking home the second place money was Zuhlke. Zuhlke, as well, runs a limited schedule at Norfolk.

Third went to Milander, fourth was Robert Osborne of Norfolk and rounding out the top five was Keith Hansen.

Following Roth across the line in the "B" feature was his son Travis Roth of Bancroft and Zuhlke would finish third.

Winning heat races were, Steve Matthies of Norfolk, Vic Lovejoy of Meadow Grove and Osborne.

The top four spots in the Grand National track points standings remain the same. Osborne leads, Lovejoy is second, Jay Smith of Norfolk is third and Jeff Haase of Norfolk fourth.

Milander's third place finish moves him to the fifth spot from the seventh spot he had last week.

Tom Wagner and Raymond Haase, both of Norfolk, both drop a spot. Wagner is sixth and Raymond Haase is seventh.

Travis Dickes of Madison finished 10th in the "A" feature, as Matthies, who lost another drive shaft in the "A," finished 15 out of 15 cars. Both drivers gain a spot, as Creighton's Mike Kruse's car did not make it to the track. Dickes is eighth and Matthies is ninth.

Rounding out the top ten is Hansen.




