

# Meilke outlasts field for first feature win

The night was one to forget for several drivers, but for Street Stock driver Kelly Meilke of Norfolk it was an accomplishment of overcoming a difficult track surface to win the Street Stock "A" feature, last week.

Racing many years at Riviera in the 4-cylinder division, Meilke stopped racing 10 years ago. He had several wins in the division, before the class was dropped from the program,

When his son, TeJay, got old enough to drive his own race car, Kelly Meilke could not sit in the stands and watch him race. The older Meilke then put together his own car and returned to the track.

Meilke said at the beginning of the season, he was plagued with minor mechanical set backs and the car is finally coming around.

It has been in the final few weeks, Meilke has shown consistent runs at the front of the pack. His best finish of the year has been eighth twice.

Meilke started on the pole for the 15lap race Saturday night. The first 11 laps went non-stop, as Meilke pulled a slight advantage over the second place car of Nick Cautrell of Bloomfield.


No caution flag was thrown when Jim Johnson of Bloomfield and Jim Kimmel of Norfolk hooked together exiting turn four. The two slid sideways and ended up stuck in three inches of water in the infield, unable to move because of the soggy ground.

A short time later a caution was thrown when the fourth place car of Pat Herley of Norfolk spun in turn three.

Meilke's lead vanished. On the restart, Meilke led, Cautrell second, Scott Fredrickson of Carroll third and Dennis Martz of Norfolk was fourth.

Martz got by Fredrickson on the restart, but both Cautrell and Martz could not


When the program finally got started the racing surface was still soggy and racing was unique to many of the drivers.

It had to be the worse Grand National feature race for sometime at Riviera Raceway last week, as the 25-lap main feature was slowed by eight cautions, which eliminated eight of the 15 cars that started the race.

Robert Osborne of Norfolk won the feature, but it was a total surprise to him.

Osborne, one of the more cautious drivers, found himself getting bounced around throughout the race, as did anyone of the 15 cars in the race.

Osborne lost track position on the fifth

Rayr lided caution, when Tom Wagner of Norfolk slowed quickly to avoid collecting the car in front of him. Osborne found himself hitting Wagner and spinning the driver out. Both Wagner and Osborne were sent to the rear of the field.

Taking advantage of the caution, Osborne stopped on the back stretch where a fire broke out on the right front. He said he shut the brake off earlier, but the pads continued to make contact with the rotor causing the rotor to turn cherry red.

When he stopped the rotors started a

fire, he pulled off the track to have the fire extinguished. He returned to the track with a vengeance.

Surviving the multiple car wrecks became the most important part of the night for most drivers.

Jon Haase of Plainview started on the pole and was the only car that suffered little if no damage until the last laps, when he collided with Raymond Haase of Norfolk.

Jon Haase, the grandson of Raymond Haase, has a best finish of eighth coming

into the night. Keeping his poise, Jon Haase would endure the numerous cautions with excellent restarts. He also managed to keep his grandfather from making the pass for the lead.

Osborne had a front row seat to the incident that many have cost both Jon and Raymond Haase their first win of the season.

Osborne said he had settled in to finish fourth or maybe a third place finish. He started running a higher line than the rest of the leaders to finish out the race.

Raymond Haase also picked a different way around turns one and two by rolling his car into turn one and let it slide up in the middle of the turn. He then cut down to the tires out of turn two trying to get a nose under the younger Haase.

However, on lap 23 Raymond Haase got together with Jon Haase exiting turn two. Raymond Haase's car got airborne over Jon Haase's car.

Both cars had to back off a second allowing other cars to get by.

It was a huge break for Osborne. Henery, who was tailing the duo, had to check up, but Osborne, running the higher line, blasted past to inherit the lead. Henery took over second and Jon Haase recovered and dropped into the third spot.

Osborne held off Henery in the final laps to win his sixth this season and second straight. He also has 14 top fives in 16 starts.

Henery finished second for his seventh top five. Henery was also second to Osborne the week earlier.

Jon Haase salvaged third for his first top five of the season. Keith Hansen of Norfolk crossed the line fourth for his fourth top five. Rounding out the top five was Lovejoy. It was his eighth top five.

Osborne struggled in his heat race and was forced to the "B" feature, which he won over Bob Milander and Steve Matthies, both of Norfolk.


Winning their heats were Travis Dickes of Madison, Doug Tomka of Meadow Grove and Raymond Haase. It was Dickes second straight, Tomka's first and Raymond Haase's second.

In the points, Osborne's win extends his lead even more.


The next three positions remain the same. Lovejoy has second, Jay Smith of Norfolk is third and fourth is Jeff Haase.

Henery brings the Mike Kruse Grand National to fifth, moving up three spots.



Meilke went on to win. He said the key to his win was finding the smoothest part of the track and keeping it there.


Cautrell was second, his second top five of the season. Martz finished third for his seventh top five.

Travis Loecker won the "B" feature over Darrell Doerr of Plainview and Larry Robinson of Omaha, whose normal track was rained out.


Winning the heat races were Jason Throener of Pilger, Robinson, Ryan Rohde of Carroll and Chris Johnson of Bloomfield.


